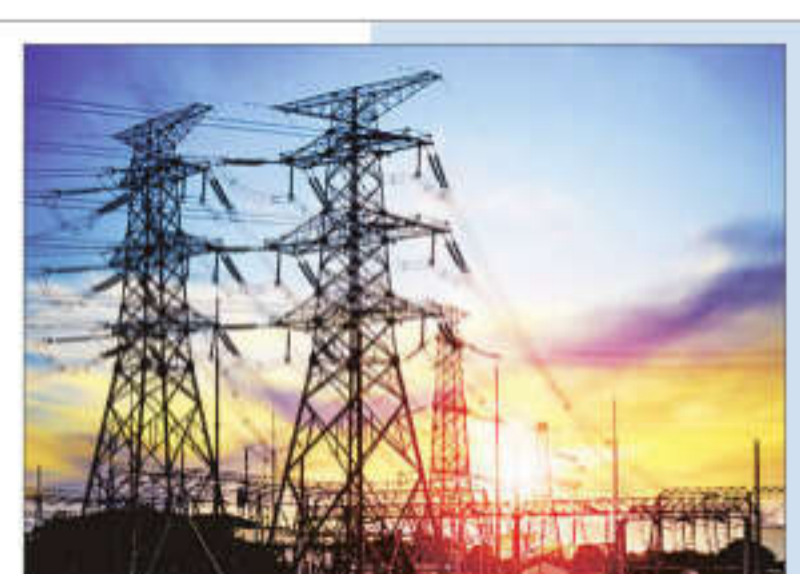
Induction push to lift power demand

■ Induction cooktop adoption could add 13-27 GW to peak power demand by FY27

■ Govt estimates 30-40% rise in demand for induction cooktops this fiscal

A SURGE IN induction cooktop adoption—triggered by LPG shortages and global energy disruptions—could add 13-27 GW to India's peak power demand by FY27, forcing policymakers to recalibrate supply planning ahead of a record summer load. "We are expecting that the additional demand would be in the range of 13-27 GW in low and high induction cooking adaption," said Krushna Chandra Panigrahy, director general at the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE), highlighting the scale of emerging demand pressures.

The shift assumes significance as India's peak power demand is already projected to touch a record 271 GW this summer, with additional load from electric cooking likely to strain distribution networks, particularly during morning and evening peaks. Panigrahy noted that the transition to electric cooking is already underway and beginning to reshape consumption patterns. "The transition has started... and it is expected to introduce an additional layer of demand, particularly during the morning and evening peak

hours, and this will be seen at the distribution level," he said.

The demand spike is being driven by a sharp increase in induction cooktop sales since March 2026, when consumers turned to electric alternatives amid tight LPG availability. Government sources estimate a 30-40% rise in demand for induction cooktops this fiscal, reflecting a rapid behavioural shift in urban and semi-urban households.

India currently sells 10-11 million induction units annually, but a senior official indicated that much of the recent growth is coming from tier II cities, where consumers are increasingly adopting electric cooking as a reliable alternative.

The shift is also visible in pricing trends. Entry-level induction cooktops, typically priced at around ₹1,800, have seen modest rise of about ₹150-200, while premium models have recorded steeper price gains, according to market data.

Rising adoption of electric cooking is expected to create localised demand spikes at the distribution level, adding stress to grids already grappling with seasonal peaks and supply disruptions linked to global fuel markets. In response, the government has initiated measures to shore up electricity availability. The power ministry has deferred maintenance shutdowns at thermal plants and is operationalising additional

capacity to ensure around 10,000 MW of extra supply during peak summer demand.

"Power plants have to annually take shutdowns... but this has been postponed to make available electricity to meet peak demand," said Piyush Singh, additional secretary, power ministry, adding that the move will offset the 8,000 MW capacity loss due to disruptions in LNG supplies. Centre is also ramping up generation capacity across sources. About 22,361 MW of additional capacity is expected to be added in the next three months, including 10,000 MW of solar, 3,500 MW of thermal and 1,900 MW of battery storage, alongside wind, hydro and hybrid projects.

...demand may rise 6.5% in FY27

INDIA'S ELECTRICITY CONSUMPTION touched a record ~149 billion units (BUs) in March 2026, but growth slowed sharply to 1.7% year-on-year as unseasonal rains and weaker industrial momentum tempered demand, according to a Crisil Intelligence report.

"Power demand in March rose to ~149 BUs... however, the growth rate was a modest 1.7% on-year," the report said, flagging a divergence between rising consumption levels and slowing growth momentum.

Despite the moderation, demand remains structurally strong, with Crisil estimating 5.5-6.5% growth in FY27, driven by rising temperatures and lower rainfall if El Nino conditions materialise — potentially pushing cooling demand higher.

March consumption was the highest for the month since at least 2010, reflecting the steady expansion of India's electricity demand base even as near-term drivers softened. The moderation was largely weather-led. **FE BUREAU**

Rubio to visit India in May

● US diplomat discusses trade, Quad with Misri

US SECRETARY OF State Marco Rubio is set to visit New Delhi next month, it was announced here after his "productive meeting" with India's Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri on a range of issues, including trade and the Quad.

Misri, who is on a three-day visit in Washington, met Rubio at the White House on Thursday. The two leaders reviewed bilateral relationships, especially trade, critical minerals, defence and the Quad.

"Welcome to the White House Vikram Misri! Productive meeting with Sec Rubio that focused on our bilateral relationship, especially trade, critical minerals, defence and the Quad," US Ambassador to India, Sergio Gorr, who was also present at the meeting, posted on X.

Secretary Rubio looks forward to visiting India next month, Gorr said. "We look forward to deepening our engagement in these important sectors and much

more to strengthen the India-US Comprehensive Global Strategic Partnership," the Indian embassy in the US said in a post on X.

Earlier, Misri held separate meetings with US Deputy Secretary Christopher Landau and US Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs, Allison Hooker.

"Deputy Secretary of State Christopher Landau met with Indian Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri today in Washington. The leaders reaffirmed the close partnership between the two countries and shared news about the situation in the Persian Gulf and other global and

regional priorities," Tommy Pigott, Principal Deputy Spokesman for the Department of State, said in a statement.

According to the Indian embassy, Misri and Landau discussed bilateral priorities and also exchanged assessments on regional and global developments of mutual concern.

Hooker said she and Misri discussed how India and the US can work closer together on security, defence, and the economy. "We are finding practical ways to make both Americans and Indians safer and more prosperous, including through the Quad," she said.

India splurges on Russian oil as sanctions threat fades

waiver allowing the purchase of Russian oil to be extended before it expires in the coming days. But purchases are unlikely to drop back even without that, given a dearth of supply options, they added.

"Our priority is to source the energy needed to meet our domestic demand," Sujata Sharma, joint secretary in the oil ministry, said, when asked how critical US waivers were to India's decision to import Russian oil. The choice "is driven by the



technical commercial feasibility of the crude and the commercial sense it makes to our refiners," she said during a briefing on Friday.

Imports from Russia averaged 1.98 million barrels a day in March, the highest since June 2023, according to data from intelligence firm Kpler.

The figure has dipped in April to an average of 1.57 million barrels a day — but that's largely because Nayara Energy's 400,000 barrel-a-day refinery, which runs largely on Russian crude, has shut down for maintenance. Volumes are expected to pick up again from next month, the executives said.

The world's third-largest oil importer went from taking only a fraction of its crude from Russia to becoming the largest seaborne buyer after the invasion of Ukraine in 2022, as India seized on prices that became heavily discounted as others pulled away. That all changed last year, when US President Donald Trump began applying pressure on India to stop, introducing punitive tariffs and finally sanctioning Moscow's top two producers. **BLOOMBERG**

New NH projects: Gadkari bats for 100% land acquisition

UNION ROAD TRANSPORT and Highways Minister Nitin Gadkari on Friday opined that no new national highway project should be approved without a 100% land acquisition, as it is a major hurdle in road construction.

Addressing an event, Gadkari said the highways ministry has highway assets worth ₹15 lakh crore that can be monetised. "Land acquisition, forest and environment clearance are major problems in highways

projects. We had made it mandatory that without acquiring 90% of the land no new national highway projects will be started. Now I think that without acquiring 100% of the land, we should not give an appointed date for the new national highway projects," he said.

Appointed date is the formal start date for highway projects, signalling that land acquisition and clearances are sufficiently in place for construction to begin. Gadkari reiterated that con-

sultants responsible for preparing detailed project reports (DPRs) for highway construction are the real culprits behind the poor quality of highways.

He suggested that retired NHAI officials should use their skills and start firms to prepare DPRs.

A DPR is a comprehensive blueprint for a road construction project, outlining all technical, financial and logistics details necessary for its execution. **PTI**

ONGC chief: India must cut energy reliance on West Asia

AS THE WORLD scrambles to recover from the biggest energy shock in decades triggered by the West Asia conflict, India should be cautious about relying on traditional supply assumptions, particularly its proximity to West Asia for sourcing oil and gas, ONGC Chairman and CEO Arun Kumar Singh said.

India, which relied on West Asia to meet nearly half of its crude oil imports, 30% of its gas and 85-90% of LPG, must invest in building strategic storages as an insurance against price and supply dis-

ruptions, he said. The six-week long war shut the only shipping lane that was used by the Gulf countries to export crude oil, natural gas and cooking gas LPG. This led to an energy crisis in several countries, including India which had to prioritise supply of gas.

Singh warned that a shifting global order and rising geopolitical tensions are undermining long-held assumptions about energy security.

"If the world gets more and more de-globalised, we will have more and more problems," Singh said. **PTI**

BMC to launch AI facility in Mumbai to fast track approvals

THE BRIHANMUMBAI MUNICIPAL Corporation (BMC) is set to launch an advanced artificial intelligence (AI)-driven facility dedicated to the city's real estate sector. The initiative is expected to significantly improve ease of doing business by automating key approval processes, minimising manual intervention, and enabling more data-driven decision-making.

Mumbai is the largest property market in the country in terms of sales volumes. It recorded over 97,000 unit sales in 2025, while the National Capital Region leads in terms of the total value of properties sold.

"The introduction of this AI-led facility marks a significant step towards streamlining processes and enhancing transparency in Mumbai's real estate ecosystem. By leveraging technology, we aim to reduce approval timelines and improve overall efficiency for stakeholders," said Ashwini Bhide, Municipal Commissioner, BMC.

Common queries on Self-Enumeration (SE) and their Answers (Part-1)

WHAT IS SELF-ENUMERATION?
Self-Enumeration is an online process in which you fill and submit your household details on the SE portal (se.census.gov.in) yourself, without waiting for an enumerator

- ❖ **Is Self-Enumeration mandatory?**
No, it is an additional facility. If you do not do it, an enumerator will collect data during field visit
- ❖ **Can I do Self-Enumeration in any language?**
This facility is available in Hindi, English and 14 Indian languages
- ❖ **Is internet required for Self-Enumeration?**
Yes, internet is required to access the portal
- ❖ **Is my information safe?**
Yes, all data is secure, encrypted and stored on government servers
- ❖ **What is SE ID and its use?**
After submission of information, you will receive a unique 11 digit SE ID (Also via SMS/email) which must be shown to the enumerator during her/his visit to your house
- ❖ **What if SE ID is forgotten?**
It can be retrieved using the registered mobile number on the portal
- ❖ **Will an enumerator visit after Self-Enumeration?**
Yes, the enumerator will visit your home and confirm your details using the SE ID
- ❖ **Do I need to upload any documents?**
No documents are required to be uploaded
- ❖ **Is help available on the portal?**
Portal has user guide, flowcharts, tutorial videos, FAQs and tooltips
