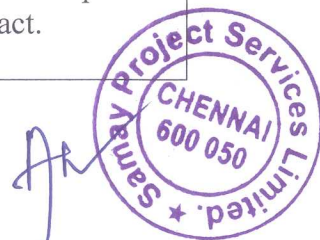

Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Schedule III of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and applicable SEBI circulars, we wish to inform that **Samay Project Services Limited ("SPSL" or "the Company")** has received a **Letter of Intent ("LOI")** from its Wholly Owned Subsidiary, **Samay BioCNG Chittoor Private Limited ("SBCPL")**, for undertaking the Engineering, Procurement, Construction, Commissioning and initial Operation & Maintenance of a **10 TPD Compressed BioGas (CBG) Plant at Baitapalle Village, Puthalapattu Mandal, Chittoor District, Andhra Pradesh.**

1. Name of the entity awarding the order(s)/contract(s)	Samay BioCNG Chittoor Private Limited, a Wholly Owned Subsidiary of Samay Project Services Limited.
2. Significant terms and conditions of order(s)/contract(s) awarded in brief	LOI for Engineering, Procurement, Construction, Commissioning and initial Operation & Maintenance of a 10 TPD CBG Plant . The scope broadly covers detailed engineering, procurement, critical civil infrastructure, complete mechanical works, process piping, electrical systems, instrumentation and automation, utilities, balance of plant, construction management, testing, commissioning, biological commissioning and

	process stabilisation. SPSL shall also undertake initial O&M of the plant for one year from successful biological commissioning , extendable by mutual agreement.
3. Whether order(s)/contract(s) have been awarded by domestic/international entity	Domestic entity
4. Nature of order(s)/contract(s)	Engineering, Procurement, Construction, Commissioning and initial Operation & Maintenance of a 10 TPD CBG Plant
5. Whether domestic or international	Domestic
6. Time period by which the order(s)/contract(s) is to be executed	The Plant is required to be completed by 30 April 2027, followed by approximately three months of biological commissioning and process stabilisation. Time is of the essence.
7. Broad commercial consideration or size of the order(s)/contract(s)	The overall estimated value of the proposed EPC Contract is approximately ₹42.50 Crore (Rupees Forty-Two Crore Fifty Lakhs only), inclusive of applicable GST. The definitive EPC Contract/Purchase Order shall be placed after completion of detailed engineering and finalisation of the BOQ/BBU.
8. Whether the promoter/promoter group/group companies have any interest in the entity that awarded the order(s)/contract(s)? If yes, nature of interest and details thereof	Yes. SBCPL is a Wholly Owned Subsidiary of Samay Project Services Limited.
9. Whether the order(s)/contract(s) would fall within related party transaction(s)? If yes, whether the same is done at "arm's length"	Yes. The transaction is a Related Party Transaction. The transaction is proposed to be undertaken on an arm's length basis , in accordance with applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 and the Company's Related Party Transactions Policy.
10. Nature of relationship with the entity awarding the order(s)/contract(s)	Wholly Owned Subsidiary
11. Scope of work	Complete EPC execution within the agreed project battery limits, including all critical civil infrastructure and complete mechanical, electrical, instrumentation and automation works, together with commissioning, biological commissioning, process stabilisation and initial O&M as specified in the LOI and definitive EPC Contract.

12. Current status / next steps	The LOI authorises SPSL to immediately commence detailed engineering, vendor finalisation, procurement planning and placement of critical/long-lead purchase orders to facilitate timely completion of the Project. The definitive EPC Contract/Purchase Order will be issued upon completion of engineering and finalisation of the BOQ/BBU.

The transaction is in the ordinary course of business of the Company and is proposed to be undertaken on an arm's length basis. The commercial arrangement is based on a Cost Plus 12.5% pricing methodology, as approved by the Audit Committee and Board of Directors of the Company.

The Company will comply with all applicable requirements relating to Related Party Transactions under the Companies Act, 2013, SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 and other applicable laws and regulations.
