The field "Mori" containing the well "Mori#5" was handed over to the Production enhancement contract (PEC) Operator M/s Deep Exploration services private limited (M/s DESPL) in the year 2025.</p> <p>A show cause notice was issued by APPCB (Andhra Pradesh Pollution Control Board) to Contractor M/s DESPL and ONGC for environmental violations including operating without obtaining Consent to Establish/ Consent to Operate and for causing air pollution and potential environmental damage.</p> <p>The APPCB has subsequently issued the "Stop Production Order" to the Mori #05 Well of Mori Field vide order dated 23.04.2026, received at evening in ONGC Rajahmundry Office on 24.04.2026.</p>

Date of receipt of direction or order, including any ad-interim or interim orders, or any other communication from the authority	<p>Order of APPCB was received by the Company at evening on 24.04.2026.</p> <p>As per the received order, APPCB in exercise of its powers vested under Section 33 (A) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 31 (A) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and amendments thereof, issued STOP PRODUCTION ORDER to M/s.ONGC Well Mori-5, Irusumanda (V), Malkipuram (M), Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema District to immediately stop all further operations of facility of the Company, in the interest of safeguarding public health and environment protection.</p>
4.	Details of violation(s) / contravention (s) committed or alleged to be committed	Environmental violations including operating without obtaining Consent to Establish/ Consent to Operate and for causing air pollution and potential environmental damage.

Impact on financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible	<p>Mori#5 well was drilled in March 1994 and was on production from Jan-1995 to Apr-2009. There is no production from the well since Apr-2009.</p> <p>Mori field was handed over to PEC - M/s. DESPL, vide NOA dated Sep-2024 for production enhancement. Subsequently, a zone transfer operation was planned by M/s. DESPL to recomplete the well in the leftover zone. During the workover job (WOJ), an uncontrolled blowout event occurred on 05.01.2026.</p> <p>The well was successfully capped on 10.01.2026 with the efforts of ONGC Crisis Management Team. Since then the well is closed.</p> <p>Considering the size and scale of the Company's operations, the impact is not considered significant. The Company intends to review the order in detail and respond accordingly.</p>
