जून तिमाही में ऐपल की भारत से रिकॉर्ड कमाई

ऐपल ने भारत और कुछ अन्य उभरते बाजारों में अपनी तीसरी तिमाही में रिकॉर्ड आय अर्जित की है। हालांकि प्रौद्योगिकी क्षेत्र की इस प्रमुख कंपनी ने आगाह किया है कि अमेरिका द्वारा लगाए गए शुल्क के कारण उसे चालू चौथी तिमाही में 1.1 बिलियन डॉलर का नुकसान हो सकता है। कंपनी ने बताया कि जून तिमाही में लगभग हर भौगोलिक क्षेत्र में आईफोन का प्रदर्शन बेहतर रहा और भारत, पश्चिम एशिया, दक्षिण एशिया और ब्राजील सहित उभरते बाजारों में दो अंक में वृद्धि दर्ज की। जून तिमाही में आईफोन की बिक्री 13.5 फीसदी बढ़कर 44.6 अरब डॉलर रही।

विनिर्माण गतिविधियां 16 माह के उच्च स्तर पर

भारत के विनिर्माण क्षेत्र की वृद्धि दर जुलाई में मजबूत होकर 16 महीने के उच्च स्तर 59.1 पर पहुंच गई। अनुकूल मांग परिस्थितियों के बीच नए ऑर्डर और उत्पादन में तेजी से इसे समर्थन मिला। शुक्रवार को जारी मासिक सर्वेक्षण में यह जानकारी दी गई। मौसमी रूप से समायोजित एचएसबीसी इंडिया मैन्यूफैक्चरिंग परचेजिंग मैनेजर्स इंडेक्स (पीएमआई) जून के 58.4 से बढ़कर जुलाई में 59.1 हो गया। यह मार्च 2024 के बाद से इस क्षेत्र में सबसे मजबूत सुधार का संकेत है।

त्योहारी विज्ञापन खर्च में दिखेगी तेजी

रोशिनी शेखर मुंबई, 1 अगस्त

त्योहारों के दौरान विज्ञापन पर होने वाले खर्च में पिछले साल के मुकाबले 8 से 20 फीसदी वृद्धि होने के आसार हैं। इसे मुख्य तौर पर डिजिटल माध्यम, बेहतर उपभोक्ता धारणा और बड़े क्रिकेट टूर्नामेंट से रफ्तार मिलेगी। हालांकि मीडिया खरीदने वाले अधिकारियों का कहना है कि त्योहारी विज्ञापन खर्च में वृद्धि को सतर्क रख के साथ देखना चाहिए क्योंकि इस साल त्योहारी अवधि छोटी होने के कारण कंपनियां निवेश पर रिटर्न हासिल करने पर ध्यान केंद्रित करेंगी।

हवास मीडिया इंडिया के अनुसार, इस साल त्योहारी सीजन के दौरान कुल विज्ञापन खर्च 48,000 से 51,000 करोड़ रुपये के बीच रहने का अनुमान है। वार्षिक विज्ञापन खर्च में औसत 9 से 11 फीसदी की वृद्धि के मुकाबले त्योहारी विज्ञापन खर्च में 16 से 20 फीसदी की वृद्धि होने का अनुमान है। यह 15 फीसदी से अधिक खर्च के पिछले अनुमान के अनुरूप है।

हवास मीडिया इंडिया के अध्यक्ष (निवेश एवं साझेदारी) रामसाई पंचाकेशन ने बिज्ञानेस स्टैंडर्ड को बताया, ‘यह उद्योग के लिए एक चुनौतीपूर्ण समय है क्योंकि पर्सनलाइजेशन से वृद्धि को रफ्तार मिल रही है। कहा जा रहा है कि 2025 में त्योहारी सीजन के लिए अनुमानित वृद्धि 2023 के बराबर या उससे थोड़ी अधिक रहेगी। प्रतिशत वृद्धि के लिहाज से वह मोटे तौर पर 2022 जैसी रहेगी।’ उन्होंने कहा, ‘भू-राजनीतिक तनाव और असामान्य बारिश के कारण 2025 की पहली छमाही चुनौतीपूर्ण रही।

ट्रंप शुल्क से छंटनी का डर

नया शुल्क 7 अगस्त से होगा लागू मगर कार्यकारी आदेश में जुर्माने का जिक्र नहीं

अमेरिका के राष्ट्रपति डॉनल्ड ट्रंप द्वारा भारतीय वस्तुओं पर 25 फीसदी का व्यापक शुल्क लागू होने से निर्यातकों को बड़े पैमाने पर छंटनी का डर सता रहा है। हालांकि अमेरिकी प्रशासन के आदेश में रूसी खरीद के लिए 'जुर्माना' नहीं लगाया गया है। क्वाइट हाउस के एक कार्यकारी आदेश के अनुसार नए शुल्क 7 अगस्त से लागू होंगे और यूरोपीय संघ के लिए विशेष रियायत को छोड़कर, विश्व व्यापार संगठन के मौजूदा शुल्क के अतिरिक्त लगाए जाएंगे। इस सूची में चीन को शामिल नहीं किया गया है, जिस पर 30 फीसदी शुल्क लागू रहेगा।

7 अगस्त से पहले भेजे गए और 5 अक्टूबर तक अमेरिका पहुंचने वाले भारतीय माल पर 10 फीसदी बुनियादी शुल्क ही लगेगा। मगर वाहन, स्टील और एल्युमीनियम जैसे उत्पादों पर पहले घोषित क्षेत्रीय शुल्क लगेगे। इसके अलावा फार्मा, सेमीकंडक्टर, इलेक्ट्रॉनिक उत्पाद, कच्चे तेल और कोयला जैसे ऊर्जा उत्पाद जैसी छूट प्राप्त श्रेणियां फिलहाल बरकरार रहेंगी। ग्लोबल ट्रेड रिसर्च इनिशिएटिव (जीटीआरआई) ने कहा कि त्वरित अनुमान के अनुसार भारत का वस्तु

निर्यात वित्त वर्ष 2025 में 86.5 अरब डॉलर से 30 फीसदी घटकर वित्त वर्ष 2026 में 60.6 अरब डॉलर रह सकता है। भारत को अधिकांश देशों की तुलना में अपेक्षाकृत अधिक शुल्क का सामना करना पड़ रहा है क्योंकि दोनों देश 1 अगस्त की समयसीमा से पहले अंतरिम

व्यापार समझौते को अंतिम रूप देने में विफल रहे। कृषि और डेरी क्षेत्रों के लिए अधिक बाजार पहुंच की अमेरिकी जिद के कारण समझौता नहीं हो पाया। ट्रंप ने 25 फीसदी शुल्क के लिए भारत की ब्रिक्स सदस्यता को आंशिक रूप से जिम्मेदार ठहराया है। अमेरिका के विदेश

मंत्री मार्को रबियो ने कहा कि रूस के साथ भारत का संबंध भारत-अमेरिका संबंधों में 'खटास का विषय' बना हुआ है। विदेश मंत्रालय ने शुल्क की स्थिति पर संतुलित प्रतिक्रिया दी। विदेश मंत्रालय के प्रवक्ता रणधीर जायसवाल ने आज कहा, 'अमेरिका और भारत की साझेदारी ने कई बदलावों और चुनौतियों का सामना किया है। हम दोनों देशों द्वारा प्रतिबद्ध ठोस एजेंडे पर ध्यान दे रहे हैं और हमें विश्वास है कि ये रिस्ते आगे भी बढ़ते रहेंगे।' भारतीय परिधान निर्यातकों ने चिंता जताते हुए कहा कि अमेरिका द्वारा लगाए गए 25 फीसदी शुल्क के कारण विनिर्माण इकाइयों में बड़े पैमाने पर छंटनी हो सकती है। उन्होंने सरकार से हस्तक्षेप की मांग की है। वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री पीयूष गोयल सरकार की परामर्श प्रक्रिया के तहत शनिवार और रविवार को मुंबई में निर्यातकों से मुलाकात कर सकते हैं। निर्यातकों के संगठन फियो और अन्य निर्यात संवर्धन परिषदों की आज बैठकें हुईं और वे अगले सप्ताह की शुरुआत में वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्रालय को अपनी सिफारिशें प्रस्तुत कर सकते हैं। एक वरिष्ठ सरकारी अधिकारी ने बिज्ञानेस स्टैंडर्ड को बताया कि वाणिज्य विभाग ट्रंप के कार्यकारी आदेश का बारीकी से आकलन कर रहा है और उद्योग व अन्य हितधारकों से बातचीत कर रहा है।

जुलाई में 1.7 % बढ़ा शुद्ध जीएसटी संग्रह

मोनिका यादव नई दिल्ली, 1 अगस्त

जुलाई महीने में वस्तु एवं सेवा कर (जीएसटी) से सरकार का शुद्ध राजस्व महज 1.7 फीसदी बढ़कर 1.68 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा। रिफंड में तेज वृद्धि के कारण शुद्ध संग्रह पर असर पड़ा है। सकल जीएसटी संग्रह 7.5 फीसदी बढ़कर लगभग 1.96 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा। शुद्ध जीएसटी संग्रह में फरवरी के बाद से सबसे धीमी वृद्धि हुई है। जून में शुद्ध जीएसटी संग्रह 3.3 फीसदी बढ़ा था।

घरेलू लेनदेन से सकल राजस्व 6.7 फीसदी बढ़ा मगर रिफंड जुलाई 2024 के 8,000 करोड़ रुपये से दोगुना से अधिक बढ़कर लगभग 17,000 करोड़ रुपये रहने से शुद्ध जीएसटी प्राप्तियां पिछले साल की समान अवधि से 0.2 फीसदी कम रहीं। निर्यातकों को जीएसटी रिफंड 20 फीसदी बढ़ा और कुल मिलाकर 10,000 करोड़ रुपये से थोड़ा अधिक रहा, जिससे आयात से शुद्ध राजस्व 7.5 फीसदी बढ़कर 42,548 करोड़ रुपये रहा। जुलाई में जीएसटी संग्रह के आंकड़े जून में किए गए लेनदेन के होते हैं। जून में

शुद्ध जीएसटी प्राप्तियां 1.59 लाख करोड़ रुपये रही थीं जबकि मई में 1.73 लाख करोड़ रुपये और अप्रैल में 2.09 लाख करोड़ रुपये का राजव मिला था। चालू वित्त वर्ष के पहले चार महीनों में शुद्ध जीएसटी प्राप्तियां 8.4 फीसदी बढ़कर 7.11 लाख करोड़ रुपये रही। इसमें घरेलू लेनदेन से राजस्व 6.1 फीसदी बढ़कर 5.6 लाख करोड़ रुपये और आयात से जीएसटी राजस्व 18.1 फीसदी बढ़कर लगभग 1.51 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा। चार महीनों में सकल जीएसटी संग्रह 8.18 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा और रिफंड लगभग 1.07 लाख करोड़ रुपये रहा।

Op Sindoor: India Flags Pakistan Ally Turkey, Azerbaijan's Presence at SCO

New Delhi: India has expressed reservations on the presence of Turkey and Azerbaijan, both dialogue partners of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO), at the group's Summit in Tianjin, China, early September in the backdrop of the support extended by Ankara and Baku to Pakistan during Operation Sindoor. India's reservations were conveyed to the host China by India in the runup to the Summit, ET has reliably learnt. As SCO works by consensus, reservation on an issue by one member could be the decisive factor.

India and China have been in dialogue on the issue, ET has learnt. While Turkey had assisted Pakistan with defence hardware including drones, Baku provided political support to Islamabad in the backdrop of Pakistan's support

against Armenia on Azerbaijan's territorial matters.

A preliminary probe into the debris of Pakistani drones thwarted by India's air defence systems revealed that the country used Turkey-made drones. Subsequently, in India, there were growing calls to boycott Turkey and Azerbaijan over their support for Pakistan. Last month external affairs minister S Jaishankar raised the issue of the terror attack in Pahalgalam

at the SCO foreign ministers meet in Tianjin and said member countries needed to remain true to the grouping's founding objectives and maintain an uncompromising position on terrorism. Jaishankar, who was on his first China visit since the Galwan Valley clashes in June 2020, said the April 22 attack in Pahalgalam, in which 26 people were killed, "was deliberately conducted to undermine the tourism economy of Jammu and Kashmir, while sowing a religious divide," Jaishankar said.

PARTNERSHIP WITH RUSSIA TIME-TESTED, STEADY

Amid Criticism, India Backs Strategic Ties with US

New Delhi: India underscored the depth of long-standing ties with the US while defending its relationship with Russia and energy purchases from that country. US President Donald Trump and secretary of state Marco Rubio have been critical of India buying oil from Russia. "Trump has also been attacking India's trade stance ahead of the US imposing a 25% tariff on the country's goods."

"India and the United States share a comprehensive global strategic partnership anchored in shared interests, democratic values, and robust people-to-people ties," Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said at a briefing in the capital on Friday. "This partnership has weathered several transitions and challenges. We remain focused on the substantive agenda that our two countries have committed to and are confident that the relationship will continue to move forward."

He underscored the military ties between the two countries. "We have a strong defence partnership with the US which has been

enstrengthening over the last several years," Jaiswal said. "There is potential for this partnership to grow further under the India-US COMPACT for the 21st century."

This was a reference to the initiative launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Trump during their February summit in Washington DC—Catalyzing Opportunities for Military Partnership, Accelerated Commerce & Technology for the 21st Century or COMPACT. This will "drive transfor- mative change across key pillars of cooperation," including defence industry cooperation.

However, Jaiswal said that the "sourcing of our defence requirements is

determined solely by our national security imperatives and strategic assessments." He didn't mention F-35 fighter jets made by Lockheed Martin that the US wants India to buy.

Jaiswal said the relationship with Russia was a longstanding one. "India and Russia have a steady and time-tested partnership," he said. "Our bilateral relationships with various countries stand on their own merit and should not be seen from the prism of a third country."

India has huge energy needs, including oil, coal, and gas, which it must purchase to power its economy like any other country. It buys from Russia because Russian oil is sanctioned, cheap, and sold below global prices due to those sanctions. Unfortunately, this is helping to sustain Russia's war effort

When asked about a report on Indian state-run oil refiners pausing purchases of Russian oil, Jaiswal said, "In securing our energy needs, we are guided by what is on offer in the markets, and by the prevailing global circumstances."

Rubio had on Thursday said that India's purchase of oil from Russia is "most certainly a point of irritation" in ties between the two countries. He told Fox Radio that this was helping to sustain Moscow's war effort in Ukraine.

"Look, global trade... India is an ally. It's a strategic partner. Like anything in foreign policy, you're not going to align 100% of the time on everything," Rubio said when asked if President Trump was "upset" with India getting a "great portion" of the discounted oil from Russia. "India has huge energy needs and that includes the ability to buy oil and coal and gas and things that it needs to power its economy like every country does, and it buys it from Russia, because Russian oil is sanctioned and cheap and... they're selling it under the global price because of the sanctions. And that, unfortunately, is helping to sustain the Russian war effort," Rubio said.

RS Tally Hits 102 as 3 Nominated MPs Join BJP

New Delhi: Ahead of the vice-presidential polls, three nominated Rajya Sabha MPs have joined the BJP, taking the party's tally in the Upper House to 102. This is the first time since April 2022 that the ruling BJP's strength has crossed the 100-mark in the Rajya Sabha — and it comes just ahead of the vice-presidential election scheduled for September 9. Top lawyer Ujjwal Nikam, former foreign secretary Harsh Vardhan Shringla, and social worker C. Sadanandan Master, who took oath as nominated MPs last month, joined the BJP this week. The Rajya Sabha can have a maximum strength of 250 members, including 12 nominated members. The current strength stands at 245. Out of the 12 nominated MPs, five have now joined the BJP. —OPB

Mirwaiz Urges Delhi to Bridge 'Dil Ki Doori' with J&K

Srinagar: Hurriyat leader Mirwaiz Umar Farooq on Friday urged the Centre to address the 'dil ki doori' (emotional distance) with J&K through greater engagement. Delivering his customary sermon at Srinagar's Jama Masjid, the chief cleric praised Lok Sabha members from Kashmir, Mian Altaf and Aga Ruhullah from the ruling National Conference and Engineer Rashid of Awami Ittehad Party, for their united stand in Parliament. "Neither war nor violence nor use of force can solve problems and lead to peace and prosperity, which the billions of people in the Indian subcontinent seek," said Mirwaiz. —Hakeem Irfan Rashid

PROHIBITORY ORDERS CLAMPED; FADNAVIS SAYS SITUATION UNDER CONTROL

Social Media Post Sparks Communal Violence in Pune Village, Several Held

Mumbai: The Pune police detained several people and clamped prohibitory orders at Yavat village in the district on Friday, after a communal flare-up triggered by a social media post led to mobs vandalising vehicles, shops and other properties.

Maharashtra chief minister Devendra Fadnavis said a social media post by a person who was not from the village about another community fuelled tensions. Police had to resort to lathi charge to control the mob, he said.

"The situation is under control; both communities are sitting together and trying to resolve the issue," said Fadnavis. Authorities will take strong action against anyone trying to incite trouble, he warned. While the social media post was "objectionable", it did not give anyone the right to "take the law into their own hands", the CM said.

Yavat was already reeling under tensions after

a statue of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj was vandalised by a youth from the minority community a few days back. While the youth was arrested, tensions that lingered erupted Friday over the social media post by another youth. An irate mob set fire to a bakery and vandalised several shops and tried to attack the house of the youth who had put up the social media post. A mob also allegedly vandalised a place of worship. Deputy CM Ajit Pawar, who is also Pune's guardian minister, visited the village later in the day and met residents. "We have brought in a state reserve police force team to station here. There was a mob of 30 to 40 people. However, the situation has been brought under control," Pawar said.

The youth who posted the objectionable message hailed from Nanded and was living in Yavat for the past few years, he said.

Cong Brass to Address Legal Conclave Today

New Delhi: Senior leaders of the Congress, including Mallikarjun Kharge and Rahul Gandhi, will address a national legal conclave here on Saturday, which the AICC department of law, human rights and RTI is organising.

Chairman of the AICC department Abhishek Manu Singhvi said at a presser on Friday that "Constitutional Challenges: Perspectives



and Pathways" will be Conclave's overarching theme. "The event takes place at a pivotal moment in our Republic's journey — a time that calls for renewed commitment to the foundational values of our democracy. As custodians of the Constitution of India, we are presented with an opportunity to come together — as legal professionals, public thinkers, and citizens — to reaffirm our collective faith in the constitutional order, uphold the rule of law, and strengthen the integrity of our institutions," Singhvi said.

It was nothing but a "political witch hunt" unleashed by the then home minister P Chidambaram, Sarma alleged while talking to reporters. "It was a conspiracy hatched by the Congress to involve Bhagwat, but the court verdict has exposed the party."

He said the plan was to defame the RSS and the Hindu religion. "After this verdict, my assessment is that Chidambaram should now be quizzed. He should be asked why he tried to frame the Hindu society with terror. People should also ask this question to him," he added.

Almost 17 years after the Malegaon blast that claimed six lives and injured 101 people, a special court in Mumbai on Thursday acquitted all seven accused, including former BJP MP Pragna Singh Thakur, noting that "there was no reliable and cogent evidence" against them.

Gowda's Grandson & Ex-JD(S) MP Revanna Convicted in Rape Case

The former MP is currently lodged in Bengaluru's central prison; verdict likely today

Bengaluru: A special court for elected representatives in Bengaluru on Friday convicted former JD(S) MP Prajwal Revanna, grandson of former Prime Minister HD Deve Gowda and nephew of Union minister HD Kumaraswamy, in a rape and sexual harassment case.

Special court judge Gajanana Bhat pronounced the verdict, with the sentencing expected to be announced on Saturday.

Revanna, 34, is currently lodged in Bengaluru's central prison.

He was investigated by a special investigation team following allegations of sexually assaulting a domestic help. His father, HD Revanna, a JD (S) MLA and former minister, faced sexual harassment charges in a separate case.

Top Court Junks Plea to Bring Political Parties Under PoSH

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Friday refused to entertain a plea seeking to bring political parties under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition, and Redressal) Act, 2013.

A division bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) BR Gavai said the issue would fall "only in the domain of the parliament". The bench refused to entertain the plea. Eventually, the petitioner was given the liberty to withdraw his plea.

The petitioner, Supreme Court advocate Yogamaya MG,

had moved the court highlighting non-compliance with the PoSH Act by political parties, particularly when it comes to constitution of internal complaints committee (ICC) to deal with sexual harassment complaints.

The petitioner sought that the definitions of "workplace" and "employer" under the PoSH Act be harmoniously interpreted to make the Act applicable to political parties. The petitioner had earlier also approached the apex court over the same issue. However, the court had then asked the petitioner to first approach the Election Commission of India (ECI).

THAROOR'S 'SCORPION' REMARK AGAINST PM

'Why So Touchy?' SC Suggests Closing Defamation Case

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Friday asked BJP leader Rajiv Babbar to consider closing the defamation case against Congress MP Shashi Tharoor over his statement comparing Prime Minister Narendra Modi to a scorpion.

A division bench of justices MM Sundresh and N Kotiswar Singh verbally remarked "let us close all these things. Why get so touchy about all

this? This way, administrators and judges come in the same group and have thick skin". The development took place during the resumed hearing of a plea filed by the senior Congress leader against a Delhi High Co-

urt order refusing to quash the case against him. The bench eventually adjourned the matter on a request by the counsel for the respondents. Tharoor had petitioned the apex court challenging the Delhi High Court order that rejected his plea to quash the defamation case. The apex court stayed the trial in September 2024 and had sought the response of Babbar and the Delhi government. —Our Political Bureau
