Rs. 30.75 cr expansion for Kapaleeswarar College

Chennai,Aug 31: The state government has sanctioned Rs 30.75 crore for the second phase expansion of Arulmigu Kapaleeswarar Arts and Science College in Kolathur, including a girls' hostel, auditorium and playgrounds, HR&CE minister C Ramesh told the assembly on Monday. Responding to a question from Kolathur TVK MLA V S Babu on additional buildings and introduction of evening classes, Ramesh said tenders would soon be floated for the second phase of construction. The college, administered by the Kapaleeswarar temple in Mylapore, is functioning from a campus on Poompohar Nagar Main Road in Kolathur. The land belongs to the Somanatha Swamy temple in Kolathur. The first phase of construction has been completed and the buildings are in use. Ramesh said the second phase would include additional college buildings, a hostel for women students, an auditorium and sports facilities. The possibility of introducing evening classes would be examined after the second-phase works are completed, and further action would be taken based on the assessment, he said. The minister also said he would inspect the college after the ongoing assembly session and review the facilities required for students.

Six-member panel to inspect Mullaiperiyar dam

Theni,Aug 31: A six-member expert panel constituted under the National Dam Safety Authority will begin a four-day inspection of the Mullaiperiyar dam from Tuesday, assessing its structural strength, seepage, foundation condition and long-term safety. The Dam Safety Evaluation Panel, headed by former National Hydroelectric Power Corporation chairman and managing director Balraj Joshi, will conduct the inspection from September 1 to 4. The team will stay at Thekkady on the Tamil Nadu-Kerala border during the exercise. The panel includes experts from different fields, including water resources management and earthquake engineering. M L Sharma, professor of earthquake engineering at IIT Roorkee, is among the members. During the four-day exercise, the experts will examine the present condition of key structures of the dam, its structural strength, seepage levels, foundation stability and maintenance works. The team will also review the status and effectiveness of strengthening works carried out at the dam earlier and assess measures required for its long-term safety and maintenance. The inspection assumes significance against the backdrop of Kerala's continuing demand for a comprehensive safety assessment of the Mullaiperiyar dam and its proposal for a new dam. Tamil Nadu has maintained that scientific and technical assessments of the dam's safety can be carried out, while insisting that its irrigation and water rights should not be affected.

TN unveils fintech, electronics and logistics projects

Chennai, Aug 31: Tamil Nadu will establish a Rs 400 crore digital finance hub in Coimbatore and a semiconductor and electronics manufacturing park in Kanchipuram district as part of a series of industrial and infrastructure projects announced by the state government on Monday. Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay, making the announcements in the Assembly under Rule 110, said the Coimbatore Fintech Hub would be developed by TIDCO with office spaces, facilities for startups, advanced laboratories and infrastructure for training and skill development. The project is aimed at attracting global investments, promoting emerging technologies and creating high-quality jobs. At Maduramangalam in Kancheepuram district, SIPCOT will establish a semiconductor and electronics manufacturing park at a cost of Rs 175 crore. The park will have research and development facilities and is expected to attract investments of around Rs 2,000 crore and generate about 5,000 direct and indirect jobs. The government also proposed a multimodal logistics hub in the Tiruchirappalli region, taking advantage of its central location in the state. TIDCO will conduct a feasibility study and prepare a detailed project report for the facility. Vijay also announced Rs 1,762 crore worth of works to strengthen the state's power distribution infrastructure. The project includes setting up 36 new 33/11 kV substations and installing new distribution transformers. Damaged and ageing cables, conductors, pillar boxes, circuit breakers and other equipment will also be replaced as part of the distribution network upgrade.
