Therefore, at this point of time, the Company is of the view that this is not a material event which attracts disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015.

## **Third-party cybersecurity incident**

ZURICH, SWITZERLAND, March, 17, 2023 – We recently learned that a third-party software provider called FORTRA GoAnywhere MFT (Managed File Transfer) was the victim of an attack by the CLOP ransomware group that could have resulted in an unauthorized access to employee data in some countries.

Upon learning of this event, we took immediate action and initiated our own investigation, disconnected the third-party system, and engaged forensic IT experts to help us analyze the nature and scope of the attack. Employees who may be affected have been informed and we are providing support. We have also notified relevant data privacy, security and law enforcement authorities and we continue to cooperate with the relevant stakeholders.

To date, we have no information that neither our network operations nor the security or reliability of customer data have been compromised. We will continue to update relevant parties as the investigation progresses.

At Hitachi Energy, we value and respect the confidentiality of our employees' personal information and we understand that they would be rightly concerned about potential unauthorized access.
