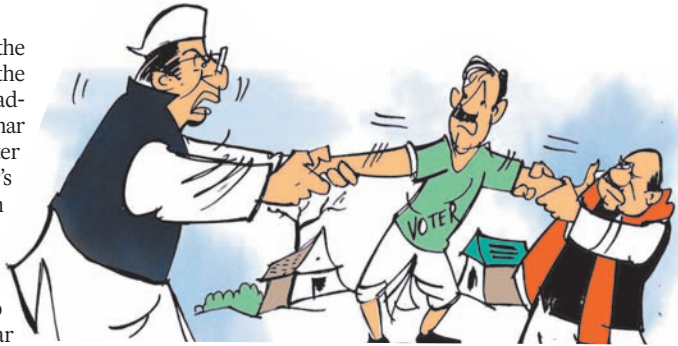

BIHAR POLLS POISED FOR A CLOSE FINISH?

FORECASTS AND PREDICTIONS VIS-A-VIS GROUND REALITIES

Neither the NDA nor the INDIA bloc wins the Welfare scheme advantage in Bihar. Tejaswi's 'har ghar sarkari naukri' counter balances Nitish Kumar's Mahila Rozgar yojna, then what will tilt the balance in Bihar?



With opinion polls showing a razor-thin gap between alliances, Bihar seems headed for one of its most unpredictable elections in recent memory. According to the latest VoteVibe survey (Nov 1, 2025), the NDA leads with 45% vote share and 143 projected seats, while the RJD-led Mahagathbandhan trails at 39% and 87 seats. The Jan Suraj Party, led by Prashant Kishor, though distant in numbers, has grown steadily to about 7% vote share and four seats, indicating the rise of a new anti-establishment sentiment.

But the numbers tell only half the story. On the ground, *the Free Press' travels across* Darbhanga, Saran and Patna revealed a divided, almost introspective electorate. In Darbhanga Rural, where migration and joblessness dominate daily life, one hears repeated refrains of palaayan, palaayan – migration as both compulsion and identity. Here, voters remain

torn: Tejaswi Yadav's promise of "Har Ghar Sarkari Naukri" sounds attractive. In Darbhanga Rural constituency the Yadav supporters were overwhelmingly unanimous in support of Tejaswi.

In Chapra constituency the narrative plays out differently. The contest plays out along both welfare and identity lines. "Caste still matters," one local shopkeeper admitted, "but people are also watching who can actually deliver jobs." Here, party identity remains stronger than caste identity for 51.1% of respondents, a subtle but important shift away from old fault lines. Yet, the NDA's local strength, bolstered by new candidate selections and the JD(U)'s return to the alliance, keeps the ruling bloc competitive even in areas where discontent simmers.

THE POLL ECHOES THAT SCEPTICISM: 48% of

voters dismiss Tejaswi's job promise as unrealistic, while 38.1% consider it achievable. Still, a slim majority of 50.5% believes it at least matches Nitish Kumar's Rs 10,000 Mahila Rozgar Yojana, showing no clear welfare advantage for either camp. Bihar's battle of manifestos, it seems, is not just about policy, it's about credibility. The Bihar Voter is shrewd, calculative and least likely to be taken for a ride with empty promises. This is no Madhya Pradesh or Haryana, or Maharashtra for that matter where beneficiary schemes are said to have played a deciding role, especially for women.

In Patna, middle-class voters appear split between nostalgia and impatience. Many acknowledge Nitish's 20-year record, which 56.7% of respondents still rate positively, but

younger and first-time voters are drawn toward Tejaswi's energy and rhetoric. "We want jobs, not lectures," said a university student in Patna City. That sentiment underlines a crucial statistic while Tejaswi Yadav leads in CM preference at 35%, Nitish Kumar still commands 23.4%, reflecting a leadership gap but not a collapse.

Jan Suraj's projected vote share up from 9.1% to 12.3% in a year, adds another layer of uncertainty. Its intellectual, youth-oriented appeal could cut into both alliances, especially in urban and semi-urban constituencies. Analysts see this as a possible spoiler effect, making the 2025 race even tighter.

In short, Bihar 2025 is strident a two-way fight, which involves a tug between credibility, continuity, and change. Voters appear discerning, no longer easily swayed by freebies or slogans. As one elderly voter in Darbhanga put it succinctly: "We've heard promises from everyone. This time, our vote will be for who we believe not who we know." The result may well hinge on who earns that belief.

Rahul's 10% comment on Army stirs row

Congress MP Rahul Gandhi on Tuesday stirred a controversy during a campaign rally in Bihar's Kutumba, ahead of the Assembly election that begins on Thursday, after claiming that the Indian Army is "under the control of 10 per cent of the country's population", in a reference to the upper castes.

Addressing a public gathering, Gandhi said, "If you look closely, 90 percent of the country's population is Dalit, Maha Dalit, backward, extremely backward, or from minority communities. Ninety percent of the people come

from the most backward and tribal sections of society."

He went on to add, "If you take out a list of India's 500 largest companies, you won't find anyone from the backward or Dalit communities there, they all come from that top 10 percent. All the jobs go to them. They have control over the armed forces. You won't find the remaining 90 percent of the population represented anywhere."

Reacting to his remarks, BJP leader Suresh Nakhua said, "Rahul Gandhi is now searching for a caste in the Armed Forces and says 10% of people control it. In his hate for PM Modi, he has already crossed the line of hating India."

PM HAILS WOMEN POWER AS VITAL FOR VIKSIT BHARAT

PM Modi interacted with spirited women karyakartas of the Bharatiya Janata Party from Bihar as part of the "Mera Booth, Sabse Mazboot" outreach initiative. The interaction was marked by warmth, humour, and conviction as PM Modi hailed the vital role of women in strengthening democracy and steering India towards a Viksit Bharat.

Opening the interaction, PM Modi thanked the karyakartas for their tireless grassroots work and said that "Bihar's women have always been the strongest force behind social change." He emphasised that the "double-engine government" had prioritised women-led development through initiatives such as Ujjwala Yojana, PM Awas Yojana, and Jal Jeevan Mission, which have empowered women to become decision-makers within their homes and communities.

Lallan in a spot

Ahead of the first phase of Bihar assembly election, an FIR has been filed against Union minister and senior JD (U) leader Rajiv Ranjan Singh aka Lallan Singh after a video in which Singh appears to instruct supporters in the Mokama area to prevent "some leaders" from leaving their houses on polling day went viral on social media. The FIR, registered at the behest of the Election Commission of India, invokes provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and the Representation of the People Act, 1951.

Tejaswi promises annual financial aid to women

RJD leader Tejaswi Yadav on Tuesday announced that the INDIA bloc would provide the entire annual financial aid of Rs 30,000 to women in January next year if they are voted to power in Bihar. Tejaswi made the announcement two days before the first phase of voting in the state. His announcement is seen as his bid to counter the ruling NDA's 'Mukhyamantri Mahila Roggar Yojana', as part of which Rs 10,000 has already been transferred into the accounts of 1.21 crore women to start their own businesses.

Campaigning for first phase ends

The high-octane poll campaign for the first phase of Bihar assembly election ended on Tuesday as several heavyweights including deputy chief ministers Samrat Choudhary, Vijay Kumar Sinha and RJD leader Tejaswi Yadav are in the fray in this round. Votes for the first phase will be cast on Thursday. The second and final phase of the election will be held on

November 11 while results will be declared on November 14.

In the first phase, 121 constituencies spread across 18 districts will go to the polls. Voting for the remaining 122 seats will be held in the second phase. Out of the total 243 assembly constituencies, 203 are general seats, 38 are reserved for scheduled castes (SCs) and two are reserved for scheduled tribes (STs).

Tharoor article on 'dynastic politics' has BJP pleased as punch

Congress lawmaker Shashi Tharoor, who has through his words and actions on multiple occasions caused discomfort to his party over the last year, again caused a flutter through an article that right on the eve of Bihar elections talked of "grave threat to Indian democracy" from "dynastic politics" – an issue BJP has been raising to attack the Congress and Rashtriya Janata Dal with.

In his column, Tharoor noted that the Nehru-Gandhi family "cemented the idea that political leadership can be a birthright".

He wrote in the article, published on October 31, that: "For decades, one family has towered over Indian politics. The influence of the Nehru-Gandhi dynasty – including independent India's first prime minister, Jawaharlal Nehru, prime ministers Indira Gandhi and Rajiv Gandhi, and current opposition leader Rahul Gandhi and MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra – is bound up with the history of India's struggle for freedom. But it has also cemented the idea that political leadership can be a birthright. This idea has penetrated Indian politics across every party, in every region, and at every level."

Tharoor added that, "While the Nehru-Gandhi family is associated with the Indian National Congress, dynastic succession prevails across the political spectrum" the time has come to trade "dynasty for meritocracy".

His article immediately provided an opportunity to the BJP to flog the Congress and the RJD for working to enrich their leading families.

BJP national spokesperson C.R. Kesavan saw Tharoor's views as "a veiled attack on the Nehru-Gandhi family's misrule which severely affected India's progress for decades."
