# Govt creating world-class programmes, infra to develop creators' economy: Minister

NEW DELHI, AUGUST 22

INFORMATION AND Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnav Thursday said the government is focused on creating world-class talent development programmes and infrastructure to develop creators' economy and there are plans to establish world-class universities and facilities that will enhance the capabilities of creators in media and entertainment.

He said this while launching 25 challenges as part of first season of 'Create in India Challenge' for World Audio Visual & Entertainment Summit (WAVES). The global summit is scheduled to be held between November 20 and 24 in Goa, alongside the International Film Festival of India (IFFI). Vaishnav said a totally new creators' economy has been created and the same is also recognised by PM Narendra Modi, as reflected in the first-ever National Creators Award presented by him in March 2024. These challenges, hosted by industry associations and organi-

sations and being done in the run-up to the main event (WAVES), cover animation, filmmaking, gaming, music and visual arts among other disciplines. Vaishnav's comments come days after the government faced flak from the industry as well as from independent content creators for bringing a draft Broadcasting Bill 2024 last month. The draft Bill — shared with few select stakeholders — had sought to define a "digital news broadcaster" in sweeping terms to include independent content

creators, and proposed prior registration with the government.

The draft Bill was subsequently put on hold and in a statement the ministry had said it is holding a series of consultations with the stakeholders and is offering them further additional time till October 15 to issue their comments, adding that a fresh draft will be published after detailed consultations.

On Thursday, Vaishnav said, "The Government of India is leaving no stone unturned to encourage this economy and therefore, we need to ensure the talent and skill development and availability of necessary infrastructure in this sector."

He said filmmaking is one of India's strengths, adding that there is a great scope of using new technology and tools in this sector, thereby ensuring a good scope for employment generation in today's era. He said it is estimated that if successfully executed, the programme can generate 2-3 lakh jobs in the sector. I&B Secretary Sanjay Jaju said this initiative is a "significant milestone in our ongoing mission to nurture and elevate India's creative ecosystem".

# NGT fines Punjab ₹1K-cr for violating green laws

THE NATIONAL Green Tribunal imposed a ₹1,026-crore penalty on Punjab government for "persistent defiance and non-compliance of environment laws" with regard to solid and liquid waste management and issued notices asking why proceedings should not be initiated against top officials for defying an earlier order.

The tribunal has asked the state government to deposit the penalty towards environmental compensation with the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB)

within one month.

It added that the government was fined Rs 2,080 crore on September 22, 2022, for the same issue and asked to create a ring fence account for the amount.

But neither the penalty was paid nor the ring fence account created.

"Since Chief Secretary has also failed in compliance of Tribunal order dated 22.09.2022 with regard to creation of ring-fence account of Rs 2,080 crore, this is clear that the order of this Tribunal has been defied and disobeyed, which is also an offence under Section 26 of NGT Act, 2010," the order read.

# Part of proposed stone crusher unit in Rajaji park ESZ falls in River Song's floodplain: Wildlife Institute to NGT

THE WILDLIFE Institute of India (WII) has submitted a report before the National Green Tribunal (NGT) that a part of a stone crusher unit proposed in Rajaji Tiger Reserve's eco-sensitive zone, Dehradun, falls in River Song's active floodplain area which sees regular elephant movements.

The NGT's principal bench was hearing a plea filed by a group of residents from Dehradun, who have sought quashing

of permits granted for proposed stone crusher unit, stating that no wildlife clearance was obtained for the project. The environmental clearance granted for the project, proposed to be run by M/S Balaji Associates, stated it was subject to obtaining wildlife clearance. The Tribunal granted four weeks to the project proponent to respond to the plea as well as the WII report.

In July, the NGT had admitted the case and served notices to the Uttarakhand government, its forest department, the project proponent and WII.

WII said in its report dated August 16 that the river is used by elephants and other wildlife to access the Lal Thappar and Teen Pani elephant corridors.

"Both of these corridors are crucial to facilitate elephant movement in an otherwise disjunct forest mosaic in the western portion of Rajaji National Park and adjoining Dehradun Forest Division," it said. According to maps attached with the report, the proposed unit is located near Banwaha, Fatehpur and Majri forest beats which have witnessed human-elephant conflicts.

# Assam: Opp walks out of House over land Bill, calls it 'unconstitutional'

THE OPPOSITION walked out of the Assam Legislative Assembly on the first day of the autumn session Thursday, calling proposed amendments to the Assam Land Revenue and Regulation Act "unconstitutional".

The government introduced 10 Bills in the Assembly Thursday which will be debated and considered later during the course of the ongoing session. When Revenue and Disaster Management Minister Jogen Mohan presented the Assam Land and Revenue Regulation (Amendment) Bill, 2024, some Opposition members opposed its introduction.

"This is in violation of our Constitution. According to Article

16 of our Constitution, every citizen has been created equally... So vehemently oppose the introduction of this Bill," said Baghmara MLA Sherman Ali Ahmed, who has been elected as a Congress MLA but is under suspension from the party.

Later, he told *The Indian Express* he objected to Assam Cabinet's announcement Wed-

nesday that it has approved an amendment to the Act which will impose restrictions on sale of land surrounding notified 'Iconic Structures'. "There is no bar in the sale of land in the Constitution. We are opposing the attempt to bring a Bill like this," said AIUDF MLA Rafiqul Islam.

The Speaker replied that the Bills have been introduced and that objections could be raised during subsequent discussion. Following this, AIUDF MLAs moved to the Well of the House, while the Congress along with lone MLAs of CPI(M) and Rajgor Dal staged a walkout. The AIUDF legislators subsequently left the House as well.

However, the Bill does not contain the particular amendment announced by Cabinet Wednesday.

# 47,928 foreigners detected in 43 yrs, 43% of them are Hindus, Assam CM tells House

Assam government Thursday said over 47,900 foreigners have been detected in the state from 1971 to 2014, of whom over 43% are Hindus.

In a written reply to a query by AGP MLA Ponakan Baruah, Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said the Foreigners Tribunal has declared 47,928 people as foreigners between 1971 and 2014.

Of them, 27,309 were Muslims, 20,613 Hindus and six belonged to other religions, he said.

The Chief Minister said the highest number of foreigners was detected in Cachar.

Of the 10,152 declared foreigners, 8,139 were Hindus and the remaining 2,013 were Muslims.

As per the Assam Accord, names of all foreigners coming to the state on or after March 25, 1971 would be detected and deleted from electoral rolls and steps would be taken to deport them. There were 90.24 lakh Bengali-speaking people, both Hindus and Muslims, in the state — 28.92% of total population, he said.
