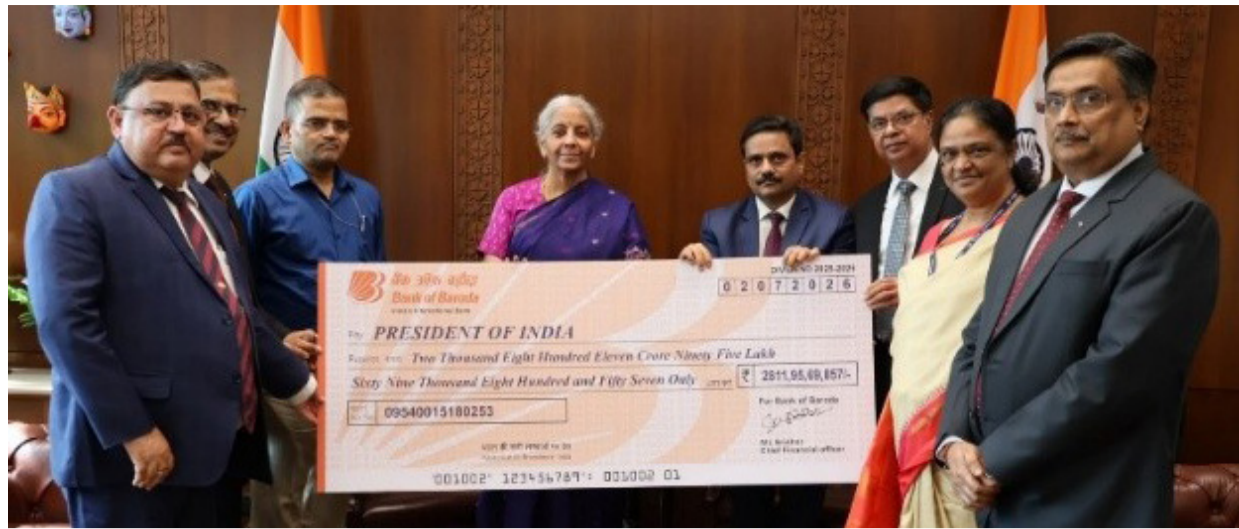

Bank of Baroda presents Rs. 2,811 crore dividend cheque to Finance Minister

Mumbai, June 29: Public sector lender Bank of Baroda presented a dividend cheque of Rs.2,811 crore to Union Finance and Corporate Affairs Minister Nirmala Sitharaman for the financial year ended March 31, 2026. The cheque was handed over by Dr. Debadatta Chand, Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer of Bank of Baroda, in the presence of Sanjay Lohiya, Secretary, Department of Financial Services (DFS), and the bank's Executive Directors Lalit

Tyagi, Sanjay Mudaliar, Lal Singh, and Beena Vaheed.

The dividend payout reflects the bank's robust financial performance during FY 2025-26 and its continued focus on delivering long-term value to stakeholders. The bank declared a dividend of Rs.8.50 per equity share, equivalent to 425 per cent of the face value of Rs.2 per share. FY 2025-26 proved to be a milestone year for Bank of Baroda, which reported its highest-ever standalone annual net profit

of Rs.20,021 crore, crossing the Rs.20,000 crore mark for the first time in its history.

Chennai, June 30: The Tamil Nadu Sports Development Authority (SDAT) has invited online applications for the 2026 Chief Minister's State Youth Award, which recognises outstanding voluntary service by young people towards social development. The last date to apply is 5.45 pm on July 6.

The awards will be presented during the Independence Day celebrations on August 15, 2026. Every year, three men and three

women are selected for the honour.

Each awardee will receive a cash prize of Rs 1 lakh, a medal and a certificate of appreciation.

Applicants must be between 15 and 35 years of age, having completed 15 years as of April 1, 2025, and not crossed 35 years as of March 31, 2026. Only voluntary service carried out between April 1, 2025, and March 31, 2026, will be considered.

Candidates must have been residents of Tamil Nadu for

at least five years and should have undertaken measurable and verifiable voluntary service for the welfare of society. Employees of Central or State governments, public sector undertakings, universities, colleges and schools are not eligible to apply.

Chennai, June 30: Applications are being accepted online for admission to the B.E. Degree Programme for Working Professionals (formerly Part-Time B.E.) offered by the Directorate of Technical Education (DOTE) for the 2026-27 academic year. The last date to apply is 5 pm on July 12.

The programme is offered at six Government Engineering Colleges in Coimbatore, Salem, Tirunelveli, Bargur, Vellore and Karaikudi, and two Government-aided institutions

Rajnath Singh unveils new financial powers framework for DRDO

New Delhi, June 30: Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Monday unveiled the Delegation of Financial Powers to DRDO 2026 (DFP-2026), a major reform aimed at improving efficiency, accountability and the timely execution of strategic defence research and development projects.

Launching the revised framework, Singh said DFP-2026 would accelerate the development, production and induction of indigenous defence systems, platforms and technologies into the Armed Forces. He added that the reforms would strengthen collaboration between DRDO,

industry and academia, advancing the vision of Aatmanirbhar Bharat and enhancing India's defence preparedness.

The new framework significantly expands financial and administrative powers within the Department of Defence Research and Development. It provides dedicated financial provisions for trial campaigns, testing and evaluation activities, authorises funding for pre-project R&D initiatives, and clearly defines financial powers for grants related to Extra-Mural Research Projects, Defence Innovation Accelerator-Centres of Excellence and Technology Development Fund

projects.

The Defence Minister said the revised delegation of financial powers would help ensure faster decision-making, improve project execution and promote greater self-reliance in defence technologies.

Chief of Defence Staff General N. S. Raja Subramani, Defence Secretary and DRDO Chairman Rajesh Kumar Singh, Secretary (Defence Production) Sanjeev Kumar, Secretary (Ex-Servicemen Welfare) Sukriti Likhi, Controller General of Defence Accounts Anugraha Narayana Das, and other senior defence officials attended the event in New Delhi.
