Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Qualified Opinion:

We have audited the accompanying standalone quarterly financial results of M/s. **Orchasp Limited** for the quarter ended 31st March, 2025 and the year-to-date results for the period from 01-04-2024 TO 31-03-2025, attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these standalone financial results:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. except for the effects of matters described in the "Basis for Qualified Opinion" section of our report gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended 31st March, 2025 as well as the year to date results for the period from 01-04-2024 to 31-03-2025.





Basis for Qualified Opinion:

- (a) We refer to the carrying value of investments amounting to Rs. 6,825 lakhs in the Wholly Owned Subsidiary located in Portugal, Cybermate International, Unipessoal, LDA, which has remained non-operational for over four years. The subsidiary has defaulted in its statutory filings for the period, and the Portuguese authorities have consequently issued a notice for cancellation of its Certificate of Incorporation. In the absence of sufficient information and clarity on the subsidiary's operations and financial position, we are unable to comment on the appropriateness of the carrying value of the investment or determine whether a provision for impairment is required.
- (b) The Trade receivables and trade payables have been outstanding for a period exceeding six months. In the absence of external confirmations for trade payables, trade receivables, and various advances/loans, we are currently unable to determine the accuracy or recoverability/payability of these balances.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial results under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.





Emphasis of Matter Paragraph

We draw attention to the Note No. 5 of the Standalone Financial results, which discloses the foreign exchange variation upon balance conversion of 1 % Unsecured FCCBs excluding the accrued interest. Upon conversion of these 1 % Unsecured FCCBs, the number of shares of the company increased by 1697.09 lakhs and were duly issued during the financial year 2024-25. As at 31st March, 2025, the Share Capital of the Company is Rs. 6,391 lakhs.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Management's Responsibilities for the Standalone Financial Results:

These quarterly financial results as well as the year-to-date standalone financial results have been prepared on the basis of the interim financial statements. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation of these financial results that give a true and fair view of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34, 'Interim Financial Reporting' prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

We are considering transferring the investment to another subsidiary and rectifying the non-compliance. We have been provided the final amounts due and pending compliances after which we propose to transfer the investment to another subsidiary. We will be completing the compliances during the present quarter.

b. Non-Receipt of trade receivables and payables due for more than 6 months.

We are of the opinion that the delays have been caused due to adverse conditions prevailing in the business and financial markets. We have extended our timelines by another six months for realizing of debtors due to adverse market conditions.

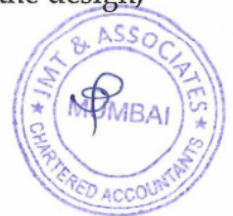

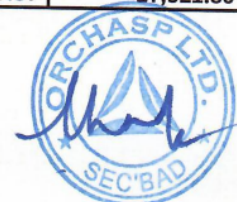
