ITI admission deadline extended till July 31

Erode, July 3:

The last date for applying for direct admission to the 2026-27 academic year at the Government Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) in Erode (Kasipalayam) and Gobichettipalayam (Periya Kodiveri) has been extended till July 31.

According to a statement issued by the district administration, candidates who have passed Class 10 or higher are eligible to apply for two-year trades including Electrician, Fitter, Mechanic Motor Vehicle, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Technician, Turner, Machinist, COPA, Draughtsman

(Civil) and Textile Wet Processing Technician. Candidates who have passed Class 8 are eligible to apply for the Wireman trade.

Students can also enrol in new trades offered through upgraded technology centres established in collaboration with Tata Technologies, including Advanced CNC Machining Technician, Mechanic Electric Vehicle, Manufacturing Control and Automation, Industrial Robotics and Digital Manufacturing Technician, and Basic Designer and Virtual Verifier.

Students admitted to these courses will receive free training, free hostel

accommodation, a monthly stipend of Rs.750 from the Tamil Nadu Government, and an additional Rs.1,000 per month for eligible students under the Tamil Pudhalvan and Pudhumaipen schemes. They will also be provided with free textbooks, bicycles, drawing instruments, uniforms, footwear, and free bus travel passes.
