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## Rainbow Children's Medicare Limited reports steady Q3 performance

- Improvement across key KPIs
- Andhra Pradesh and Bengaluru footprint expands with commissioning of Rajahmundry (~100 beds) and Electronic City (~90 beds) hospitals respectively
- Planned capacity additions for the current cycle now largely complete, the organization is shifting its focus firmly on execution

**Hyderabad, January 28, 2026:** Rainbow Children's Medicare Limited (RCML), India's leading pediatric multi-specialty and perinatal care hospital chain, announced its financial results for the third quarter and first nine months of the financial year FY26 ended December 31, 2025.

Operationally, the quarter saw steady improvement across key KPIs, including outpatient footfalls, inpatient discharges, and deliveries. New units performance also strengthened, reflecting the gradual progress of beds added over the past years. The company continues to deliver sustainable growth and remains confident that this momentum will be maintained as ongoing seasonality normalizes and recently commissioned hospitals move further along their ramp-up curves.

During the quarter, RCML expanded its footprint with the commissioning of the 100-bed Rajahmundry hospital in Andhra Pradesh, strengthening the presence in the region. Early patient response in the hospital has been encouraging. In Bengaluru, the ~90-bed Electronic City hospital recently commenced operations, further reinforcing the company's presence in the city.

With the planned capacity additions for the current cycle now largely completed, the organization is firmly shifting its focus to execution. Priorities over the coming quarters will center on strengthening operations, improving occupancies, enhancing the service mix, and building sustainable volumes across the group hospitals. The appointment of Mr. Abrarali Dalal as Chief Executive Officer further strengthens the leadership team at a stage where operational excellence and scale-up are key.

## Key Developments

- The trajectory of operations at Guwahati (~150 Beds), Warangal (~100 beds) and Rajahmundry (~100 beds) has been as per expectation & have integrated well with Rainbow.
- The spoke hospital in Electronic City<sup>1</sup> (~90 beds) has commenced operations, further strengthening the company's footprint in Bengaluru.
- Updates on Projects:
  - The Hennur (~60 beds) facility is in the concluding stage and awaiting government approvals.
  - The regional hub hospital in Coimbatore (~130 beds) has entered the construction phase and is targeted to commence operations by end of FY 27.
  - Construction activity is progressing at brisk pace both at Sector 44 (~325 beds) and Sector 56 (~125 beds), Gurugram (NCR).
  - The regional greenfield hub hospital in Pune (~150 beds) has received the requisite approvals from the government. Excavation work has commenced at the site.
- Rainbow Children's Hospital continues to maintain a robust balance sheet with cash, cash equivalents, fixed deposits, and mutual fund investments totaling Rs. 5,792 Mn as of December 31, 2025. These funds will support our ongoing capital expenditure, merger and acquisition plans. With our current cash and anticipated internal accruals in coming quarters, we are well-positioned to complete all planned capital expenditures using internal resources.
- During the quarter, the company invested Rs. 568.9 Mn in capital expenditures towards expanding and enhancing our services at existing / upcoming hospitals.

## About Rainbow Children's Medicare Limited

Rainbow Children's Medicare Limited network comprises of 23<sup>1</sup> hospitals and 5 clinics in 9 cities, with a total bed capacity of 2,375<sup>1</sup> beds. Our Pediatric services operating under the brand "Rainbow Children's Hospital" includes newborn and pediatric intensive care, pediatric multi-specialty services, pediatric quaternary care (including organ transplantation); whereas our women care services under "Birthright by Rainbow" offers perinatal care services which includes normal and complex obstetric care, multi-disciplinary fetal care, perinatal genetic and fertility care along with gynecology services.

Rainbow Children's Hospital built on strong fundamentals of a multidisciplinary approach with a full-time consultant led clinical service along with 24/7 commitment in a child centric environment. The company follows a hub-and-spoke operating model where the hub hospital provides comprehensive outpatient, inpatient care, with a focus on tertiary and quaternary services, while the spokes provide 24/7 emergency care, large outpatient services and comprehensive obstetrics, pediatric inpatient and level 3 NICU services. This model is successfully operational at Hyderabad and is gaining traction in Bengaluru. The endeavor is to replicate this approach in Chennai and across the National Capital Region. Subsequently Rainbow intends to expand into tier-2 cities of Southern India.

Rainbow Children's Hospital embraces a unique doctor engagement model, where doctors work exclusively on a full-time, retainer basis. The doctors work in teams and have 24/7 commitment, which is particularly important for children's emergency, neonatal, pediatric intensive care services and to support pediatric retrieval services. The Company also operates the country's largest pediatric DNB training programme in private healthcare, offering post graduate residential DNB and fellowship programme.
