4	Details of the violation(s)/ contravention(s) committed or alleged to be committed;	Alleged disallowance of GST Input Tax Credit claimed in the GST return .The demand order is for the period from April 2021 to March 2022.

As per Section 16 of the CGST Act, 2017, a registered person is eligible to claim Input Tax Credit (ITC) on services used for business, subject to possession of a valid tax invoice or other prescribed tax-paying documents, and actual receipt of the services. The Company had reiterated this position in its additional submission filed in response to the SCN.
		Based on the Company's assessment, the aforesaid demand is not sustainable. The Company is evaluating all available options, including filing an appeal against the order, as it has been passed without adequately considering the crucial clarification provided under Section 16 of the CGST Act, 2017.
		The Company does not anticipate any material impact on its financials, operations, or other activities arising from this matter.
