1. To approve the alteration of the Memorandum of Association of the Company

4. To engage in activities that generate commission income by acting as an agent, broker, or intermediary for the sale, promotion, or marketing of event-related services, including venue bookings, vendor management, artist coordination, sponsorship acquisition, and other allied services, while earning performance-based fees, incentives, and commissions on successful event transactions or contracts.
5. To provide management consultancy services, including strategic planning, organizational development, business restructuring, operational improvement, and market analysis to clients. Additionally, to engage in event consultancy services, including the planning, organizing, coordinating, and managing of corporate events, conferences, exhibitions, trade shows, and promotional campaigns to facilitate brand visibility and customer engagement.
6. To engage in the business of providing manpower supply services by recruiting, training, and deploying skilled, semi-skilled, and unskilled workforce to clients across various industries.

**Notes:**

1. A member entitled to attend and vote at the Extra Ordinary General Meeting ("Meeting") is entitled to appoint a proxy to attend and vote on a poll instead of himself / herself and the proxy need not be a member of the Company. The instrument appointing proxy in order to be effective, should be deposited at Company's registered office, duly completed and signed, not less than 48 (forty-eight) hours before the commencement of the meeting. A person can act as proxy on behalf of members not exceeding fifty (50) and holding in the aggregate not more than ten percent of the total share capital of the company. A member holding more than ten percent of the total share capital of the company carrying voting rights may appoint a single person as proxy and such person shall not act as proxy for any other person or shareholder.
2. The Proxy holder shall prove his/her identity at the time of attending the Meeting.
3. When a member appoints a proxy and both the Member and the Proxy attend the Meeting, the Proxy stands automatically revoked.
4. Corporate Members intending to send their authorized representatives to attend and vote at the meeting pursuant to section 113 of the Companies Act, 2013 are requested to send a certified copy of the board resolution authorizing their representatives to attend and vote on their behalf at the meeting.
5. An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies act, 2013, relating to the Business as set out at item nos. 1 & 2 of the EGM Notice, to be transacted at the Meeting is annexed hereto.
6. Pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended upto date, Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 the Company is pleased to provide its members the facility to exercise their right to vote on the resolutions proposed to be passed in the Extra Ordinary General Meeting (EGM) by electronic means and the business may be transacted through e-voting services provided by National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL).

The facility for voting through ballot / polling paper shall also be made available at the venue of the EGM. The members attending the meeting, who have not already cast their vote through remote e-voting shall be able to exercise their voting rights at the meeting. The members who have already cast their vote through remote e-voting may attend the meeting but shall not be entitled to cast their vote again at the EGM.

**THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING ARE AS UNDER:-**

The remote e-voting period begins on 15th April, 2025 at 9:00 A.M. and ends on 17th April, 2025, at 5:00 P.M. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / Beneficial Owners as on the record date (cut-off date) i.e. Friday, 11th April, 2025, may cast their vote electronically. The voting right of shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date, being Friday, 11th April, 2025.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

Step 1: Access to NSDL e-Voting system**A) Login method for e-Voting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode**

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. After successful login the Easi / Easiest user will be able to see the e-Voting option for eligible companies where the evoting is in progress as per the information provided by company. On clicking the evoting option, the user will be able to see e-Voting page of the e-Voting service provider for casting your vote during the remote e-Voting period. How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

2. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon "Login" which is available under 'Shareholder/Member' section.

6. If you are unable to retrieve or have not received the “ Initial password” or have forgotten your password:
 - a) Click on “**Forgot User Details/Password?**”(If you are holding shares in your demat account with NSDL or CDSL) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
 - b) **Physical User Reset Password?** (If you are holding shares in physical mode) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.

7. After entering your password, tick on Agree to “Terms and Conditions” by selecting on the check box.
8. Now, you will have to click on “Login” button.
9. After you click on the “Login” button, Home page of e-Voting will open.

Step 2: Cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system.

How to cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system?

1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies “EVEN” in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle is in active status.
2. Select “EVEN” of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on “Submit” and also “Confirm” when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message “Vote cast successfully” will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote

**General Guidelines for shareholders**

1. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to nageswara.raop@kfintech.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.co.in. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on "**Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter**" displayed under "**e-Voting**" tab in their login.
2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. In such an event, you will need to go through the "Forgot User Details/Password?" or "Physical User Reset Password?" option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com to reset the password.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT IN RESPECT OF THE SPECIAL BUSINESS PURSUANT TO SECTION 102 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2013 ("THE ACT")

Item No: 1

Your Board periodically evaluates opportunities for expansion into complementary and profitable areas aligned with the Company's growth strategy. To support this vision, it is essential that the Objects Clause of the Memorandum of Association ('MOA'), is broadened to encompass a wider range of activities.

The proposed alteration in the Objects Clause, as outlined in the Resolution, aims to facilitate diversification into ancillary services that enhance the core business of event management. This amendment will empower the Company to explore new avenues. By expanding its operational scope, the Company will be better positioned to optimize resources, improve service offerings, and efficiently integrate these new activities with its existing business.

This strategic expansion will enable the Company to adapt to evolving industry trends, cater to a broader client base, and achieve long-term sustainability in a competitive market.

The Board at its meeting held on March 21, 2025 has approved alteration of the MOA of the Company and the Board now seek Members' approval for the same.

The proposed change of object clause requires the approval of the shareholders through Special Resolution pursuant to the provisions of Sec 13 of the Companies Act, 2013.
