**Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the “Listing Regulations”)**

Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para B of Part A of Schedule III of the Listing Regulations, SEBI Master Circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024 and SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-2/CIR/P/2024/185 dated December 31, 2024, we hereby inform you that the Hon’ble High Court of Chhattisgarh has disposed off the Writ Petition filed by the Company, thereby giving liberty to the Company to pursue the pending case before the Collector of Stamps, Raipur.

The case relates to the deed of conveyance dated November 1, 1999, executed between the transferor and the Company (transferee), involving transfer of cement plant at Sonadih. The Company had paid the requisite stamp duty and had also undertaken necessary registration of the deed. Subsequently, the Collector of Stamps, Raipur, initiated *suo moto* proceedings under Section 47-A(3) of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, alleging undervaluation of the property. The Company against the said action of the Collector of Stamps had filed a Writ Petition before the Hon’ble High Court of Chhattisgarh. The Hon’ble High Court vide interim order dated February 15, 2002, allowed the Collector of Stamps, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, to complete the enquiry but refrain from passing any final order until the Writ Petition was disposed off.

The Hon’ble High Court has now disposed off the said Writ Petition, thereby giving liberty to the Company to pursue the pending case before the Collector of Stamps, Raipur.
