# FM: Govt to revise GDP base to FY23 to reflect eco changes

## Nirmala Rejects Criticism Over Data Quality

New Delhi: Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman Wednesday said that govt is moving to update the base year for calculating GDP to 2022-23 instead of 2010-11 and dismissed concerns over an IMF report's reference to India's data quality.

The new base, which will also come with a revised basket to goods and services, will reflect the changes in the economy as consumption patterns have changed over the last 15 years. Data based on the new series will be released on Feb 27 with the first

advance estimate based on the current base to be released on Jan 7. There will also be changes in the base year for inflation and industrial production next year.

India's economic data has come under scrutiny, and a revamp is seen to be necessary to capture the changes in the digital economy. Recently, IMF in its annual report on India gave negative remarks on quality of data & called for measures to make it more up to date.

Responding to the IMF re-

port, which was raised in Lok Sabha, Sitharaman said that the multilateral agency focused largely on India's overall healthy economic performance. “The ratings given by IMF are part of its report on the Indian economy, which expects India's GDP to grow at 6.5% in 2025-26. It recognises growth in the private sector, macroeconomic stability and the resilience of the Indian financial sector. These are identified as key drivers of growth. IMF also notes that

inflation is well below RBI's tolerance band and is projected to be 4.3% for the full year. The point of contention was the quality of data on which the ‘C’ grade was given. The ‘C’ grade is assigned to the National Accounts data because it is based on an outdated base year — 2011-12,” she said.

She said that govt is in the process of updating the base year. “So, the data currently being used is based on the 2011-12 base year, and it is solely for this reason that we have been given a ‘C’ grade. The IMF report does not question the growth figures,” she said, rejecting opposition's criticism.

Latest data released by NSO, estimated India's GDP to have grown by scorching 8.2% in the July-Sept quarter, after a robust 7.8% in the first three months of the financial year.

## Woman eating golgappa gets lockjaw in UP

One bite at a roadside stall in UP's Auraiya sent a woman (42) from chaos to chaos Saturday. Family members at first chuckled, thinking she was exaggerating the struggle to shut her mouth after eating a golgappa. That amusement soon evaporated and they rushed her to the district hospital. Doctors tried manually resetting the dislocated jaw but couldn't get

it to move. They transferred her to Ahilyabai Holkar Medical College where a team worked for an hour to ease the jaw back in place. Relatives said this had never happened to her before. She had travelled to the district hospital only to accompany her niece for delivery. Stepping out for a snack seemed harmless until the golgappa refused to let her reclaim her bite. **TNN**

## Prasar Bharati chairperson quits abruptly: Navneet Kumar Sehgal, a retired 1988-batch IAS officer of the UP cadre, has resigned as chairperson of Prasar Bharati, barely months after taking charge. Sehgal was appointed to the post on March 16, 2024, following his superannuation as UP additional chief secretary last year. His exit has triggered speculation in official circles. Sources said the I&B ministry has accepted his resignation. **TNN**

## IndiGo flight cuts send the air fares soaring

Flying a million passengers every three days, the impact in terms of number of flyers hit is lakhs.

The volume of public inconvenience and outcry on social media led the aviation authorities to act. Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has called the airline's senior management Thursday “to explain the unprecedented disruptions”

and also present a plan on how they hope to get back on track in the ongoing peak travel season. “DGCA is investigating the situation and evaluating measures along with the airline to reduce cancellations and delays in order to minimise inconvenience being caused to passengers,” an official said.

IndiGo announced Wednesday evening it had “initiated calibrated adjustments”, or flight cuts. **TNN**

## 5 from B'desh get life in terror conspiracy case

**Kolkata:** A sessions court in Kolkata on Wednesday sentenced five Bangladeshis to life imprisonment after holding them guilty of conspiring to carry out terrorist attacks in India, waging war against the country and possessing fake Indian documents, reports **Dwaipayan Ghosh**.

One accused, Abdul Kalam, was discharged for lack of evidence. Those convicted were Anwar Hossain Faruque, Md Rubel, Maulana Yusuf Sk, Md Sahidul Islam and Jabirul Islam. The six, suspected to be members of terror outfit Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen Bangladesh, were arrested by Kolkata STF in Sept 2016. It was alleged they planned bomb blasts in various parts of India, including the northeast.

# Prisoner not taken to court on 65% of dates, SC raps Maha

**Mumbai:** Producing an undertrial prisoner in court was a fundamental safeguard to enable them to air grievances, said Supreme Court as it censured state prison authorities for their failure to produce an inmate on 65% of the court dates.

“We are shocked at the conduct of the state authorities,” said the bench of Justices Ahsanuddin Amanullah and Prashant Kumar Mishra and directed the director general, prisons, to conduct a “personal inquiry into the matter and fix responsibility and take action against the persons concerned”.

The accused, Shashi Jurmani, in custody for more than four years, petitioned SC for bail in a criminal attempt to murder case registered at Ulhasnagar in 2021. The apex court granted Jurmani bail subject to conditions to be imposed by the trial court. Jurmani's counsel submitted that he was not even produced before a court on 55 dates out of 85.

The apex court bench heard state counsel Raman Yadav's response and noted that the submission of the petitioner's counsel, Sana Raees Khan, regarding the undertrial inmate's non-production in the court had “not been controverted”.

The initial allegation against the petitioner in the FIR was that he, along with others, stabbed a man as well as a police constable.

However, later, the man, who died after two months, “clearly” said in his statement that the petitioner only assaulted him with fists and kicks and it was another accused who had stabbed the policeman with a knife.

The police constable, in his statement, did not name any accused and only described the physical build, noted the apex court order.

The petitioner claimed that he had no criminal antecedents and a co-accused had been granted bail. “We are shocked at the conduct of the state authorities. The production of an accused before the court is not only to ensure a speedy trial but more importantly, as a safeguard so that the prisoner is not abused otherwise, and he comes directly in contact with the court to air his grievances, if any, against the authorities. We find that there has been a grave infraction of such fundamental safeguard, which is appalling and shocking. We deprecate the same,” said Supreme Court.

“If any attempt is made to protect or shield any person”, SC said the DG prisons or the head of department to whom it was entrusting the inquiry, “shall be personally held responsible”.

The court sought a report with an affidavit personally affirmed by the officer in two months, when the matter would next be heard.
