- On November 21, 2025, the Government of India notified provisions of the Code on Wages, 2019, the Industrial Relations Code, 2020, the Code on Social Security, 2020, and the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 which consolidate 29 existing labour laws into a unified framework governing employee benefits during employment and post-employment. The Ministry of Labour & Employment published draft Central Rules and FAQs to enable assessment of the financial impact due to the new Labour Codes. The Group has assessed and disclosed the incremental impact of these changes on the basis of best information available, consistent with the guidance provided by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. These changes have resulted in an increase in employee benefits of INR 290.02 crores in the statement. Considering the materiality and regulatory-driven, non-recurring nature of this development, the Group has presented such incremental impact as "Exceptional item" in the consolidated statement of profit and loss for the year ended March 31, 2026. The Group continues to monitor the finalization of Central/State Rules and clarifications from the Government on various other aspects of the New Labour Codes and would give appropriate accounting effect of such developments in the period in which they are notified.

### Narayana Announces Rs 200 Cr Expansion Plan



Narayana Educational Institutions has announced a Rs 200 crore expansion for the 2026-27 academic year, adding 38 new campuses across six states to strengthen its national presence.

The expansion spans Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu and Madhya Pradesh.

Andhra Pradesh leads with 15 new campuses, followed by Telangana with 10, while Maharashtra, Gujarat, Tamil Nadu and Madhya Pradesh will see additional schools, junior colleges and coaching centres. With this, Narayana's total network will reach 952 campuses nationwide.

The expansion includes 26 schools, 9 junior colleges and 3 coaching centres, aimed at enhancing access to quality education through modern infrastructure, digital learning and personalised mentoring.

President Puneet Kothapa said the initiative aligns with the vision of establishing a Narayana campus in every district, ensuring wider reach and opportunities for students across the country.

### Crypto Tracks Global Risk Mood Amid US-Iran Tensions

Crypto markets are reacting in line with global risk sentiment following a pause in the US-Iran conflict, according to Giottus CEO Vikram Subburaj. Bitcoin hovered near \$72,000 on April 8, while Ethereum rose to the \$2,200-\$2,250 range. Major altcoins such as Solana and XRP gained 4-6%.

Subburaj noted that crypto is behaving like a macro-sensitive risk asset rather than a geopolitical hedge. During March's escalation, Bitcoin remained range-bound between \$60,000 and \$70,000, reflecting cautious investor sentiment.

He identified three key triggers ahead: stability of the ceasefire, US macroeconomic data and Federal Reserve policy, and consistency in ETF inflows. Brent crude's sharp fall post-ceasefire indicates improving risk appetite, though volatility remains.

Subburaj advised investors to avoid chasing rallies and adopt staggered investments, such as SIPs, to manage potential market shocks.

### Azad Engineering Opens New Facility in Hyderabad



Azad Engineering inaugurated a 7,600 sq. m. lean manufacturing facility at its Centre of Excellence in Tunikibollam, Hyderabad, dedicated to supporting global energy major Baker Hughes. The facility aligns with global manufacturing standards and strengthens a strategic partnership that began in 2018.

The inauguration was attended by Telangana Industries Minister D. Sridhar Babu and senior industry leaders. Designed for high-precision, high-volume production, the unit will employ around 230 skilled professionals and focus on advanced components for industrial and energy technology applications.

Company officials said the facility reflects Azad's commitment to scaling capabilities through vertical integration, advanced quality systems and skilled talent. Baker Hughes noted that the expansion enhances its global supply chain resilience. The new unit marks Azad Engineering's fourth dedicated facility, reinforcing its growing role in global precision manufacturing and India's expanding engineering ecosystem.

### Ports Championship Inaugurated at Vizag

The 44th All India Major Ports Body Building and Weight Lifting Championships 2025-26 was inaugurated on April 23 at the Sagaramala Convention Centre. The event was formally opened by Smt. Roshni Aparanji Korati, IAS, Deputy Chairperson of Visakhapatnam Port Authority, along with senior officials.

Addressing participants, the Deputy Chairperson encouraged fair play and urged organisers to ensure proper arrangements for all teams. The event witnessed active participation from officials and members of the port's sports fraternity. Information was shared with the media by Sri Sankar Babu, Secretary, VPA.

### Neo Commits Rs 300 Crore to Hyderabad Housing Project



Neo Alternative Asset Managers has committed Rs 300 crore in structured debt to fund Atlantis at Narsingi, a premium residential project being developed by VRise Developers in West Hyderabad. The project, backed by The Vasavi Group, is a RERA-approved gated community comprising eight high-rise towers with 2,199 apartments across multiple configurations, including Sky Villas.

Strategically located near Gachibowli and the Financial District, Atlantis offers connectivity to key employment hubs and the Outer Ring Road. The development features over 70% open spaces, landscaped greens, and more than 50 lifestyle amenities. Company officials said the funding will accelerate construction and ensure timely delivery. Neo highlighted Hyderabad's strong residential demand and infrastructure growth as key drivers behind the investment, reinforcing confidence in the city's real estate market and the project's long-term value proposition.

### Bondada Engineering Posts Strong FY26 Growth



Bondada Engineering Limited reported a robust financial performance for FY 2025-26, with revenue rising 81% year-on-year to Rs 2,843 crore from Rs 1,571 crore in the previous fiscal. The growth was driven by strong execution and expansion across renewable energy, telecom, and railways.

Profit After Tax surged 86% to Rs 211 crore, reflecting improved cost efficiency and operating leverage. The company also reported a significant turnaround in cash flow from operations, moving from a negative Rs 141 crore last year to a positive Rs 125 crore, indicating stronger financial discipline. In Q4, revenue grew 28% to Rs 914 crore, while profit increased 13% to Rs 63 crore. Chairman and Managing Director Bondada Raghavendra Rao said the results highlight consistent execution and a strong order book.

It has been delivered in both practice and combat configurations, strengthening naval capabilities under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat initiative.

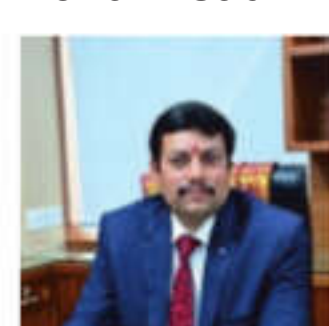


The system features advanced homing and propulsion technologies, along with enhanced search, attack and re-attack capabilities, significantly boosting the operational strength of the Indian Navy.
