Indian among 12 killed in latest Russian attacks on Ukraine

AN INDIAN citizen was among 12 people killed in the latest Russian attacks on Ukraine, President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said on Tuesday, as drones and ballistic missiles struck several cities in the eastern European nation, damaging residential buildings and civil-

ian infrastructure.

Since Monday evening, guided aerial bomb and drone strikes have continued against Odessa city and surrounding region, Zelenskyy wrote on X.

“Overall, 12 people were killed, among them an Indian citizen,” he said.

Zelenskyy said dozens of people were injured in the attacks, which also hit Kyiv,

Odesa, Kherson, Donetsk, Zaporizhzhia, Kharkiv, Chernihiv, Zhytomyr, Sumy and Dni-pro regions.

In Kyiv, seven people were killed in a strike on a railway depot. In Boryspil, a five-storey residential building was damaged, and 50 people were evacuated, while four people were killed and 13 injured in the city, Zelenskyy said.

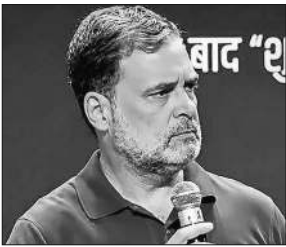
BJP, ‘Vote Chori Aayog’ change tactics to win at any cost, says Rahul Gandhi

WITH 2.07 crore of 9.78 crore electors in Maharashtra being deleted in draft rolls during Special Intensive Revisions (SIR), Leader of the Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday said that the BJP and the “Vote Chori Aayog” keep changing their tactics, and they will continue to do so for “BJP’s victory at any cost”.

“The BJP and the ‘Vote Chori Aayog’ keep changing their tactics, and they will continue to do so — the goal remains just one: BJP’s victory at any cost, and the end of India’s democracy,” Gandhi said in a post in Hindi on X.

Gandhi, who has repeatedly targeted the Election Commission over the last two years, referred to the Maharashtra As-

sembly and Lok Sabha elections in 2024, saying, “Maharashtra 2024 — Suddenly, 3.9 million new voters were added between the Lok Sabha and Vidhan Sabha elections. I said it then, and I say it today: This was vote theft.”

Then he mentioned West Bengal SIR before the Assembly polls, which saw BJP storming to power. “Of the names struck off in the SIR, 91% had to be rein-

stated after appeals. That means 9 out of every 10 names were wrongly deleted, and added back only after the election. I said it then, and I say it today: This was vote theft,” he said.

Gandhi said that now in Maharashtra, “2.07 crore voters have been removed from the draft list — that’s every fifth voter. Lok Sabha 2024: 9.29 crore; Vidhan Sabha 2024: 9.7 crore; SIR 2026: 7.78 crore...

Which list was correct?”

Hitting out at the BJP, he said, “For a government built on vote theft, the people are not important — that’s why this BJP neither listens to the people nor obeys their command.”

Congress president and Leader of the Opposition in Rajya Sabha, Mallikarjun Kharge, said that “where it suits the BJP, voters are added. Where it doesn’t, votes are split to perpetrate vote theft”. “The BJP’s conspiracy to hollow out Indian democracy by stealing votes is coming out into the open,” said Kharge. “Instead of acting as the guardian of fair elections, the Election Commission is functioning like the ‘Save BJP’s Chair Commission,’” he said.

“The country is now unit-

ing against vote theft... The nation has understood the BJP’s conspiracy. The thief has been caught... Punishment will surely be meted out for holding democracy captive,” Kharge said in a post on X.

After referring to draft rolls in Maharashtra and Bengal, Kharge said that the “same game is being repeated in Delhi. Voters were increased before the Assembly elections, then names of 4.756 million voters vanished from the draft list, and preparations are underway to issue notices to 3.3 million other voters.”

According to the draft electoral rolls published Monday, around 47.56 lakh of 1.45 crore voters were removed. At 33%, it’s the “highest percentage” of deletions at the draft stage when compared to other states/UTs.

AGENCY PROBES Rs 28 CRORE SCAM

Rice allocation ‘scam’: CBI books former FCI officials, 3 companies

THE CBI has registered an FIR against former officials of the Food Corporation of India (FCI), Delhi Region, officials of the North Eastern Regional Agricultural Marketing Corporation Ltd (NERAMAC), private traders and public servants in connection with an alleged conspiracy involving the allocation and lifting of rice under the open market sale scheme (domestic), causing a wrongful losses of Rs 28.87 crore to the FCI. The case, registered by the CBI’s Anti-Corruption unit last week, names eight accused persons, including two companies based in Assam and another in Kolkata.

According to the FIR, FCI Delhi Region allegedly allotted a total of 62,000 metric tonnes of rice to NERAMAC under the category sale of rice to state government/corporations of state governments under OMSS (D) 2025-26.

Of this, around 50,645 metric tonnes was lifted by NERAMAC at a concessional rate of Rs 23,200 per metric tonne.

The FIR states that the prevailing reserve price of rice was Rs 28,900 per metric tonne.

It alleges that NERAMAC, being a government of India-owned enterprise, was not eligible for such allocation without e-auction under the OMSS(D) policy dated July 10, 2025. According to the CBI, only state governments and corporations of state governments were eligible for allocation without e-auction.

The agency has alleged that if the quantity lifted by NERAMAC at the concessional price had been sold through auction at the reserve price, the FCI would have realised an additional Rs 28.87 crore.

The complaint was forwarded to the CBI by Rizwan Ahmed, Section Officer (Vigilance), Department of Food and Public Distribution, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, along with reports of a Neutral Committee and FCI’s vigilance wing.

The Neutral Committee had been constituted to examine the allotment of rice to NERAMAC by FCI’s Delhi Region.

NERAMAC had sought allocation of 31,000 MT of rice per week under OMSS (D), the FIR says, adding that the rice was meant to ensure availability at affordable rates to the public, daily-wage earners, labourers, migrant workers in Delhi, and persons not covered under the public distribution system due to non-availability of ration cards.

However, the CBI has alleged that the rice was not distributed for the stated purpose. Instead private entities and traders were allegedly used in the lifting and further sale of the rice, the FIR said.

The FIR alleges that the rice was not distributed to the intended beneficiaries but traders in Delhi-NCR were allegedly asked to lift it from FCI depots after depositing money at Rs 23.25 per kg into NERAMAC’s bank account and paying commission ranging from Rs 0.64 to Rs 2.50 per kg.

According to the FIR, the funds were remitted in advance into NERAMAC’s bank account and later transferred to FCI Delhi Region for allocation and release of rice after deducting administrative charges at 5 paise per kg.

The rice was lifted from FCI depots at Ghevra, Mayapuri and Narela, the FIR says. The CBI has alleged that the traders further sold the rice to other traders, earning huge profits.

SC closes suo motu case over NCERT textbook chapter on judiciary

THE SUPREME COURT on Tuesday closed suo motu proceedings pertaining to the contents of the class 8 NCERT textbook referring to corruption in the judiciary after it was informed that the chapter was withdrawn.

A bench comprising Chief Justice Surya Kant and Justices Joymalaya Bagchi and V Mohana took note that the controversial chapter has been replaced based on the revisions suggested by an expert panel constituted by the Centre. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta informed the apex court that the textbooks with the new chapter are in circulation.

The top court also clarified that a statement recorded in its May 22 order, that the curriculum had not been placed before the committee at all levels and therefore could not be termed a collective decision, was only the submission of Solicitor General Mehta and was neither an observation nor an order of the court.

The solicitor general clarified that he had not accused the academicians of not placing the curriculum before the committees.

The clarification came after senior advocate Arvind Datar, appearing for an academicians, submitted that the observations, if misconstrued as a judicial finding, will cause prejudice to them.
