**Sub: Revised Intimation under Regulation 30 read with Para A of Part A of Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015**

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, we hereby inform that the Company has received an Order from the Office of the Principal Commissioner of Central Tax, GST Commissionerate, Bengaluru East on March 21, 2025 raising demand on certain issues along with interest and levied penalty of Rs. 2,21,63,065/-.

This penalty has been imposed in accordance with Section 74(1) of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (“CGST Act”) / Karnataka Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (“KGST Act”).

Further, the details as required under Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with Schedule III and the SEBI Master Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD2/CIR/P/0155 dated November 11, 2024, on the above-mentioned penalty issue is enclosed as Annexure.
