

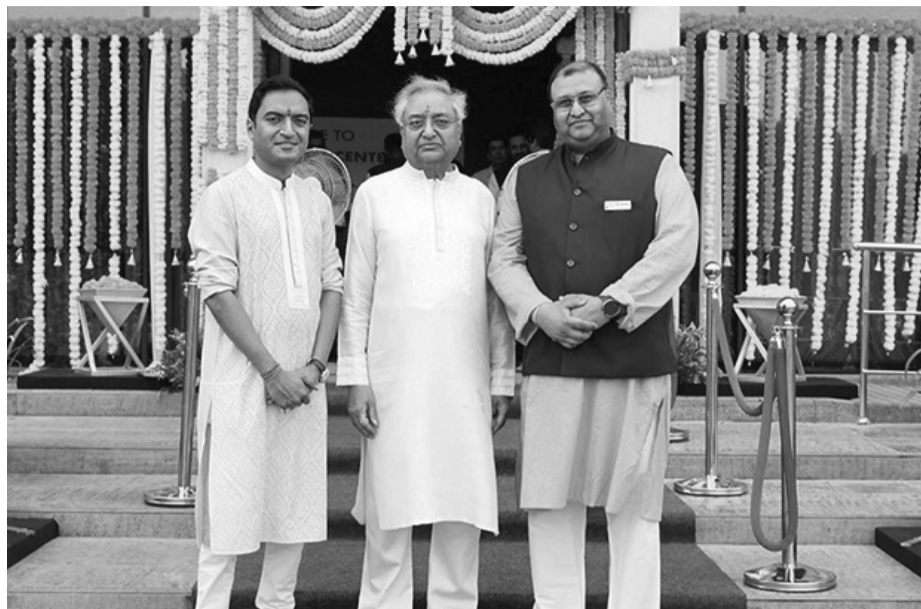

# US tariff hike poses serious threat to India's export market: FIEO chief raises concern

New Delhi, Aug 29: The Federation of Indian Export Organisations (FIEO) has expressed deep concern over the US government's decision to impose an additional 25% tariff on Indian goods. With overall tariffs on several categories now raised to as high as 50%, effective from August 27, this move is expected to severely impact India's largest export market.

FIEO President S.C. Ralhan stated that India's exports to the US could be "severely hit" by this decision. Nearly 55% of Indian exports to the US — worth around USD 47-48 billion — are now facing pricing disadvantages of 30-35%. As a result, Indian goods may become far more expensive compared to competitors from China, Vietnam, Cambodia, the Philippines, and other Southeast and South Asian countries.

Textile and apparel manufacturers in Tiruppur, Noida, and Surat have already begun shutting down operations due to declining price competitiveness, losing ground to low-cost rivals from Vietnam and Bangladesh. Similarly, seafood exports — particularly shrimp — face serious risks, as the US accounts for nearly 40% of India's seafood exports. Tariff hikes could



trigger inventory losses, supply chain disruptions, and hardships for farmers.

Other labor-intensive sectors such as leather, ceramics, chemicals, handicrafts, and carpets are also under severe pressure, especially when competing against European, Southeast Asian, and Mexican producers, Ralhan added.

Given the current crisis, Ralhan urged the government to provide immediate support, including enhanced interest subvention schemes, export credit support to maintain working capital, lower borrowing costs, easier credit access for MSMEs, and special policy guidelines from the government and the Reserve Bank of India.

He also recommended a temporary moratorium on principal and interest repayments for one-year loans, automatic enhancement of the existing credit limit by 30%, and promotion of collateral-free loans under the ECLGS scheme to ease liquidity stress without heavily burdening the exchequer.

Additionally, Ralhan emphasized the need to expand Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes, upgrade infrastructure, invest in cold-chain and storage facilities, and diversify markets aggressively through accelerated trade agreements (FTAs) with the EU, Oman, Chile, Peru, GCC, Africa, and other Latin American nations. He also underscored the importance of keeping negotiation windows open with the US.

Another key strategy, according to Ralhan, is to strengthen "Brand India" globally through innovation, enhanced certifications, and global branding initiatives, making Indian products more attractive worldwide.

Calling for urgent, coordinated action among exporters, industry bodies, and government agencies, FIEO stressed that such measures are critical to safeguard livelihoods, strengthen global trade linkages, and help Indian exporters weather this turbulent phase.

# Service initiatives mark Inner Wheel Club's golden jubilee fete
