TN allows five daily shows for new film releases

Chennai, May 27: Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay has ordered permission for movie theatres across the state to screen five shows a day during the first seven days of a film's release.

Earlier, theatres were permitted to conduct only four regular shows daily, with an additional special show allowed only after obtaining permission during local festivals and public holidays.

Under the new relaxation announced by the government, theatres can now screen five shows without special permission on local festival days, public holidays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

The decision follows demands raised by members of the film industry during a meeting with the Chief Minister at the Secretariat on May 16. Industry representatives had submitted a charter of demands, including a request to increase the number of daily screenings for newly released films.

The state government said the move was aimed at supporting the film industry and improving theatre operations during major releases.
