# Security up amid hoax bomb threats Drug racket busted, 5 held with 18L psychotropic pills

Emails to Secretariat, Assembly, Red Fort & two schools prompt searches on premises

SEVERAL establishments in the Capital, including the Delhi Secretariat, Delhi Assembly, Red Fort and two prominent schools, received bomb threat emails on Monday, prompting the authorities to check the premises thoroughly before declaring it to be a hoax.

Delhi Assembly Speaker and former Aam Aadmi Party MLA Dilip Pandey also received similar threat emails.

Taking to X (formerly Twitter), Pandey wrote, "Today, I received a bomb threat on my personal email ID, and since the matter was related to public safety, I have immediately forwarded the email to @CPDelhi @DelhiPolice for their review and necessary action."

According to officials, the Delhi Secretariat, Delhi Army Public School in Dhaula Kuan, Air Force Bal Bharti School in the Lodhi Road area and the Delhi Assembly & its Speaker had received bomb threats from the Khalistan National Army.

The emails warned of a blast at the Delhi Army School cam-

## Bomb squads, quick reaction teams on standby

Security has been tightened at all metro stations and locations across the city. The Delhi Police, which has been coordinating with Central agencies, stepped up its surveillance. Bomb disposal squads, dog squads & quick reaction teams have been deployed at strategic spots.

pus at 1.11 pm, the Vidhan Sabha at 3.11 pm and Red Fort at 9.11 am. Police, along with other authorities, promptly reached the spots and vacated them. Bomb disposal squads conducted a search but found nothing suspicious. According to the police, they are trying to trace the IP address through which the threat was issued.

Security has been tightened at all metro stations and prominent locations across the city in view of the threat. The Delhi Police, which has been coordinating with Central agencies, stepped up its surveillance. Bomb disposal squads, dog squads and quick reaction teams have been deployed at strategic locations. Footage of

CCTV cameras installed in the areas is being regularly monitored.

Notably, the fresh bomb threats came just days after Delhi was placed on high alert following intelligence inputs about imminent IED attacks by the Lashkar-e-Taiba to avenge the blast at a mosque in Islamabad on February 6. Central agencies believe the outfit is plotting attacks across big cities in the country, including at a temple in the Chandni Chowk area. Earlier this month, at least 15 schools and Parliament received bomb threat emails.

DELHI police have busted an international drug trafficking gang with alleged ties to the United Kingdom and seized more than 18 lakh psychotropic tablets worth ₹9 crore. Five people have been arrested in connection with the case so far.

The matter dates back to October 7 last year, when the crime branch acted on a tip-off and laid a trap at Mehak Apartment, Madanpur Khadar Extension-I, Sarita Vihar, from where Mohammad Abid (50) was apprehended. As many as 54,000 Tramadol Hydrochloride tablets weighing 14.472 kg were recovered by the police.

During the interrogation, the supply chain of the illegal pharmaceutical network was systematically exposed. Abid disclosed that he had procured the tablets from Javed Khan, his relative and son-in-law. Khan, who was arrested on October 30, named the owner of Prahlad Logistics in Samalka, Sunil Kumar, as his source dur-



ing questioning.

Sunil Kumar was arrested on November 2 last year and he, in turn, revealed Vishnu Dutt Sharma as the supplier. Sharma, who works as an exporter, was also arrested on November 2. He revealed further links to Vikash Singh alias Ishwar Singh and TC Sedana. Vikash was nabbed on November 6. Proceedings are underway to declare another associate, Naushad alias Bablu, a proclaimed offender.

The investigation has revealed that Sharma had exported a container disguised as a

household item, concealing 32 boxes of Tramadol and other prohibited tablets destined for the United Kingdom. Police coordinated with customs authorities to hold the container. The shipment was not delivered in the UK and was returned to India, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Crime) Vikram Singh said.

The container arrived at the T-3 Terminal of the Mundra Port in Gujarat. Once police custody was obtained, a joint raid was conducted on February 16, during which a large number of psychotropic substances were recovered.

As part of the investigation, police seized 54,000 tablets of Tramadol on October 7 last year. Later, police seized 13.8 lakh tablets of Alprazolam (Alpzar 1 mg), 1.95 lakh tablets of Alprazolam (Alpz-1), 1.35 lakh tablets of Tramadol, 30,000 tablets of Zolpidem, and 52,000 tablets of Nitrazepam on February 16. The total weight of the recovered items was 528.4 kilograms, the DCP said.

## Now, 20% posts of male constables in city police reserved for former Agniveers

LIEUTENANT-Governor V K Saxena on Monday announced 20% reservation for former Agniveers in Delhi Police male constable recruitment with exemption from the physical efficiency test and three years of relaxation in the prescribed upper age limit.

The Agniveer scheme was launched in 2022 for the recruitment of Indian youths to serve in the armed forces.

"Delhi L-G VK Saxena has approved an amendment in Rule 9 of Delhi Police (Appointment & Recruitment) Rules, 1980, to incorporate provisions for recruitment of ex-Agniveers as male constables (executive)," an official statement said.

The official communication said: "Ex-Agniveers will get 20% reservation in recruitment



to the post of constables in Delhi Police. They will also get an exemption from the physical efficiency test and three years of relaxation in the prescribed upper age limit."

"Further, age relaxation of five years beyond the prescribed upper age limit of 25 years will be given to the candi-

dates of the first batch of the Agniveer scheme," the statement added.

According to officials, after this amendment, a large number of ex-Agniveers will be eligible for appointment as constables in the Delhi Police. At present, there are 42,451 sanctioned posts of male constables (Executive) in the Delhi Police. Constables are appointed through a direct recruitment process, and the age limit for the same is 18 to 25 years.

The new provisions will ensure that ex-Agniveers have a smoother transition into law enforcement roles, recognising their four-year service in the armed forces. They will get a better chance to serve society due to their prior training and experience, it said.

## Unemployed wife not idle, can't disregard her labour, says HC

THE Delhi HC has stressed that a homemaker's labour helps the earning spouse function effectively and it was "unjust" to disregard her contributions while deciding maintenance by equating her joblessness with idleness.

Justice Swarana Kanta Sharma, while deciding on a maintenance application, observed that though women who can and are willing to work should be encouraged, "the denial of maintenance on the sole grounds that she is capable of earning and should not remain dependent upon her husband is a flawed approach." The law must ensure that the spouse who invested time, effort and years into building the family is not left economically stranded, the judge added.

The bench emphasised that the law must recognise not only financial earnings but also the "economic value" of a wife's contribution to the home and the domestic relationship during the subsistence of marriage.

Managing a household, caring for children, supporting the family and adjusting one's life around the career & transfers of the earning spouse are all forms of work, even though they were unpaid and often unacknowledged, the judge noted, adding, "These responsibilities do not appear in bank statements or generate taxable income, yet they form the invisible structure on which many families function."

"The assumption that a non-earning spouse is 'idle' reflects a misunderstanding of domestic contributions. To describe non-employment as idleness is easy. But to recognise the labour involved in sustaining a household is far more difficult. A homemaker does not sit idle; she performs labour that enables the earning spouse to function effectively. To disregard this contribution while adjudicating claims of maintenance would be unrealistic and unjust. This court is, therefore, unable to agree with any view that equates the non-employment of a wife with idleness or deliberate dependence on the husband," the judge held in an order passed on February 16.

The high court was hearing an appeal against an order of a magisterial court, which had refused to grant interim maintenance to the woman on the grounds that she was able-bodied and well-educated but had chosen not to seek employment.

### 'All forms of work'

Managing a household, caring for children, supporting the family are all forms of work, the high court stressed
