Management continues to evaluate market conditions, changing business dynamics and the competitive landscape so as to ensure optimal utilisation of the IPO Proceeds in the subsequent periods, in accordance with the objectives as stated in the IPO Prospectus.

3. The Nomination and Remuneration Committee (NRC) of the Board of Directors of the Company at its meeting held on April 28, 2025 had approved a grant of 15,96,475 stock options at an exercise price of ₹898.04 per equity share under Employees Stock Option Plan - 2023 ("ESOP 2023") and grant of 3,87,448 stock options at an exercise price of ₹10 per equity share under Performance linked Stock Unit Scheme 2023' ("PSU 2023") to eligible employees of the Company and its subsidiaries.

The total non-cash component of Employee Benefits Expenses on account of above grants is ₹ 5.94 Crore for the quarter ended June 30, 2026.

4. During the quarter ended June 30, 2026, the Company has allotted 11,79,901 equity shares of ₹ 10 each pursuant to exercise of stock options by certain employees.
5. For financial year 2025-26, the Board had recommended a final dividend of Rs. 12.50/- per equity share. The same was approved by the Shareholders in the Annual General Meeting of the Company held on July 8, 2026 and was paid on July 10, 2026.
6. During the financial year 2024-25, the Company received a Show Cause Notice from the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) alleging non-compliance with certain provisions of applicable SEBI guidelines in relation to investments made by the Schemes of Nippon India Mutual Fund. Based on its current assessment and legal advice, the management believes that the Company has complied with the relevant guidelines. The company is actively engaging with the regulator and has filed for settlement proceedings in accordance with extant SEBI regulations. However, the settlement process is at an ongoing stage and subject to regulatory approvals. Accordingly, pending the outcome of the above, no provisions have been considered necessary in the financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026.
7. The Company is in the business of providing asset management services to the schemes of Nippon India Mutual Fund, funds launched in GIFT city, portfolio management service and advisory service to the clients / schemes. The primary segment is identified as asset management services. As such, the Company's financial results are largely reflective of the asset management business and accordingly there are no separate reportable segments as per Ind AS 108 Operating Segment.
