Keel Laying Ceremony Of Mpv (Yard-21003) Built For M/S Navi Merchants

The Keel Laying Ceremony of the Third ship (Yard-21003) of the 7500DWT Multi-Purpose Hybrid Vessel (MPV) project for M/s Navi Merchants, Denmark, being built by Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd (MDL), a Navratna DPSU was held at MDL's South Yard on 20 May 2026. The prestigious Keel Laying function was graced by Mr. Rasmus Saltofte, CEO, M/s Navi Merchants with senior officials from M/s Navi Merchants, the Classification Society (DNV) and MDL. As per the contract signed between MDL and M/s Navi Merchants, MDL will design, build and deliver Six Multi-Purpose Vessels. The overall length of this Multi-Purpose Dry Cargo ship is 116.2m with a dead weight of 7500T. The vessel is with Hybrid Propulsion System and will be capable of attaining the speed of not less than 11.0 knots with shaft generator power take off of about 85 kW. The vessel will be built under survey and certification with rules of Det Norske Veritas (DNV) classification society. Today's Keel laying ceremony marks a significant milestone in the construction of the series of vessels being built under this export order by MDL.

Women's Participation in India's Maritime Sector Surges 340% Since 2020: Sarbananda Sonowal

Women's participation in India's maritime sector has increased by 340% since 2020, Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW), Sarbananda Sonowal said here today, underscoring the government's push to build a more inclusive, future-ready maritime workforce. Delivering the keynote address at the 10th Indian Ocean Dialogue in New Delhi, Sonowal highlighted "Nari Shakti" as a central pillar of India's maritime growth story. Union Minister Sarbananda Sonowal was joined by His Excellency, Dhananjay Ramful, Foreign Minister of Mauritius, and His Excellency, Waleed Mohammed Al-Qadimi, Minister of State of Yemen.
