Fest rush chokes roads, citizens bemoan ill-planned repair work

Thousands of commuters and families faced significant difficulties travelling on Saturday during the Raksha Bandhan festival, as they were stranded for over an hour at several major traffic points, including Mumbra, Narpoli in Bhiwandi, Kapurbawdi, Thane and Kalyan.

According to Thane DCP (Traffic) Pankaj Shirsat, around 140 police personnel, including six senior police inspectors and 18 PSIs/APIs, were deployed at major diversion points to manage the chaos. "Had this diversion been scheduled on a working day, the situation could have been a nightmare. Hence, we timed it from August 8-11 considering the Raksha Bandhan holiday," he told the FPJ.

Heavy congestion was reported at Mumbra toll naka, Kharegaon, and along the Bhiwandi route, triggered by ongoing repair work on the Gaimukh-Ghodbunder stretch of National Highway 48 (NH-48). Earlier, the Thane traffic police issued a notification restricting the movement of heavy vehicles on the Thane-Ghodbunder Road from August 8 midnight until 5am on August 11.

The traffic police said that the road work includes patch repairs measuring 300-400 meters between Kapjapada and Nira Kendra on Gaimukh Ghat. The road department and Thane traffic police are coordinating to manage the traffic situation. Despite these efforts, long queues of vehicles were observed from the Kharegaon Toll Plaza to Kausa on Friday and Saturday causing severe delays.

Hour-long delays

Motorists reported that journeys that typically take 10-20 minutes stretched beyond an hour due to traffic snarls on both the Mumbra-Kharegaon,

Commuters share their ordeal

Dolly Gupta, a home tutor from Bhiwandi, said she and her husband left for Kalyan on a motorcycle around 11:00pm to celebrate Raksha Bandhan at her brother's home in Vithalwadi. "We reached Vithalwadi in Kalyan at 2:30pm; a journey that usually takes 30-40 minutes," she recounted.

Similarly, Bhagwan Das, who had booked a cab from Bhiwandi to Thane with his wife and children to reach his brother-in-law's home in Thane to celebrate the festival, said they were stuck in traffic for over an hour on the Anjurphata-Kasheli Road. "The fare was hiked by Rs40 to Rs70 as compared to other days," he added.

Other commuters expressed frustration, urging the authorities to avoid road-work during festivals. "People travel with families during Raksha Bandhan. Such work should be done during weekends or non-festival days," one

commuter said.

A journalist from the FPJ, Pramod Kumar, had a horrendous time travelling to work on Saturday. Normally, it takes just 25 minutes to reach Dombivli station from his Lodha Heaven residence in an autorickshaw. He said, "The weekend rush, combined with Raksha Bandhan crowds, brought traffic to a crawl on Saturday - stretching the short commute into an exhausting two-hour slog. The rickshaw driver's mid-route detours helped avoid even worse delays. The funny part is that no motorist seemed to know the exact reason for the

traffic jam." Metro construction at Manpada has been slowing travel for weeks, but Saturday's chaos was on another level entirely - a test of patience few will soon forget, he said.

Poor roads, potholes blamed

Naresh Manera, a former coparator from the Shiv Sena (UBT), blamed the poor condition of the roads and the sub-standard material used for repairs. "Before the monsoon, the road was already damaged. Now, only one lane is operational from Thane to Ghodbunder and from

Ghodbunder to Thane, and potholes are the primary cause of traffic congestion. The solution is to use concrete instead of asphalt or bitumen," he said.

Heavy vehicle movement from JNPT Port, Mahape Road, and Navi Mumbai to Gujarat occurs through the Gaimukh Ghat stretch on Ghodbunder Road. The Ghodbunder Road is a major route linking Surat, Vapi, and Gujarat. Due to the work on Gaimukh Road, the authorities have diverted traffic via the Mumbai-Nashik Highway and Kharegaon, Mumbra Toll Naka.

Unfortunately, the ongoing road repair work on this alternate route has also led to gridlocks.

Similarly, heavy vehicles coming from Gujarat to Navi Mumbai were diverted via Chinchoti and Shirsad Phata.

Diversions, restrictions

The Thane traffic police implemented temporary restrictions and diversions for heavy vehicles August 8-11 to facilitate urgent road repairs on Ghodbunder Road. From Mumbai/Thane to Ghodbunder Road, heavy vehicles were blocked at V Junction and Kapurbawdi. The alternative route was via V Junction to Nashik Road, Kharegaon Toll, Mankoli and then Anjur Phata. From Mumbra/Kalwa to Ghodbunder Road, heavy vehicles were stopped at Kharegaon Toll Nroute. They were diverted from Kharegaon Tollto Mankoli and then Anjur Phata.

Days after an FIR was registered against NMMC doctor Dr Chandan Pandit and his father Dr DV Pandit after several patients permanently lost vision due to cataract surgeries at their private clinic in Vashi's Sector 10, a 71-year-old man has narrated a similar ordeal from 2014.

Eleven years ago, Vashi resident Rajkumar Chandan, an actor from yesteryear Bollywood horror movies, was the first to publicly voice concerns about losing sight partially in one eye after an alleged botched surgery at Dr Pandit Eye Clinic run by the accused duo. This ended his acting career; he could no longer drive or lead a normal life. However, his complaint to the Vashi police station fell on deaf ears, and no action was initiated at the time.

Chandan said, "I was told that it's only a non-cognisable (NC) matter. No investigation was conducted and none of my reports were forwarded to the Thane civil surgeon as per protocol. I vented out my anger on Google 'review' of the clinic and even then I was asked by one of the senior officers to get it down as the doctor was his friend." The former actor added if the police had taken action back then, the eyesight of many people would have been saved. "Even now, my complaint is not attached to the FIR lodged against the doctor, citing it to be a very old case," he said.

Chandan had approached the clinic, when both his eyes turned red and he began experiencing severe headaches. He was examined by Dr Dharamvir Pandit, the proprietor of the clinic, who diagnosed cataracts in both eyes.

According to Chandan, he was first operated on his right eye and, 15 days later, on his left eye - both by Dr DV Pandit and his son, Dr Chandan Pandit.

After the surgery of left eye, Chandan reported that vision was completely blurred. Despite medication prescribed at the clinic, there was no improvement even after 15 days. When he consulted another specialist, he was devastated to learn that he had lost partial vision due to alleged negligence.

Both the accused doctors were booked earlier this week by the Vashi police after Thane civil surgeon gave his report confirming negligence in operating Kopardikhairne resident Rajendra Gupta, 67, who lost vision in left eye owing to an alleged botched up surgery at the Pandits' private clinic.

Dr Chandan Pandit, who is an employee of the health department of Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation and was appointed at Airoli NMMC hospital, is accused of conducting the surgeries at the clinic registered under the name of his father.

Gupta's daughter Dipali said, "Dr Chandan Pandit provided the case papers after a lot of persuasion; but the papers had his father's name who did not conduct the surgery," she said. Calls and messages by the FPJ to Dr Pandit about the allegations went unanswered.

MMC steps in after six lose sight at Vashi clinic

The Maharashtra Medical Council (MMC) has taken cognisance of the Vashi incident in which six elderly patients lost their vision after undergoing cataract surgeries at Dr Pandit Eye Hospital in Sector 10, Vashi, Navi Mumbai. The council has sought clarification and will soon summon the doctors involved. The MMC, which regulates medical practice in Maharashtra, has the authority to suspend or revoke the license of doctors found guilty of professional misconduct.

MMC administrator Dr Vinky Rughwani told the FPJ that the matter is being treated with utmost seriousness. "The inquiry process has already begun," he said, adding that as the police are also investigating, the council cannot disclose further details at this stage.

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has also launched a separate probe into the incident. Families of the victims have accused the doctors of gross negligence and demanded strict action. The case has sparked public outrage and renewed calls for stronger norms for private eye clinics, especially to protect elderly patients from irreversible medical harm.
