Amid backlash, TN brings six schemes for sanitary workers

Initiatives include provision of free breakfast, housing, edu among others

IN the backdrop of the criticisms from its allies as well as opposition parties regarding the manner in which the DMK government handled the strike of sanitation staff in Chennai, especially how they were evicted from the protest site on Wednesday night, the state government on Thursday announced six special schemes for these workers across the state.

The schemes include provision of free breakfast, housing, enhanced insurance cover, special focus in identifying and treating occupational diseases, support for self-employment, and support for children of sanitation workers to pursue higher education.

The CM, referring to the special schemes, said on X that his government would never compromise on the dignity of sanitation workers, who toil tirelessly at all hours to keep the cities running every day.

Finance Minister Thangam Thennarasu, who briefed the reporters, appealed to the workers protesting privatisation of solid waste management in two Greater Chennai Corporation zones, to give up their strike and return to work,



emphasising that the government is keen about their welfare.

Highlighting that the sanitation workers faced issues in preparing and having breakfast since they report to work early in the morning, he said that for those working in urban local bodies, breakfast will be provided to them by the respective civic body free of cost. In the first phase, this scheme will be implemented in Chennai and later to other parts of the state.

The minister said another scheme will be implemented to treat occupational diseases faced by sanitation workers, who face high risk of contracting respiratory and skin-related ailments.

He also said the workers will receive insurance coverage of ₹5 lakh that would be paid to their families

if they died in harness. "To improve the socio-economic status of cleanliness workers and their families, when they start self-employment, they will be provided with a subsidy of 35% of the project cost up to a maximum of ₹3.5 lakh. In addition, an interest subsidy of 6% will be granted to enable them to start the business and repay the loan without default. An annual allocation of ₹10 crore will be made for this new scheme," he said.

The minister said that in the next three years, 30,000 houses will be built through the welfare board under the schemes implemented by the Tamil Nadu Housing Board and Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board. Regarding the key demand of regularisation of their service and dropping the privatisation plan, the minister said, "Cases are pending before the Madras HC as well as before the labour tribunals. The government will take decisions based on the verdicts."

On why the workers were forcibly detained at midnight, the minister said, "They were not evicted from the striking spot on the first day of the protest. Only after the (Madras HC) court verdict (on Wednesday), were they evicted."

AMIDST the raging controversy over the Supreme Court order, RSS chief Mohan Bhagwat on Thursday said stray dog crisis can be resolved by regulating the canine population, and not by sending the animals to shelter homes. All animals have the right to live, said Bhagwat speaking at the birth-anniversary celebrations of Sri Sachchidananda Math organised by the Gaudiya Vaishnava Sammilani at Cuttack. He emphasised the fine equilibrium between man and nature. "The crisis can be solved by regulating the street dog population and not by sending them to shelters," he said.

Criminal cases against dissent an affront to democracy, says Kerala High Court

KOCHI: The Kerala HC has held that clamping persons expressing dissent or raising criticisms with criminal cases is an affront to the democratic values enshrined in the Constitution. Justice V G Arun made the remarks while quashing the criminal proceedings against two persons for allegedly posting negative comments in a WhatsApp group regarding the collection of money to the Kerala CM's Distress Relief Fund (CMDRF), towards rehabilitation of the Choorimala-Mundakkal landslide victims. The petition was filed by Gowri Sankari V S and Prashanth Bellulaya seeking to quash the case.

SC cancels bail, Darshan back in jail

IN a major setback to Sandalwood star Darshan Thoogudeepa, his friend Pavithra Gowda and five others, the Supreme Court on Thursday set aside the Karnataka High Court's order granting bail to them in the Renukawamy murder case. Following cancellation of bail, all seven accused were arrested on Thursday afternoon. "The order (Karnataka High Court) is set aside, and bail granted to the accused is set aside," said a two-judge Bench of the top court, headed by Justice JB Pardiwala and Justice R Mahadevan.

The court, which had earlier reserved judgement on July 24, 2025, pronounced the order after hearing an appeal filed by the Karnataka government, challenging the High Court order granting bail to Pavithra Gowda, Darshan and five others in the sensational murder case. In earlier hearings, the court had termed the HC order granting bail as a "perverse exercise" of discretionary power.
