Ahead of meet, Taliban seek India's diplomatic recognition

But Sources Say Govt Position May Not Change

New Delhi: The Taliban are seeking an upgrade of their relationship with India in the form of diplomatic recognition, as Afghanistan foreign minister Amir Khan Muttagi meets external affairs minister S Jaishankar on Friday. Muttagi arrived in Delhi on Thursday for a 6-day visit.

He is expected to meet Jaishankar on Friday. Muttagi is expected to elevate the relationship by granting recognition to the Islamic Emirate of Afghanistan (IEA), the name used by the Taliban for the country.

"It is the first high level visit by our foreign minister to India and is very significant. We expect it will initiate a new phase of relations between the two countries."

There are a lot of areas which can be explored for mutual cooperation during this visit, said the head of Taliban's political office and Afghanistan's ambassador to Qatar, Shahid Shabeen.

"I think it is time for the leadership of both countries to raise the diplomatic level by granting recognition to IEA and thus, paving the way for bilateral cooperation and expansion of relations in various fields," added Shabeen.

The UN Security Council earlier waived a travel ban on Muttagi to allow him to travel to India. That India was keen to host Muttagi is a sign of growing trust in the relationship as the Taliban urge India to expand its economic footprint in the country.

The visit also helps India further capitalise on the dramatic deterioration in the Taliban's ties with Pakistan, which accuses Kabul of funding and arming the Pakistani Taliban or Tehreek-e-Taliban Pakistan (TTP).

Recognition for the Taliban, however, remains a tricky issue for India as the Indian govt wants its position to be in consonance with that of the international community. That position is unlikely to change with Muttagi's visit.

As multiple sources here told TOI, visit is only indicative of an enhancement in bilateral relations and diplomatic engagements. As the govt has said in past, India seeks a sovereign, democratic and peaceful Afghanistan, where interests of all sections of Afghan society are protected.

Additionally, despite credible assurances by Kabul that it won't allow Afghanistan to be used against India, the Indian govt still has concerns about links between Pakistan-based terror groups and forces in Afghanistan, Russia remains the only country to have formally recognised the govt in Kabul.

Apart from Delhi, Muttagi is also likely to travel to Agra and Deoband.

ATS searches Pune locations in 2023 ISIS sleeper cell case

Pune: Maharashtra ATS and Pune police conducted Thursday coordinated searches across multiple sites in the city following intelligence inputs indicating possible anti-national activity.

The operation is part of the continuing probe into the 2023 Pune ISIS sleeper cell case, in which 11 men were arrested earlier for alleged links to a sleeper cell inspired by the international terrorist organisation and said to be active in Maharashtra.

ATS SP Jyanti Meena said investigators questioned 19 people and seized "electronic gadgets and incriminating documents". He declined to specify the nature of the materials, citing the ongoing investigation.

ATS officials said no new arrests had been made following the searches. Nineteen houses in Kondhwa locality alone were searched during the operation that began around 3.30am and continued till late afternoon. "ATS seized laptops, phones, and several documents," a crime branch officer said.

Apart from Pune city, ATS searched a flat at Mohli in Pimpri Chinchwad area and detained one person for questioning.

"The man had recently rented the flat. Some documents, a laptop, and a cell phone were recovered from an officer from Pimpri Chinchwad crime branch.

The operation ties back to the July 2023 arrests of three men — Mohammed Shahinwaz Alam, Mohammed Yusuf Mohammed Yaqub Saki. They were initially arrested by Pune police on suspicion of vehicle theft. The trio lived in Kondhwa and claimed to work as graphic designers. Police later alleged they were members of SuPa, an ISIS-inspired group. During a house search, police seized white powder and a pistol. Tests confirmed the white powder also envisages substance.

Chenab hydel project set to get green nod, move follows suspension of IWT

New Delhi: Acting swiftly on projects of strategic significance following suspension of Indus Waters Treaty, a central panel has recommended grant of mandatory environmental clearance (EC) for construction of the ambitious 1,656-MW Sawallot hydroelectric project in Ramban district of Jammu & Kashmir.

The EC will pave the way for the beginning of the project's construction after fulfilling procedural formalities with the UT govt.

The Sawallot hydroelectric project (HEP) by the NHPC is a run-of-the-river project that will be using the water of Chenab river in Ramban, Reasi and Udhampur districts of the UT. It will be constructed in two stages in an area of more than 1,601 hectares at an estimated cost of over Rs 3,380 crore.

The hydroelectric project also envisages construction of a 192.5 m high Roller Compacted Concrete (RCC) gravity dam from the deepest foundation level, an upstream short water conductor system, an installed on-line monitoring system for the dam and a tail race system.

The expert committee of the environment ministry on river valley and hydroelectric projects, while granting the green clearances during its last meeting on Sept 26, also specified certain "environment conditions" and safeguards which the project proponent will have to follow.

The environmental conditions of the green clearance for the project include setting up a team to oversee environmental management activities, installing an on-line monitoring system for the dam and a mechanism of compensation for land acquisition for the project.

Jindal Power to Buy Jhajjar Thermal Plant from Apraava

Apraava Renewable and Kohima-Mariani Transmission also part of deal

Mumbai: Naveen Jindal-owned Jindal Power (JPL) has signed an agreement to acquire the 1,350 MW Jhajjar Power Project in Haryana from Apraava Energy (formerly CLP India), marking one of the largest thermal power deals in recent years.

The companies did not disclose the transaction value but sources said the deal is pegged at around ₹4,000 crore.

In May ET first reported that JPL had emerged as the frontrunner for the acquisition after signing an exclusivity agreement with Apraava for bilateral negotiations earlier this year.

Axis Capital and HSBC advised Apraava on the sale process. The Jindal Group entity was coming up with Czech-based Seven Global Investments for the asset. The deal, expected to close within a month, underscores JPL's strategy to strengthen its base-load power portfolio as a line when demand for thermal power remains robust.

PepsiCo Beats Q3 Market View on Steady Demand for Healthier Brands, Energy Drinks

PepsiCo beat Wall Street expectations for third-quarter revenue and profit on Thursday, as demand for its energy drinks, healthier sodas and snacks brands in key international markets remained steady.

The company's revenue for the quarter rose 1% from \$10.1 billion in the same period last year.

PepsiCo is facing pressure from an activist investor for lagging behind its main rivals, while also being challenged by changing consumer preferences and scrutiny by synthetic biology from the Trump administration.

CEO Ramon Laguarta on Thursday stressed on PepsiCo's efforts to roll out a strong "pipeline of innovation" as it adds protein-rich sodas and energy drinks to its portfolio.

PepsiCo is also working to rebrand its Lay's and Tostitos brands to highlight the absence of food dyes and synthetic ingredients, and is also introducing smaller pack sizes as consumers look for affordable options.
