- 1.** In view of Covid-19 pandemic, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“MCA”) vide Circular No. 20/2020 dated 5th May, 2020 read with Circular No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, Circular No. 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, Circular No. 02/2021-22 dated 13th January, 2021, Circular No. 02/2022 dated 5th May, 2022 and Circular No. 10/2022 dated 28th December, 2022 (collectively referred to as ‘MCA Circulars’) and Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/ CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated 12th May, 2020, SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 15th January, 2021, SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2022/62 dated 13th May, 2022 and SEBI/HO/CFD/PoD-2/P/CIR/P/2023/4 dated 5th January, 2023 issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (collectively referred to as ‘SEBI Circulars’), inter alia, permitted the holding of the Annual General Meeting (“AGM”) through Video Conferencing (“VC”) without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue. Hence, the Company is providing VC option to the members of the company to attend the meeting through video conferencing. However, the members attending the meeting through VC shall not be entitled to attend proxy. The credentials of attending the meeting through VC are given elsewhere in this Notice.
- 2.** Pursuant to the MCA Circulars, the facility to appoint proxy to attend and cast vote for the members is not available for this AGM. However, the Body Corporates are entitled to appoint authorised representatives to attend the AGM through VC/ OAVM and participate thereat and cast their votes through e-voting.
- 3.** Pursuant to the provisions of SEBI (LODR) Regulations, 2015 and Section 91 of the Companies Act, 2013, Register of Members and Shares Transfer Books of the Company will remain closed from Saturday, 1st July, 2023 to Saturday, 8th July, 2023 (both days inclusive).
- 4.** Members intending to require information about accounts at the meeting are requested to write to the Company at least 10 days in advance of the Annual General Meeting.

8. REMOTE E-VOTING AND ALSO E-VOTING DURING THE AGM:

Pursuant to provision of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Amendment Rules, 2015 the Company is pleased to offer remote e-voting facility to the members to cast their votes electronically on all resolution set forth in the notice convening 18th Annual General Meeting. The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) to provide the e-voting facility (both remote e-voting and e-voting during the AGM).The complete details of the instructions for e-voting are annexed to this notice.
9. The instructions for shareholders voting on the day of the AGM on e-voting system and instructions for attending the AGM through VC / OAVM are also annexed to this Notice separately.
10. Members, Directors, Auditors and other eligible persons to whom this notice is being circulated can attend this annual general meeting through video conferencing at least 15 minutes before the schedule time and shall be closed after expiry of 15 minutes from the scheduled time.
11. The attendance of the Members attending the AGM through VC/OAVM will be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013. Attendance of the members will be recorded on the CDSL platform at the time when the member login to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM.
12. Additional information pursuant to Regulation 36(3) of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and para 1.2.5 of Secretarial Standard on General Meeting (SS-2) notified under the Companies Act, 2013 in respect of the directors seeking appointment/reappointment at the AGM are furnished and annexed to the notice.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:**ITEM NO. 3:**

Pursuant to Section 149 and all other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Rules framed thereunder and the applicable provisions of Listing Regulations, an Independent Director shall hold office for a term up to five consecutive years on the Board of a Company and shall be eligible for reappointment on passing of a Special Resolution by the Company.

In accordance to that Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi (DIN: 08441361) was appointed as an Independent Director of the Company for a term of 5 years from 11th May, 2019 and will complete their initial term as an Independent Director of the Company on 10th May, 2024, he is eligible for re-appointment for one more term.

The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 18th April, 2023 noted that the above Director is reasonably known professional drawn from diverse fields, who bring with him a wide range of skills and experience to the Board, which enhances the quality of Board's decision-making process. The Company and the Board has immensely benefited from his experience, knowledge and strategic insights on various matters relating to the Company's business. Considering various aspects including the contribution made till now and the performance of the Company, the Board felt that it will be in the interest of the Company to re-appoint him as Independent Director.

The Board of Directors of the Company on the basis of the report of performance evaluation and the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, approved the re-appointment of Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi (DIN: 08441361) as Independent Director of the Company not liable to retire by rotation, for a second term of 5 (five) consecutive years w.e.f. 11th May, 2024.

Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi (DIN: 08441361) has given his consent to act as Independent Director of the Company and has furnished necessary declarations to the Board of Directors that he meet the criteria of Independence as provided under Section 149(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 and Regulation 16(1)(b) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. Further as per the declarations received by the Company, Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi is not disqualified to be re-appointed as Director under Section 164 of the Companies Act, 2013. The Company has received notices in writing from member under Section 160 of the Companies Act, 2013 proposing the candidature of Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi for the office of Director of the Company. In the opinion of the Board Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi fulfils the conditions specified under the Companies Act, 2013 and the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 for re-appointment as Independent Director. A brief profile of the aforesaid Independent Director proposed to be re-appointed including nature of his expertise and shareholding in the Company, etc. are given elsewhere in this Notice. He is and was not a Director in any other listed Company

None of the Directors or Key Managerial Personnel except Mr. Pramodsinh D. Dabhi either directly or through his relatives with regard to his re-appointment is, in any way, concerned or interested, whether financially or otherwise, in the resolution as set out at Item No. 3 of the Notice. The Board of Directors, therefore, recommends the Resolution as set out at Item No. 3 to be passed as Special Resolution by the Members.

ITEM NO. 4:

Pursuant to Section 148 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with the Companies (Cost Records and Audit) Rules, 2014, the Company is required to have the audit of its cost records conducted by a cost accountant in practice.

The Board has approved the appointment of M/s. A. G. Tulsian and Co., Cost Accountant for the FY 2022-23 and onwards.

Further, according to Section 148 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 14 of the Companies (Audit and Auditors) Rules 2014, the Board of Directors of the Company is authorized to appoint the cost auditors of the Company and approved the remuneration of cost auditors subject to ratification by shareholders.

Accordingly, consent of the members is sought for passing an Ordinary Resolution as set out at item no. 4 of the notice for ratification of the remuneration payable to the Cost Auditors for the financial year 2022-23 and onwards.

Moreover, in respect of financial year 2023-24 and onwards, in order to give flexibility to the Board of Directors for fixing the remuneration of cost auditors from time to time, it is proposed to obtain approval of shareholders authorizing Board of Directors to approve remuneration of cost auditors, not exceeding the limit as approved by the shareholders.

The Directors recommend this resolution to be passed as an Ordinary Resolution.

None of the Directors or KMP or their relatives are in any way concerned or interested in the resolution except to the extent of their respective shareholding in the Company.

ITEM NO. 5:

The existing Authorised Capital of the Company is Rs. 18,00,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Crores Only) comprising of 1,80,00,000 Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each. In order to have additional capital for future exigencies, it would be necessary to increase the said Authorised capital to Rs. 27,00,00,000 (Rupees Twenty Seven Crores only) comprising of 2,70,00,000 Equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each.

Section 61 of the Companies Act, 2013, provides that a limited company having a share capital may, if so authorized by its Articles of Association, with the consent of its members in its general meeting, alter the conditions of its Memorandum of Association so as to increase its share capital by such amount as it thinks expedient by issuing new shares.

Article 7 of the Articles of Association empowers that the Company may in General Meeting from time to time by Ordinary Resolution increase its capital by creation of new Shares which may be unclassified and may be classified at the time of issue in one or more classes and of such amount or amounts as may be deemed expedient. The new Shares shall be issued upon such terms and conditions and with such rights and privileges annexed thereto as the resolution shall prescribe and in particular, such Shares may be issued with a preferential or qualified right to dividends and in the distribution of assets of the Company and with a right of voting at General Meeting of the Company in conformity with Section 47 of the Act. Whenever the capital of the Company has been increased under the provisions of this Article the Directors shall comply with the provisions of Section 64 of the Act.

In view of this, the Company proposes to increase the existing authorised equity capital from Rs. 18,00,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen Crores Only) comprising of 1,80,00,000 Equity Shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each to Rs. 27,00,00,000 (Rupees Twenty Seven Crores only) comprising of 2,70,00,000 Equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each.

The proposed increase in Authorised Capital will consequently require alteration in Capital clause V of Memorandum of Association.

The Ordinary resolution is therefore proposed at item no. 5 of the notice to increase the Authorised Share Capital of the Company and the notice for making necessary alterations in Capital clause V of Memorandum of Association.

The Directors recommend these Resolutions at Item No. 5 of the accompanying Notice for the approval of the Members of the Company. The copy of the MOA after proposed alteration and other relevant documents are available for inspection at the Registered office of the Company.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REMOTE E-VOTING:

The instructions for members for voting electronically are as under:

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

Step 2 : Access through CDSL e-Voting system in case of shareholders holding shares in physical mode and non-individual shareholders in demat mode.

(i) The Remote E-voting period begins on 5th July, 2023 (Wednesday) at 9.00 a.m. (IST) and ends on 7th July, 2023 (Friday) at 5.00 p.m. (IST). During this period shareholders of the Company, holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date of 1st July, 2023 may cast their vote electronically. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting after 5.00 p.m. (IST) on 7th July, 2023.

(ii) Shareholders who have already voted prior to the meeting date would not be entitled to vote at the meeting venue

(iii) Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. **SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 9th December, 2020**, under Regulation 44 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolutions. However, it has been observed that the participation by the public non-institutional shareholders/retail shareholders is at a negligible level.

Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to **all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts/ websites of Depositories/ Depository Participants**. Demat account holders would be able to cast their vote without having to register again with the ESPs, thereby, not only facilitating seamless authentication but also enhancing ease and convenience of participating in e-voting process.

Step 1 : Access through Depositories CDSL/NSDL e-Voting system in case of individual shareholders holding shares in demat mode.

(iv) In terms of **SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated December 9, 2020** on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.
