Major road infrastructure upgrade begins in Erode at Rs. 20.35 Cr

Erode, Feb. 4: As part of the Tamil Nadu Urban Road Infrastructure Scheme, Housing, Prohibition and Excise Minister Muthusamy inaugurated asphalt road-laying works worth Rs. 20.35 crore across the four zones of the Erode Municipal Corporation. Under the project, 229 roads with a total length of 45.221 kilometres will be laid as asphalt roads in six packages. The Erode Municipal Corporation maintains a total road length of 841.27 kilometres across 60 wards in its four zones. As a continuation

of infrastructure development, these works are being taken up in the second phase under the Tamil Nadu Urban Road Infrastructure Scheme. In addition, work orders will soon be issued for the construction of cement concrete roads on 90 roads, covering a length of 7.36 kilometres, at an estimated cost of Rs. 2.84 crore, to be executed in three packages. In the first phase, road works covering 1,019 roads with a total length of 1,076.6 kilometres were completed at a cost of Rs. 43 crore. In the second phase, works are

currently underway on 319 roads, spanning 52.58 kilometres, at an estimated cost of Rs. 23.19 crore. The event was attended by Collector Kandasamy, Rajya Sabha MP Anithyur P. Selvaraj, Erode East MLA V.C. Chandrakumar, Erode Corporation Mayor Nagarathinam, Municipal Commissioner Arpit Jain, Deputy Mayor V. Selvaraj, Deputy Commissioner Dhanalakshmi, Assistant Conservator of Forests (Trainee) Nithin H.R., along with other officials and departmental officers.
