3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

ITEM NO. 1: TO APPOINT MR. VIJAY KUMAR SINGH (DIN: 07603392) AS AN INDEPENDENT DIRECTOR OF THE COMPANY

The Board of Directors on the recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee ('NRC') in their meeting held on May 28, 2026, approved the appointment of Mr. Vijay Kumar Singh (DIN: 07603392) as an Additional Director (Independent) of the Company for a term of five years commencing from May 28, 2026 to May 27, 2031, not liable to retire by rotation, subject to approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution.

The Company has received requisite disclosures / declarations from Mr. Vijay Kumar Singh including-

- Consent in writing to act as Director in Form DIR-2 pursuant to rule 8 of the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014;
- Disclosure of interest under Section 184(1) of the Act in Form MBP-1;
- Intimation in Form DIR-8 pursuant to rule 14 of the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014, that he is not disqualified in accordance with Section 164 of the Companies Act, 2013;
