Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, preferably in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring action of the Respondents in marking the petitioner company as having management dispute vide letter of the 1st Respondent dated 29-04-2015 and not demarking the same inspite of the continuous representations of the petitioner dated 19-04-2022, 25-04-2022, 06-07-2022, 13-02-2025 and 26-02-2025, as arbitrary and illegal and direct the Respondents to forthwith remove the marking of the petitioner company as having management dispute, in the interest of justice.

IA NO: 1 OF 2025

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents to remove the marking of the petitioner company 'as having management dispute' in all the official records maintained under the companies Act, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition, in the interest of justice.

The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE N.V.SHRAVAN KUMAR

WRIT PETITION No.8205 of 2025

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri.N.Avanesh, learned standing counsel appearing for respondents. With their consent, the writ petition is being taken up for disposal at the admission stage itself.

2. This writ petition has been filed seeking the following prayer:-

"to declare the action of the Respondents in marking the petitioner company as "having management dispute" vide letter of the 1st Respondent dated 29.04.2015 and not demarking the same inspite of the continuous representations of the petitioner dated 19.04.2022, 25.04.2022, 06.07.2022, 13.02.2025 and 26.02.2025, as arbitrary and illegal and direct the Respondents to forthwith remove the marking of the petitioner company as having management dispute."

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is a public limited company engaged in the business of manufacturing and dealing in sugar and allied products. It is further submitted that respondent No.1 issued letter dated 29.04.2015, stating the following:-

"Please note that the PRUDENTIAL SUGAR CORPORATION LIMITED having CIN L15432TG1990PLC032731 has been marked as having management dispute with the following reasons:

Based on the investor complaint alleging the illegal removal of company's MD and also investor complaints reg. the mis-conducting of postal ballot and based on the court order dated 8-10-2014, the company is marked as co. having management dispute.

You are required to settle the matter amicably or get an order/interim order from a Court or Tribunal of competent jurisdiction. Till such dispute is settled, the documents filed by the company and by the contesting groups of Directors will not be approved/registered/recorded and will thus not be available in the registry for public viewing."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner on 19.04.2022, 25.04.2022, 06.07.2022, 13.02.2025 and 26.02.2025 made detailed representations and requested the respondent authorities to unmark the 'Management Dispute' of the Company and further submitted that the same are still pending for consideration. Aggrieved by the same, this writ petition is filed.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submit that the petitioner is a public limited company and if the documents filed by the company are not available for public viewing, the same would effect the company's goodwill and would cause financial loss to the company and pray this Court to direct the respondent authorities to consider the petitioner's representations dated 19.04.2022, 25.04.2022, 06.07.2022, 13.02.2025 and 26.02.2025 and pass orders in a time bound period.

6. Learned standing counsel appearing for respondents submits that if the petitioner's representations dated 19.04.2022, 25.04.2022, 06.07.2022, 13.02.2025 and 26.02.2025 are still pending for consideration; the respondent authorities may be directed to dispose of the said representations and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

7. In view of the submission made by learned counsel appearing on either side and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent authorities to dispose the

petitioner's representations dated 19.04.2022, 25.04.2022, 06.07.2022, 13.02.2025 and 26.02.2025 and after giving fair opportunity of hearing to the petitioner shall pass appropriate orders strictly in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three (03) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner.

8. Accordingly this writ petition is disposed of. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.
