New regulations for school buses from next academic year

THE MAHARASHTRA transport department is set to introduce a new set of regulations for private school buses starting from the next academic year that will include them to have a panic button, fire suppression sprinklers, GPS tracking systems and CCTV cameras installed. Additionally, schools or private bus operators charging transportation fees from parents must have a centralized CCTV surveillance system for monitoring their fleet. A committee headed by retired transport officer Jitendra Patil has been appointed to draft these guidelines and has been directed to submit its report within a month. The decision comes after multiple complaints from parents regarding the functioning of school buses operated by various institutions across the state. The transport department re-

cently held an important meeting to address these concerns and ensure the safety of students commuting by school buses.

Transport Minister Pratap Sarnaik stated that the new measures are being introduced in response to concerns raised by parents.

"A new set of regulations will be established for private school buses transporting students, effective from the upcoming academic year. Institutions or school bus operators who charge transportation fees from parents must have centralized CCTV surveillance of the buses," he said.

The transport department will review the committee's recommendations before finalising the regulations. Once implemented, schools and bus operators will be required to comply with these safety measures to continue operating. The move aims to bring accountability to school bus operations and improve safety standards for students.

Shirke family says 'will protest' Chhaava film's historical inaccuracy

A DESCENDANT of the historic Shirke family of Maharashtra on Monday said that members of the family might take to the streets in protest against the inaccuracies shown in the film Chhaava. The Shirke family has alleged that two of their ancestors, Maratha commanders Ganoji and Kanhoji Shirke, were shown in the film as having betrayed Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj, leading to his capture by the Mughal emperor Aurangzeb.

"Our reputation has been deeply affected. The whole of India thinks of us as gaddar (traitors). If the filmmakers continue to ignore us, we will take to the streets in protest. The Shirke family numbers are in lakhs in Maharashtra," said Deepak Raje Shirke, a member of the family. He added that the "Chhaava was, otherwise, a good film and the story of Chhatrapati Sambhaji Maharaj should come before audiences." "Only the few controversial parts must be removed," said Deepak Raje Shirke.

On Monday, several members of the family visited the temple of the family's deity in their ancestral village of Shirkioli to plan their resistance to the film Chhaava. The film, which released on February 14, has been directed by Lakshman Utekar and stars Vicky Kaushal, Ashutosh Rana, Akshaya Khanna and Divya Dutta.

On February 20, the family sent a legal notice to the filmmakers, the publisher of the novel and its rights holders. "A couple of days

BJP minister holds janata darbar in Shinde fort Thane, says 'no rivalry'

'No one can hold dominance over a city forever'

MAHARASHTRA FOREST Minister Ganesh Naik of the BJP on Monday held a "janata darbar" in Thane, the home turf of Deputy Chief Minister and Shiv Sena chief Eknath Shinde, while stating that "no one can hold dominance over any city forever".

The development came amid speculations of a rift in the ruling Mahayuti coalition comprising BJP, Shiv Sena and NCP.

Without naming anyone, Naik told reporters on Monday that no one can hold dominance over any region forever in politics.

"No one can hold dominance in any city or district forever...There are always ups and downs in politics and what matters is one's public image and acceptance among the people. As and when leadership changes, situation changes and based on the public acceptance, the dominance can be established," he said.

BJP had been trying to regain its ground in Shinde's turf, Thane. Naik was insistent on getting the guardian minister post of Thane, which Shinde managed to get. However, Naik dismissed speculations of rivalry between the Mahayuti allies.

"Janata darbar is being held everywhere to ensure that the issues of the citizens reaches to the administration and are resolved," the BJP minister said

adding that the next one in Thane will be held in March.

"All the three parties (BJP, Shiv Sena and NCP) are holding 'janata darbar' as a grand alliance and there is no competition or rivalry... Since I became a minister in 1995, I have been holding 'Janata Darbars' in Thane city, Mira Bhayandar, Navi Mumbai and every taluka of the district. Therefore, the 'janata darbar' is not to give a challenge to Shinde," he added.

The event was attended by NCP MLA Sanjay Kelkar and MLC Niranjan Davkhare.

Naik's son and former MP Sanjeev Naik said the janata darbar initiative was held on the directions of Chief Minister Fadnavis, who is keen to resolve citizens' problems at their doorsteps rather than making

them visit Mantralaya.

Meanwhile, Transport Minister Pratap Sarnaik announced that he will hold a "janata darbar" in Palghar district, of which Naik is the Guardian Minister.

Transport Minister Sarnaik said that there was "nothing wrong" in holding 'janata darbar'.

"It is our duty to hold 'janata darbar'... Naik ji was guardian minister of Thane earlier and hence he would hold Janata Darbar in Thane... Every minister can hold 'janata darbar' anywhere in the state. I will also be holding the 'janata darbar' in Palghar. There is nothing wrong in it," he said.

On February 3, Naik had also addressed a 'janata darbar' in Vashi in Navi Mumbai and in Palghar district on February 21.

Since the Mahayuti government came to power last year, there has been various instances pointing to growing unease between the leadership of alliance partners BJP and Shinde's Shiv Sena. The Shiv Sena was upset that Fadnavis did not concede their demands for the posts of Guardian Minister in Nashik and Raigad.

Last week, the Chief Minister's Office ordered an inquiry into a stalled Rs 900-crore housing project in Jalna that was approved for revival in 2023 by then Chief Minister Shinde.

In an order issued February 17, the government underlined "irregularities" in Minimum Support Price (MSP) schemes and selection of nodal agencies for crop procurement during Shinde's regime.

Nigerian woman held with drugs worth Rs 1.04 cr

Palghar: A Nigerian woman and an auto-rickshaw driver were arrested in Palghar allegedly with mephedrone worth Rs 1.04 crore, a police officer said on Monday. The duo was held on February 22 from Pragati Nagar area in Nalsopara following a tip-off, ACP Madan Ballal said.

"We seized 520 grams of mephedrone worth Rs 1.04 crore. They have been charged under NDPS Act and further probe is on," the ACP said. PTI

MSP SCHEMES Shiv Sena will support decision against any irregularities, says Minister Sanjay Shirsat

AS THE BJP-led state government re-examined yet another decision taken by the previous regime headed by its key ally and Deputy CM Eknath Shinde's Shiv Sena, Shinde-led Sena leader and Minister Sanjay Shirsat on Monday supported the move, saying the party will support the decision against any irregularities.

In an order issued on February 17, the Devendra Fadnavis-led government underlined "irregularities" in Minimum Support Price (MSP) schemes and selection of nodal agencies for crop procurement, and set up a panel to formulate a "comprehensive policy" in this regard.

The decision taken by the state's Marketing Ministry under BJP's Jaykumar Rawal to form a six-member committee comes in the wake of complaints of alleged irregularities and 'demand for money' by procurement agencies that were approved by the previous government for agricultural produce under the Centre's Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay Sanrakshan Abhiyan (PM-AASHA) scheme. The committee will submit a report in a month's time.

Speaking about it, Minister Sanjay Shirsat said that if any agency has indulged in any wrongdoing and investigation is being done, then the party will support it. "Any investigation being car-

ried out as per the rules will be supported. We are sending a message that be it anyone who does anything wrong, will be punished. When a person sits on high chair, he has full responsibility to correct any wrong decision taken previously. It is our stand that they should not be any wrong work or irregularities committed by any minister or the government. Hence, we support whatever stand Devendra Fadnavis ji has taken... if there is anything wrongdoing action then it should be inquired into and also action should be taken about it," Shirsat told the reporters in Mumbai.

The opposition MVA leaders, however, criticised Shinde and the government.

Reacting to the recent decision of setting up a panel to inquire into the appointment of state-level nodal agencies for procurement under MSP and ongoing alleged cold war between Shinde and Fadnavis, Sena UBT MP Priyanka Chaturvedi said, "The rift between Devendra Fadnavis and his Deputy Eknath Shinde is widening every day and it is for all to see. Good to see that the CM is not bowing down to coalition push and pulls to stop the contract raj that perpetrated when Shinde was at the helm," Chaturvedi said.

"Devendra Fadnavis was the Dy Chief Minister, part of the most corrupt government. So why did it not ring the bell when such decisions were made," asked Congress spokesperson Atul Londe.

Report blames high selenium in Punjab-Haryana wheat for hair loss in Buldhana

Mumbai: Incidents of sudden hair loss or acute onset alopecia totalis in Buldhana district, which hit national headlines, are linked to high selenium content found in wheat from Punjab and Haryana supplied by local ration shops, a report by Padma Shri awardee expert Dr Himmatrao Bavaskar has said.

These cases were reported in 279 individuals in 18 villages between December 2024 and January this year, prompting authorities to order a probe.

The affected individuals, many of whom were college students and young girls, faced significant social challenges due to the condition, including disrupted educational pursuits and arranged marriages. The social stigma surrounding alopecia led some to shave their scalps in an attempt to avoid embarrassment.

"We found that individuals, primarily young women, were presenting with symptoms such as headache, fever, scalp itching, tingling, and, in some cases, vomiting and loose motions. The primary cause of the outbreak was linked to wheat imported from Punjab and Haryana, which has been found to have a significantly higher selenium content than locally produced wheat," Bavaskar, MD of Bavaskar Hospital and Research Centre in Raigad, said. PTI
