TN plans tender revamp for e-bus purchase

Chennai, Aug 5: The Tamil Nadu government is set to revise tender conditions for the procurement of electric buses to attract more manufacturers, improve competition and secure better-quality buses at lower prices for State transport corporations.

The decision was discussed at a meeting chaired by Transport Secretary I. Nirmal Raj with bus manufacturers at the Metropolitan Transport Corporation headquarters in Chennai on Tuesday.

Officials said the proposed changes to tender conditions are aimed at ensuring greater transparency in the procurement process and encouraging wider participation from eligible manufacturers. The revised norms

are also expected to help the State procure buses more competitively while maintaining quality standards.

During the meeting, the Transport Secretary directed officials to expedite the procurement process so that new buses can be inducted into service at the earliest. Bus manufacturers were also asked to speed up deliveries under existing purchase orders.

Tamil Nadu's State transport corporations currently operate around 21,515 buses through 26 regions and 317 depots, catering to nearly 2.02 crore passenger trips every day.

Metropolitan Transport Corporation Managing Director T. Mohan and senior transport department officials attended the meeting.

Sonalika records highest-ever July tractor sales

Chennai, Aug 5: Sonalika Tractors has reported its highest-ever July sales, recording 11,442 tractors sold overall, driven by robust domestic demand.

The company said its domestic sales grew 27.2 per cent year-on-year, outperforming the industry growth by 1.3 times and making it the highest market share gainer in the domestic tractor market during the month.

Kerala unveils Rs. 5 cr MSME loan scheme to power entrepreneurship

Thiruvananthapuram, Aug 5: The Kerala Financial Corporation (KFC) will launch the third edition of the Chief Minister's Entrepreneurship Development Programme (CMEDP) on August 6, introducing an expanded scheme that will offer loans of up to Rs.5 crore at a highly subsidised interest rate of 6 per cent to boost the state's MSME sector.

The limited review as required under Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations 2015 has been completed by the Statutory Auditors.
- The group is operating in segments namely Lead, Copper and other non ferrous metals and Plastics. However for the purpose of Segment reporting under Ind AS 108, the other nonferrous metal and plastics does not meet the criteria laid down in the Standard as a reportable segment, the operations are reported under two segments namely Lead and Copper.
- The Board of Directors of the Company, at its meeting held on May 26, 2026, approved the stock split of each Equity Share of the face value of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five only) fully paid-up into Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 2/- (Rupees Two only) each fully paid-up, which was subsequently approved by the shareholders through postal ballot on July 02, 2026. The company fixed July 21, 2026 as the 'Record Date' for the purpose of the sub division of shares. Since the Record Date after which was of the reporting quarter June 30, 2026 but before the date of approval of these financial results by the Board (August 4, 2026), the calculation of basic and diluted Earnings Per Share (EPS) for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, and all comparative periods presented, has been adjusted retroactively based on the new face value of Rs. 2/- per share, in accordance with Ind AS 33 'Earning Per Share' and Ind AS 10 'Events occurring after balance sheet date'.
