New Delhi: The Centre is restructuring the PM Gati Shakti governance framework, with plans to dissolve the Network Planning Group (NPG) and create a new overarching institution in the Cabinet Secretariat to coordinate India's transport infrastructure development.

The Integrated Transport Planning Authority, likely to be called GatiShakti Transport Planning and Research Organisation (GTPRO), will lay out a medium-to-long-term road map for each transport ministry—roads, railways, shipping and aviation. "Integrated five-year and ten-year plans will be put in place for each transport ministry, linking into the larger vision of the government to develop a world-class infrastructure in the country as

India aspires to be a developed nation by 2047," a senior government official told ET.

According to the official, this would mean an end to the NPG as it was not very effective.

"Ministries were often seen overriding the NPG, which resulted in delay in project appraisals," the official added. The department for promotion of industry and internal trade (DPIIT), under the ministry of commerce and industry, is likely to seek the Cabinet approval for setting up the authority.

The target is to make the new body functional from the next financial year. The authority is expected to be headed by a secretary-level officer, unlike the NPG which is under the control of a joint-secretary level officer.

Apart from preparing an integrated plan, the body will also appraise sectoral projects above

₹500 crore, monitor them and assess their impact.

The idea is to have a structured framework for master planning of transport development in the country and have a data repository that can help in future planning and policy interventions.

To be created on the lines of similar unified institutions in the US, UK and Germany, the Indian entity will come up with comprehensive, long-term strategies for transport-related sectors to reduce costs, increase efficiency, and

promote integrated multimodal corridors.

This will help break siloes, created by each individual ministry, which creates hindrance and delays national infrastructure development.

India currently has no apex body to deal with transportation as a whole and each ministry works on their own vision document, with no integrated or coherent medium-to-long plans in place, often resulting in disintegrated development.

Ministry for Replacing Closed Units in IIP Index

New Delhi: The statistics ministry has proposed replacing factories that have closed or changed their production lines in the new Index of Industrial Production (IIP) series, set to be released next year.

Under the proposed methodology, inactive units would be substituted with active ones that have at least 12 months of overlapping data to ensure continuity and comparability. Until overlapping data is obtained, nil or imputed values may temporarily be used in the series, according to a discussion paper released by the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Im-

plementation (MoSPI) on Tuesday. "This ensures the time series remains consistent and reflective of ongoing industrial activity," the ministry said in a statement. In the current IIP series, the weight of closed factories is around 8.9%, as per the discussion paper.

MoSPI is revising the IIP base year to 2022-23 from 2011-12, with weights based on the Annual Survey of Industries 2022-23. In the current series, manufacturing accounts for a weight of 77.633, followed by mining at 14.373 and electricity at 7.994.

Substitute factories will be selected from the latest ASI data and must meet three criteria: they should produce the same item.

Aim to Make India Global Hub for Green H₂: Joshi

New Delhi: The government aims to make India a global hub for green hydrogen production, use, and export through its National Green Hydrogen Mission, renewable energy minister Pralhad Joshi said on Tuesday.



Speaking at the International Green Hydrogen Conference, Joshi said that with the world adopting the Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism, green hydrogen is no longer just a choice but an economic necessity.

"The global economy is moving toward cleaner value chains, and those who adapt early will lead the markets of tomorrow," he said.

"Our industries and economies must make a shift towards sustainability. We have to ensure that our growth remains both

competitive and climate-resilient," he said, emphasizing the need to move to cleaner fuels. "I am especially proud that India is taking this transformation a step further. We are striving to power our entire green hydrogen production through renewable energy," he said. The cost of solar power in India is among the lowest in the world, and with rapidly expanding wind and hydro projects, the country is building a clean energy base that will drive the next great industrial revolution — the hydrogen revolution.

So far, under the mission, incentives have been awarded for 3,000 MW per year of domestic electrolyser manufacturing capacity and 8.62 lakh metric tonnes per year of green hydrogen production.

"India now has the lowest green ammonia price globally. Prices of ₹49.75/kg were discovered for the production and supply of 7.24 lakh metric tonnes per year of green ammonia," he said. Around ₹132 crore has been invested in five pilot projects for steel, and 37 hydrogen-fuelled vehicles and nine refuelling stations have been supported with ₹208 crore. The government has announced a fresh call for proposals for pilot projects that showcase cutting-edge technologies, including the utilisation of biomass to produce green hydrogen.

Assocham: Digitised Single-window System Needed for MSMEs

New Delhi: Digitised and time-bound single window systems along with consolidated annual MSME (micro, small and medium enterprises) compliance form combining multiple filings, will help improve the investment climate across states and improve competitiveness, Assocham said in the second phase of its study on 'Ease of Doing Business in the Indian States'.

The industry body suggested functional single window systems in states such as West Bengal, Odisha and Andhra Pradesh, with fixed approval timelines.

The report presented detailed state-level insights from 18 states including Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Gujarat, Haryana, Kerala, Maharashtra, Odisha and Punjab. It suggested a five-year tax holiday for recognised startups in Bihar, releasing underutilised land with public sector undertakings and government in Goa for industrial use, delegating pre-approval checks to certified third-party professionals and giving final approvals to technical experts instead of commissioners in Gujarat, and developing new industrial zones through public-private partnership besides a special purpose vehicle for each industrial estate in Jammu and Kashmir. "By streamlining approvals and

reducing bureaucratic delays, such systems can greatly enhance efficiency and transparency," it said while recommending simplifying land-use and zoning procedures, rationalising approval fees and strengthening last-mile infrastructure, particularly access to electricity, roads and water, to improve overall business competitiveness.

"While there have been notable policy reforms and simplification of processes such as for GST (goods and servi-

ces tax) recently, businesses still navigate multiple layers of compliances and approvals," said Nirmal Minda, president, Assocham. It suggested converting most compliances to self-declaration, with others requiring self-declaration plus proof of compliance, allowing companies to start construction, operations and hiring based on self-certification or self-undertaking, exemption from penalty for first-time defaulters and simplified approval process for loans and guarantees by MSMEs. "The Kerala Loading and Unloading Act should be repealed to allow for labour flexibility, mechanization, and to eliminate non-transparent cash demands," it suggested to Kerala along with moving to a 10-year factory and trade licence model.

To Maharashtra, it recommended that the government not only allow green cover on industrial land but also allow it on a separate patch of land and a "pay-per-use" model for water charges.

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केवायसी ऑपची अद्याप प्रतीक्षाच

रणधुमाळी सुरु; तरी 'महाआयटी'कडून विलंब

मुंबई : राज्यात स्थानिक स्वराज्य संस्थांच्या निवडणुकांची रणधुमाळी सुरु झाली असून नगरपरिषद आणि नगरपंचायतींसाठी दोन दिवसांत हजारोच्या आसपास उमेदवारांनी अर्ज भरले आहेत. राज्य निवडणूक आयोगाकडून अर्ज ऑनलाइन भरून घेण्यात येत आहेत. परंतु, मतदारांना त्यांचे नाव आणि उमेदवाराविषयी माहिती मिळावी, यासाठीचे 'नो यूअर कॅंडिडेट' (केवायसी) हे अॅप अद्याप सुरु झालेले नाही. 'महाआयटी' या संस्थेकडून हे अॅप विकसित करून देण्यात येत असून तांत्रिक कारणांमुळे त्याला आणखी काही विलंब होणार असल्याचे आयोगामधील सूत्रांनी स्पष्ट केले.

यादीची निवडणूक ही मतदारांच्याच्या मुद्द्यावरून गाजत आहे. अनेकांची नावे जाणीवपूर्वक वगळण्यात आल्याचा, तर काहींची घुसविण्यात आल्याचा आरोप विरोधी पक्षांकडून केला जात आहे. राज्यातील १४६ नगरपरिषदा व ४२ नगरपंचायतींच्या सदस्यपदांसाठी निवडणूक घेणित झाली असून १० नोव्हेंबरपासून त्यासाठी अर्ज भरण्यासाठी सुरुवात झाली आहे. अवघ्या दोन दिवसांत राज्यभरातून हजारोंच्या आसपास अर्ज दाखल झाले आहेत. या निवडणुकांच्या

हे अॅप मतदारांच्या सोयीसाठी असून ते निवडणूक प्रक्रिया सुरु होण्याआधी लोकार्पण पोहोचणे अपेक्षित होते. खासकरून ग्रामीण भागात, सर्वसामान्य मतदारांच्या हाती स्मार्टफोनवर या अॅपच्या माध्यमातून उमेदवारांविषयी काही मिनिटांत माहिती उपलब्ध होणार आहे. अजूनही हे अॅप विकसित झालेले नाही. सध्या मतदार राज्य निवडणूक आयोगाच्या वेबसाइटच्या माध्यमातून मतदारायादीत आपले नाव शोधू शकतात, असे या अधिकाऱ्याने स्पष्ट केले. मतदान केंद्रनिहाय मतदारायाद्या प्रसिद्ध होण्याआधी या अॅपचे लोकार्पण व्हावे, अशी अपेक्षा असल्याचेही या अधिकाऱ्याने स्पष्ट केले.

पार्श्वभूमीवर, राज्य निवडणूक आयोगाने मतदारांसाठी विशेष अॅप विकसित करणार असल्याचे स्पष्ट केले होते. मतदारांना मतदारायादीत नाव शोधणे अधिक सुलभ व्हावे, त्याचबरोबर आपले मतदान केंद्रदेखील शोधता यावे, तसेच उमेदवारांनी अर्जसोबत जोडलेली शपथपत्रे तपासून त्यांची गुहेगारीविषयक पार्श्वभूमी, शैक्षणिक व आर्थिक परिस्थिती मतदारांना आपल्या मोबाइलवर पाहता यावी, यासाठी हे अॅप विकसित

करण्यात येत होते. हे अॅप विकसित करण्याचे काम राज्याच्या 'महाआयटी' कडे देण्यात आले होते. परंतु, निवडणूक प्रक्रिया सुरु होऊनही अद्याप या अॅपची प्रतीक्षाच आहे. आयोगाच्या सूत्रांनी दिलेल्या माहितीनुसार, या अॅपची तयारी अंतिम टप्प्यात आली असून काही किरकोळ तांत्रिक कारणांमुळे ते रवडल्याचे कळते. परंतु, या विलंबामुळे आयोगातील अधिकारी कमाळीचे नाराज असून त्याविषयी उघड नाराजी व्यक्त करत असल्याचे दिसून येत आहे.

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Kit to make finding urinary tract infections quick, cheap

Bhavnagar Scientists Develop 9-Hour Detection Kit

Rajkot: Detection of urinary tract infection (UTI), one of the most common infections, especially among women, is set to become quicker with a pathbreaking innovation by scientists in Bhavnagar.

A team of researchers at CSIR-Central Salt & Marine Chemicals Research Institute (CSMCRI), Bhavnagar, have developed a low-cost, rapid test kit that will detect UTIs in just 9 hours — a process that typically takes more than a day using conventional methods.

U-AST (Urinary Antibiotic Susceptibility Test) kit was developed by Saumya Haldar and Maheshwari J. Behere, who led a team of microbiologists and biochemists at

CSMCRI. The gold standard for UTI diagnosis is considered to be urine microscopy, culture, and sensitivity testing in a pathology laboratory.

The total duration of the complete analysis from infection determination to bacterial antibiotic-sensitivity testing typically requires 36 to 72 hours, and the laboratory cost is between Rs 1,000 to 3,000. This test requires trained technicians and controlled lab environments that are not available in rural and some semi-urban areas. The manufacturing cost of the kit is only Rs 50.

"UTIs are among the most common bacterial infections worldwide, but in rural India,

timely diagnosis is a challenge. Our kit allows health workers to detect infection and antibiotic sensitivity within a single working day, enabling faster, more targeted treatment," said Haldar.

According to CSMCRI, the U-AST kit has received all clinical validation, and they are in talks with some companies to start mass production for its use on a big commercial scale.

The kit uses a colorimetric micro-well for mat — meaning colour changes indicate bacterial growth and antibiotic response — and requires minimal equipment, making it suitable for primary health centres and rural clinics.

The team designed the kit not only to identify UTIs quickly but also to assess bacterial resistance to commonly used antibiotics.

This feature is crucial in combating antimicrobial resistance (AMR). "Empirical use of antibiotics without laboratory confirmation has been a serious issue in rural healthcare," said Behere. "With U-AST, we're providing a solu-

tion that empowers local practitioners to prescribe antibiotics based on evidence rather than assumption."

K B Pandey, a principal scientist at CSMCRI, added, "As the kit doesn't rely on high-end instruments or cold-chain logistics, it can be distributed widely and operated by basic healthcare workers after minimal training."

"Early and accurate detection of UTIs can significantly reduce complications like kidney infections and prevent hospitalizations," said Kannan Srinivasan, the Director of the CSIR-CSMCRI, Bhavnagar.

A paper detailing the results of this work was recently published in a journal of the Royal Society of Chemistry.

For the study, researchers tested 50 anonymous urine samples from patients at Neuberg Suprathech Reference Laboratories, Ahmedabad, to check how well the new kit works. Each sample was split into two parts — one tested using the standard lab culture method and the other with the new U-AST kit.

Dispute over terrace leads to attack

Her neighbours allegedly confronted her outside her residence and objected to her using a portion of the shared terrace. The complainant told police that the area in question was a common facility accessible to all residents, but the argument soon escalated into a heated exchange.

During the altercation, the neighbours allegedly abused and assaulted her, during which her gold chain broke and fell to the ground, resulting in a loss of about Rs 10,000.

Police have registered a case for assault, use of abusive language, and causing damage, and have begun further investigation.

Sand mafia frees truck from woman officer near Kalol

Ahmedabad: In a brazen display of impunity, members of the sand mining mafia on Monday afternoon took away a fully laden truck which woman govt officer and her team had intercepted and seized on the Gandhinagar-Kalol highway.

The officer from the geology and mining department, Devyani Jadeja, later filed a complaint with Kalol police alleging how the mafia obstructed her from carrying out duties, and threatened her.

Jadeja and her team — driver Vipul Raval and a security guard — were conducting routine checks when they spotted a dumper truck loaded with 43.440 metric tonnes of sand, the officer found out after having it weighed at the unit's weighbridge. According to protocol, Jadeja proceeded to take it to the collector's compound in Gandhinagar for legal action.

But the team had no intention of letting what was about to unfold would be nothing short of a dramatic highway heist involving bikers and SUVs, all sent by the mafia to free the impounded vehicle. The officer's convoy had just passed Ambedkar crossroads in Kalol when it was intercepted by two mo-



torcycles carrying three men, who signalled the dumper driver to stop.

One of them, clad in a red T-shirt, claiming to be the owner's representative, questioned Jadeja's action, and showing blatant disregard for law, allegedly directed the driver to step on the pedal and drive away. As the officer and her team chased it, a black and white SUV moved in to block their way.

The officer later found the truck dumping the sand near Lakshminagar Society in Kalol. As she tried to approach it, a metallic grey car and a white hatchback entered the scene, and a man from one of the vehicles aggressively banged on the govt vehicle's window, hurled abuses and threats before making a swift getaway. Jadeja has alleged.

Kalol taluka police registered a complaint under the Gujarat Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining, Storage and Transportation) Rules, 2017, and Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957.

ASI booked for assaulting wife in Amreli

The ASI then allegedly started abusing and assaulting her. When she tried to defend herself, both allegedly thrashed her.

Ahmedabad: Want certified copies of records from the revenue department portal? You will need a credit card to pay or will face inconvenience like many other citizens. Applicants seeking certified documents including 7/12 extracts are complaining that the department has stopped taking all online payments, except through credit card.

As not everyone uses a credit card, access to records has become an uphill task. Applicants say it's been 15 days since other pay-

ment modes, including UPI, have stopped.

The state revenue department implemented the Integrated Online Revenue Application (iORA), through which applicants could obtain certified copies of revenue records by paying the requisite fees online including UPI.

Advocate Dipak Patel said, "Applicants and advocates would obtain certified copies of revenue records through the iORA. The system had online payment options, including UPI. For the last 15 days, this official website has been accepting online payments only via credit card, while UPI payments have been stopped. Applicants who don't have a credit card are currently facing trouble getting copies of records."

He added, "The state and central govt promote digital payments. The online system was put in place so that citizens would not have to visit

govt offices to obtain revenue records, including the 7/12. However, for the last 15 days, UPI has been disabled for online payments, causing inconvenience to applicants. Attempts to contact the helpline numbers provided on the website have been made repeatedly, but no one answers the mobile or landline numbers. There is a demand to urgently restore the UPI payments facility."

In response, a revenue department official requesting anonymity said, "This will be investigated, and the system improved if citizens are facing difficulties."

BLS denied liability, said its role limited to sticking visas

At the hearing, the logistics company remained unrepresented. BLS International argued that the complainant had signed an undertaking absolving it of responsibility for damage during transit and claimed its role was limited to affixing visa stickers, not handling deliveries.

Kanga's advocate countered that both firms were liable, as BLS International had appointed the logistics company to ensure safe delivery. After reviewing argu-

ments, the forum held both firms responsible. It observed:

"The logistics firm delivers documents that are important internationally. A passport is a fragile document, and it should be packed with care. However, it was packed in a simple cover, which led to damage during the throwing of parcels during transport. In this case, the logistics firm failed to handle the passport with care, committing a serious mistake and carelessness. So, they are liable to pay Rs 1.05 lakh with 9% interest to the complainant."

BLS International is an international firm related to visa processing.

"So, they should appoint a logistics firm that handles fragile documents with care, but they failed to do so. Therefore, BLS International must pay Rs 10,000 to the complainant as a fine, as he incurred a significant loss."

Kanga's wife had filed a separate claim for Rs 1.08 lakh, citing losses due to her inability to travel. However, the forum rejected it, noting that her passport was intact and the firms were not responsible for her ticket purchase.

₹1.73L theft a day after house party

Ahmedabad: A 51-year-old contractor from Chandkheda has reported the theft of gold jewellery worth Rs 1.73 lakh from his home — a day after hosting a get-together for his relatives, friends, and neighbours. The incident came to light following a complaint lodged with Chandkheda police on Monday.

According to the FIR, on Oct 25, the complainant had organised a gathering at his residence in Mote-

ra, attended by around 32 guests. The event went on until after midnight. The next afternoon, the complainant's wife reportedly found an earring belonging to her sister-in-law in their bedroom, which aroused suspicion.

When the women checked the cupboards in their respective rooms, they discovered that several jewellery boxes containing gold ornaments were missing. The stolen items, including gold jewellery sets, chains, and other ornaments, were

valued at Rs 1.73 lakh, the complainant stated.

Initially, the family chose not to file a police complaint, hoping the missing ornaments might have been misplaced or would be returned after informal discussions with guests who had attended the party. However, when the items could not be located despite repeated inquiries, they decided to approach the police.

The Chandkheda police have registered an FIR under relevant sections of the BNS pertaining to theft.

Row over GU's temporary hiring of 47 assistant profs

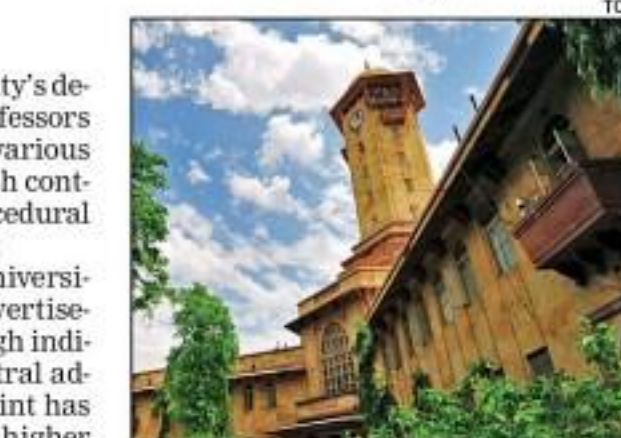

Ahmedabad: Gujarat University's decision to recruit 47 assistant professors on a temporary basis across various departments has sparked a fresh controversy with allegations of procedural lapses and lack of transparency.

According to sources, the university did not issue any official advertisement for the posts, either through individual departments or the central administration. A formal complaint has now been submitted to the state higher education department, questioning the legality of the appointments.

Critics point out that the Gujarat University Act does not contain provisions for hiring assistant professors on a temporary or contractual basis, making the process potentially irregular. The complaint alleges that the recruitment was carried out without a public notification, denying equal opportunity to eligible candidates and allegedly favouring individuals with personal or political ties.

The issue has revived memories of a 2018 case in the university's MSW department, where a contractual appointment was declared invalid by the process illegal.



quity committee. The GU syndicate reportedly recommended action against officials involved in 2023.

A retired professor, citing that precedent, has demanded the immediate cancellation of all new appointments and the filing of a police complaint against those responsible. The representation also alleges that some of the selected candidates had only submitted their PhD theses and were still appointed at a monthly salary of Rs 45,000.

It has further been claimed that no formal selection committees were constituted, and some department heads refused to participate, calling the process illegal.

Chhattisgarh gets MoUs for ₹33k crore in investments

Ahmedabad: Chhattisgarh received investment proposals worth approximately Rs 33,000 crore during the Investor Connect Programme held in Ahmedabad on Tuesday. Chhattisgarh chief minister Vishnu Deo Sai handed over investment letters to leading companies in sectors such as thermal power, green steel manufacturing, solar cells, pharmaceuticals, and medical food supplements. The proposed investments are expected to generate more than 10,000 jobs in the state.

Torrent Power Ltd has proposed to set up a 1,600MW thermal power plant at a cost of Rs 22,900 crore in Chhattisgarh, and Torrent Pharmaceuticals Ltd has proposed an investment of Rs 200 crore to establish a pharmaceutical

manufacturing unit. Other companies which have signed MoUs with Chhattisgarh include Leezyon Life Sciences Pvt Ltd (Rs 101 crore), Onix Three Ener-sol Pvt Ltd (Rs 9,000 crore), and Mala Creation Pvt Ltd (Rs 700 crore).

MoUs were also signed by Shalby Hospitals (Rs 300 crore) and Sapphire Semicon Pvt Ltd (Rs 120 crore).

Vadilal Group, Welspun Group, and Jade Bluc have expressed interest in investing in Chhattisgarh.

Sai held discussions with leading industrialists on investment opportunities in Chhattisgarh. "Gujarat and Chhattisgarh together will play a significant role in shaping a developed India," he said. "While Gujarat has enterprises, Chhattisgarh has energy, minerals, a skilled workforce, and an investor-friendly industrial policy."
