SC orders pan-India CBI probe into digital arrest scam cases

New Delhi: Supreme Court on Monday ordered a pan-India probe by CBI into digital arrest scam cases and directed 14 states, including opposition-ruled West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, Karnataka, Jharkhand, Telangana and Kerala, to grant permission to the central agency to carry out a comprehensive pan-India investigation into these cyber-crime cases. The bench also issued notice to Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and asked it to explain to the court why Artificial Intelligence tools or machine learning technologies should not be employed to identify multiple accounts in banks and freeze the deposits suspected to be proceeds of crime.

We direct the Department of Telecom (DoT) to submit a proposal for the consideration of SC, which may eventually be required to be implemented to prevent misuse of SIM cards," it said. SC bail to man who posed as Shah's nephew in cheating case

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Monday granted bail to Ajay Kumar Nayyar, accused of cheating a businessman of his 3.9 crore by impersonating the nephew of home minister Amit Shah. A bench noted that Nayyar has undergone over 4 years in custody and the conclusion of trial will take time.

The offence carries a maximum sentence of seven years, and the petitioner has already been in custody for more than four years. "The charges were framed in 2022 and even after three years, the cross-examination of the first witness is on, while there are 31 witnesses," the bench said. His earlier bail application had been dismissed by the Delhi HC on Sept 1, which noted the "nature and expanse of the allegations against the applicant" and the possibility of amendments to charges that could attract life terms. Being as Amit Shah's nephew, Nayyar promised the lender and showed a demand draft of Rs 90 crore, asking for his 2.5 crore as processing fees. Fire breaks out in Thane factory & Andheri office

Mumbai: Two separate fires broke out in Maharashtra on Monday, one in Thane and another in Andheri, with no casualties reported.

In Thane, a blaze erupted at 5.30 am at a pearl manufacturing unit in the Raupat compound on Kalyan Road, Bhiwandi. Bhiwandi Municipal Corporation disaster management chief Sahib Khan said no one was injured. Firefighters rushed to the scene, and efforts to douse the fire were ongoing.

In Andheri, a fire broke out at 12.30 pm on the third floor of a three-story commercial building housing the Lokshahi news channel office in Andheri (East). At least four fire engines were deployed, and while the blaze was contained to the third floor, it was still burning.

NIA raids 8 places in Kashmir linked to 'white-collar terror' module case

Srinagar: The National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Monday carried out raids at eight locations in Pulwama, Shopian and Kulgam districts of Kashmir in connection with a 'white-collar' terror module case that was behind a car blast near Delhi's Red Fort, officials said here.

The NIA teams conducted searches at the residence of Moulvi Irfan Ahmad Wagon in Shopian, officials said. Wagon has emerged as the mastermind of the radicalisation and recruitment of the 'white-collar' terror module busted early last month. He was arrested by police in October, and the NIA took him into custody last month after taking over the

This year, 8 terrorists killed, 5 pushed back in infiltration bid across LoC: BSF IG

Srinagar: There was no terrorist infiltration into Kashmir across the Line of Control (LoC) this year, with eight infiltrators killed by security forces and five others pushed back, following four intrusion attempts, a senior BSF officer said on Monday. "The BSF along with the Army ensured effective and impactful domination of the LoC, which led to neutralisation of all the infiltration attempts this year from the Kashmir Valley. The force has also contributed immensely in keeping a strong security grid in the hinterland, including during the Shri Amarnath Yatra 2025," Inspector General, Border Security Force (BSF), Ashok Yadav told reporters on the 61st Rising Day of the force.
