**पर्या लीक पर कड़ी सजा
के प्रावधान वाला विधेयक**

केंद्रीय मंत्रिमंडल ने प्रथम प्रचलक मामलों में कड़ी शर्का का प्राधान्य समुचितता के लिए विधेयक के मसौदे को शुक्लवार को मंजुरी दे दी। इसमें 10 करोड़ रुपये तक के जुम्लियां का प्राधान्य भी शामिल है। प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी ने पुष्करवार को घोषणा की कि अगले बजटो संसद में एक विधेयक प्रस्थापित होगा, जिसमें प्रथम प्रचलक के खिलाफ सख्त प्रावधान हों। यह घोषणा ऐसे समय में की गई, जब कांग्रेस-जनता पार्टी नीट प्रथम प्रचलक मामलों में शिक्षा मंत्री धीरेंद्र प्रसाद के इलाक़े, परीक्षा में हुई अनियमितताओं के लिए जवाबदाई देने करने की सीमा मांग को लेकर उत्तर-प्रधान पर प्रदशन कर रही है।

अमेरिका ने लगाया 10 फीसदी शुल्क

अमेरिका ने वस्तुओं के उत्पादन में बंधुआ मजदूरी के इस्तेमाल पर रोक लगाने के प्रयासों के तहत भारत और 16 अन्य देशों से आयातित वस्तुओं पर 10 फीसदी शुल्क लगाया है। अमेरिका ने पिछले महीने व्यापार अधिनियम के सेक्शन 301 के तहत शुल्क लगाने का प्रस्ताव रखते समय भारत को 12.5 फीसदी शुल्क वाले देशों की श्रेणी में रखा था लेकिन बाद में इसे 10 फीसदी कर दिया। पृष्ठ 4

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राष्ट्रीय अर्थव्यवस्था से बंगाल को जोड़ना होगा: दासगुप्ता

पश्चिम बंगाल को केंद्र के साथ बेहतर तालमेल बिठाकर 'राष्ट्रीय अर्थव्यवस्था में फिर से जुड़ने' की जरूरत है। यह बात राज्य की नवगठित सरकार के वित्त मंत्री स्वप्न दासगुप्ता ने कही। उनका यह बयान राज्य के पुराने तौर-तरीकों से अलग हटकर काम करने का संकेत देता है।

विजनेस स्टैंडर्ड को दिए साक्षात्कार में दासगुप्ता ने कहा, 'हमें सबसे पहले अपनी अर्थव्यवस्था को राष्ट्रीय अर्थव्यवस्था से जोड़ना होगा। पिछले 50 वर्षों में लगातार दो सरकारों का यह सोचना कि पश्चिम बंगाल एक द्वीप की तरह काम करता है, गलत था।'
राज्यों में पश्चिम बंगाल का सकल घरेलू उत्पाद को तुलना में ऋण का अनुपात सबसे ज्यादा है। इस कारण उसके पास वित्तीय स्वायत्तता सीमित है। इसलिए सरकारें कार्यों के लिए केन्द्र की सहायता बहुत जरूरी है।

विनिवेश के बारे में उन्होंने कहा कि राज्य सरकार का पहला कदम सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र के कुछ उपक्रमों को स्टॉक एक्सचेंज पर सूचीबद्ध कराना होगा। निवेश आकर्षित करना नई सरकार का मुख्य ध्येय है। राज्य के वित्त मंत्री ने

बजट में लगभग 5,000 करोड़ रुपये की औद्योगिक प्रोत्साहन नीति की घोषणा की है जिसने 1993 से दिए गए औद्योगिक प्रोत्साहन को रद्द करने के पिछली सरकार के फैसले को पलट दिया। राज्य को दो ऐसे मध्यस्थता फैसलों से भी जूझना पड़ रहा है—इनमें हल्द्वीया पेट्रोकेमिकल्स और सिंगूर मामले में टाटा मोटर्स का मामला शामिल है। सरकार बात-चीत के जरिये समझौता करने की कोशिश कर रही है।

क्या आप बताएंगे कि उदारीकरण से पहले कौन सी बड़ी दिक्कतें प्रौद्योगिकी सेवा उद्योग के सामने आती थीं?

उदारीकरण से पहले कारोबार और खास तौर पर स्टार्टअप के लिए हर मोर्चे पर बड़ी मुश्किलें थीं। पहले तो टेलीफोन भी नहीं होते थे। टेलीफोन कनेक्शन लेने में ही औसतन सात साल लग जाते थे। दुनिया के सबसे प्रतिस्पर्धी देश अमेरिका

के साथ सबसे उन्नत प्रौद्योगिकी वाले क्षेत्र में बिना फोन के काम करना बहुत कठिन था। दूसरा, दिल्ली में अफसरशाही की रुकावटें बहुत ज्यादा थीं। अगर आप कंप्यूटर आयात करने का लाइसेंस चाहते थे तो आपको दिल्ली जाकर दरखवास्त करनी पड़ती थी। उसके बाद दिल्ली में बैठे आला अफसर तय करते थे कि आप आयात लाइसेंस पाने लायक हैं या नहीं।

नहीं। सच कहें तो आपको हर साल दिल्ली के 20 से 50 चक्कर काटने पर सच कहेंगे, उसकी वाद अमर आप सेंट्रल प्रोसेसिंग यूनिट (सीपीयू) या डिस्क ड्राइव का बेहतर मॉडल लाने के लिए लाइसेंस में तब्दीली कराने जाते थे तो सच पर लग जाता। और 10 चक्कर भी लगाने पड़ते थे। उन दिनों अमेरिका में तकरीबन हर 15 दिन में हार्डवेयर का एक नया मॉडल आ जाता था। इसलिए हम हमेशा उनसे बहुत पिछड़े रहते थे।

इसका नतीजा यह था कि एकदम नया हार्डवेयर खरीद रहे हमारे ग्राहक भारतीय सॉफ्टवेयर डेवलपर्स के साथ काम करने से बहुत कतराते थे क्योंकि हम करीब पांच-छह पीढ़ी पीछे थे। तीसरा, चालू खाते की परिवर्तनीयता यानी रुपये को बाजार दर पर विदेशी मुद्रा में बदलते रहने की छूट नहीं थी। इसलिए हर बार विदेश यात्रा से पहले भारतीय रिजर्व बैंक के पास

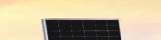


विदेशी विनिमय के परमिट की अर्जा डालन होती थी और दो-तीन हफ्ते इंतजार करना पड़ता था। परमिट भी तभी मिलता था, जब आप किस्मत वाले हों या रिजर्व बैंक के क्लर्क तय कर ले कि आप किस्मत वाले हैं। इसलिए ग्राहक अगर अपने सिस्टम में फौरन कुछ तब्दीली चाहते या नया सिस्टम तैयार करने को कहते तो उनकी जरूरत पूरी करना बहुत मुश्किल होता था।

दिल्ली में एक अफसर था, जिसे पूंजी निर्माण निग्रहक कहा जाता था। उसे शेरश बाजार का तो रती भर भी नहीं पता था। बाजार वहीं तक करता था कि आपके आईपीओ की कीमत क्या होगी। जब हमने अद्वैत दिया तब बहुत हील-हूजत के बाद वह हमारे आईपीओ की कीमत 11 रुपये रखने पर हामील हुआ। मगर फिर हम आईपीओ नहीं लाये क्योंकि किंग भी उधमी दिन-रात मेहनत करतैस इन्विटी खुदरा या संस्थागत निवेशक को असली कीमत से केवल 10 फीसस ज्यादा पर क्यों बेचेगा।

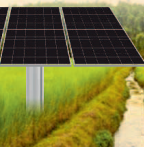

Upset SC Calls for Special Courts in Manipur Violence

Directs agencies to expedite pending investigations

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday indicated that it plans to constitute special courts to conduct day-to-day trials of cases connected to the ethnic violence in Manipur and directed investigating agencies to expedite pending investigations. A three-judge bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant directed the Manipur government to extend full cooperation to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Special Investiga-

tion Teams (SITs), which are facing various difficulties in completing the probes. "We tentatively propose to constitute special courts, probably in consultation with the State of Manipur and the High Court of Manipur and Gauhati High Court, so that the trials can be taken up on a day-to-day basis, especially in light of the inordinate delay that has already taken place in the ongoing investigations," CJI Kant said. He added, "This will be possible only when the CBI as well as the SITs are able to conclude the investigations and file their respective charge sheets. We, therefore, urge both the agencies to do their best, despite the impediments, and complete the investigations." During the hearing, the bench noted that the SITs are investigating



3,020 cases across eight districts, but charge sheets have been filed in only 301 cases. It added that charges have been framed in 41 cases and trials have commenced in 10. A total of 2,924 witnesses has been cited in these cases. Meanwhile, the CBI said it has filed charge sheets in 21 of the 31 cases

transferred to it, while supplementary investigation is underway in 11 cases. It also submitted that closure reports have been filed in six cases, of which three have been accepted. The remaining four cases are still under investigation. The CBI further highlighted the challenges hampering the probes.

"Witnesses are refusing to cooperate due to mistrust. There are language barriers because of the existence of numerous regional dialects, posing a significant impediment to effective communication with local residents and witnesses," the federal agency submitted before the court.

Delhi HC Rejects ANI's Interim Injunction Plea Against OpenAI

Bengaluru: The Delhi High Court on Friday refused to restrain OpenAI from using news agency ANI's copyrighted content, holding that the interim stage that storing publicly available literary work to train large language models (LLMs) could qualify as "fair dealing" for private use and research under Indian copyright law. Justice Amit Bansal dismissed ANI Media's application for an interim injunction against the ChatGPT maker, but clarified that the findings were prima facie and would not affect the final outcome of the copyright infringement suit. Citing ANI's October 2024 offer to license its content to OpenAI for \$7.5 million, the court said this

indicated that its claim was quantifiable, and that monetary compensation could be awarded if the news agency succeeded in the suit. ANI has accused OpenAI of copyright infringement by copying and storing its content to train LLMs underlying ChatGPT and reproducing its articles in responses generated for users. The court held that ANI failed to establish a prima facie case on either claim. It found no evidence at this stage that ChatGPT memorised and regurgitated ANI's articles or that its responses substantially reproduced the news agency's original expression. While storing a copyrighted literary work ordinarily amounts to reproduction under the Copyright Act, the court held that it should be read with Section 52 of the Act.

Assam Toll Rises to 47; CM Himanta Terms It 'Unusual'

Guwahati: Assam chief minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said 47 people have died in the current wave of floods, while eight remain missing. Sarma told reporters that exceptionally heavy rainfall in Nagaland's Mokochung, Wokha and Mon districts, along with Charaideo in Assam, between July 18 and July 20 triggered the floods. "Mokochung alone recorded 493% above normal rainfall," he said. "Wokha recorded 108% above normal while Mon received 45% above normal rainfall. Charaideo district simultaneously recorded 436% above normal rainfall while neighbouring Sivasaagar received 134% above normal rainfall."

Three Killed in Palghar, Over 1,100 Evacuated

Palghar: Heavy rains over the last two days have claimed at least three lives in Maharashtra's coastal Palghar district, cutting off several villages and forcing the administration to evacuate 1,155 people, officials said on Friday.

A relief team official described the flood situation as the worst the district has faced in ten years. Rains eased a little on Friday, but schools and educational institutions in the district have been directed to remain closed, officials said. PTI

Heavy Rains Lash Rajasthan; Red Alert in Two Districts

Jaipur: Heavy rainfall lashed several parts of Rajasthan on Friday, with Pachpadra in Balotra district and Amet in Rajsamand recording the highest rainfall of 9 cm each during the past 24 hours, officials said. Rail services on the Mumbai route were affected after rising water levels near Bridge No. 203 between Gholvad and Umargam Road stations on the Western Railway led to the suspension of train movement. -PTI

Mumbai-Ahd Flooding Dominates BRICS Meet

New Delhi: The recent urban flooding in Mumbai, Ahmedabad and Surat was discussed at the BRICS Ministerial Meeting on Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) in New Delhi on Friday. The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) presented urban flood mitigation plans and preparedness measures adopted by municipal authorities. NDMA member Dr Krishna S. Vatsa said the authorities in Delhi have devised SOPs for the upcoming monsoon season. BRICS comprises Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa. The ministerial meeting featured a high-level policy dialogue on 'Advancing Climate-Smart and Disaster-Resilient Infrastructure Systems: Partnerships, Innovation and Financing for Resilient Development', where ministers deliberated on resilient infrastructure, innovative financing, emerging technologies and international partnerships to address increasing disaster and climate risks. A ministerial roundtable on 'Accelerating Implementation of the BRICS

Disaster Risk Reduction Work Plan (2025-2028)' enabled member countries to exchange experiences and identify practical pathways for strengthening institutional cooperation, capacity building, knowledge sharing and implementation of the agreed priorities. As part of India's chairship, six flagship knowledge products were launched to support evidence-based policymaking, institutional strengthening, capacity building and practical implementation of disaster risk reduction initiatives across BRICS member countries, the NDMA said in a statement.

As the way forward, the ministers emphasised strengthening practical and action-oriented cooperation through regular technical exchanges, joint projects, simulation exercises, expert exchanges and annual thematic workstreams to promote knowledge sharing, innovation and measurable outcomes in disaster resilience. —Our Political Bureau

B'desh PM Invited as BIMSTEC Chair amid India Outreach to Regional Blocs

New Delhi: India, the current BRICS chair, is contemplating inviting key regional organisations, including BIMSTEC, ASEAN and the Arab League, as part of the outreach initiative for the summit to be held in New Delhi on September 12-13. The government is exploring a proposal to invite the current chairs of ASEAN, BIMSTEC, the League of Arab States, the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC), the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) and the African Union as

part of the outreach initiative for the BRICS Summit to champion the agenda of the Global South. Bangladesh PM Tarique Rahman could visit India for the summit, as the country is the current chair of BIMSTEC. Similarly, the Philippine President could visit New Delhi, with the Philippines serving as the current ASEAN chair. Kazakhstan is the current chair of the EAEU, and the Kazakh President is also expected to attend the summit as a BRICS Partner country.

Indian Crew Member Killed in Black Sea Attack

New Delhi: A commercial vessel, MV OMORFI, was allegedly attacked by Ukraine while transiting the Black Sea this week, reportedly in Russian territorial waters. Ten crew members, including three Indian nationals, were on board at the time of the incident. One Indian national

lost his life in the attack, while the other two on board are reported to be safe, as per an MEA statement. On receiving the information, the Indian Mission in Russia reached out to the authorities and is making efforts to extend all assistance to affected family. —OPB

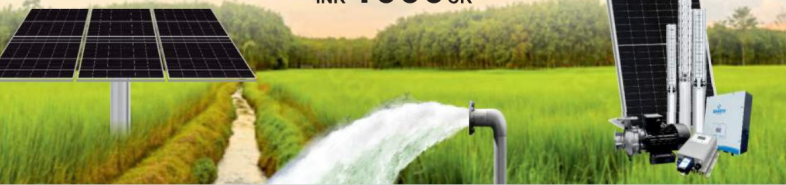
Army Rescues 100 in Rain-Hit Ahmedabad

Ahmedabad: At least 100 residents were rescued by the Indian Army from Ahmedabad city's upscale Bopal area on Friday amid extremely heavy rain lashing Gujarat over the past few days, officials said. Bopal area received 491 millimetres of rainfall in a 36-hour period from 6 am on Thursday to 12 noon on Friday. Two Army flood relief teams, equipped with four trucks and four boats, were deployed at Chhanalal Joshi Marg in Bopal area to evacuate stranded residents, defence PRO wing commander Abhishek Tiwari said. Chief minister Bhupendra Patel also visited flood-hit Bopal, walked through waterlogged streets and reviewed the ongoing rescue, relief and drainage operations. -PTI
