Revisions from the Labor
Dept shaved 103,000 jobs
off payrolls in May and June**

Washington: US employers unexpectedly cut 23,000 jobs last month, and Labor Department revisions shaved 103,000 jobs off payrolls in May and June. The unemployment rate dipped to 4.1% only because Americans left the job market.

The June jobs numbers from the Labor Department on Friday marked a sharp reversal for the American labour market and a political setback for President Donald Trump less than three months before his Republican party seeks to keep full control of Congress in the midterm election.

Forecasters had expected job creation to approach 100,000 last month.

Local public schools cut 50,000 jobs in July, restaurants and bars 26,000, retailers 19,000.

The 4.1% unemployment rate was the lowest since June 2025 – but it dropped for the wrong reasons: Fewer people were competing for work as 264,000 dropped out of the labor market. The share of those working or looking for work fell to 61.4%, the lowest since February 2021.

The Trump administration, which has imposed massive tariffs in an attempt to create manufacturing jobs, noted that jobs were up 22,000 at construction companies and 5,000 at factories.

“The Trump industrial resurgence is on schedule. Manufacturing and factory construction jobs grew again in July even as government payrolls continued to significantly shrink,” said White House spokesman Kush Desai.

Meanwhile, a federal appeals court on Friday ordered Trump administration to stop construction on a \$400 million ballroom on the site of the White House’s demolished East Wing, dealing the Republican leader a major setback in a case testing his Presidential authority.

The Washington-based US Court of Appeals, in a divided 2-1 order, upheld a preliminary injunction won by the National Trust for Historic Preservation,

which sued last year after the administration tore down the East Wing and began building a 90,000-square-foot (8,360-square-meter) ballroom without seeking authorisation from Congress.

Trump will move forward with his attempt to fire Federal Reserve Governor Lisa Cook after the US Supreme Court in June refused to let the President fire her, ABC News reported on Friday, citing sources. The White House told Cook in a letter this week that the president was “considering” removing her from her role and demanded she respond to unproven mortgage fraud allegations within three weeks, the report said.

But Americans who have lost their jobs – or are seeking to bust into the job market for the first time – are struggling to catch a break.

Economists have used the term “no hire, no fire” to describe the unusual job market conditions.

So far this year, employers are adding 61,000 jobs a month, up from 9,700 in 2025, the weakest outside a recession since 2002.

The United States doesn’t need as many jobs as it used to to keep the unemployment rate from rising. Trump’s immigration crackdown and the ongoing retirement of baby boomers mean fewer people are competing for work. So the “break-even” rate of monthly hiring, 155,000 in 2023-2024, has dropped, perhaps to nearly zero, according to a Federal Reserve study.

“There are just fewer people available to hire,” said Sal Guatieri, senior economist at BMO Capital Markets. AP

Riyadh Expects Two-pronged Attack from Tehran



Riyadh: Saudi Arabia expects imminent coordinated attacks from Iraqi militias to the north and Yemen’s Houthis from the south under the supervision of Iran’s Islamic Revolutionary Guards senior Saudi official said. Speaking on condition of anonymity, the official said late on Thursday that intelligence reports from Saudi Arabia, the US and other regional countries indicated civilian and economic sites could be targeted, including energy infrastructure, ports and airports.

Saudi Arabia had observed drones and missiles being moved, suggesting coordinated operations from both directions, and was prepared to take all measures to respond to “any aggression,” he said. Reuters

Saudi Arabia, Turkey and Pakistan Sign Defence Pact

Agreement not directed against any specific actor, open to other regional nations, says Turkish official

Riyadh | Karachi | Ankara: Saudi Arabia, Pakistan and Turkey signed a joint defence agreement in Mecca on Friday wedding Sunni Muslim US allies alarmed at a regional conflagration that has rained missile fire onto Gulf oil exporters. Iran and its allies have been firing on Saudi Arabia and other Gulf states, and blockading their energy shipments, since the US and Israel attacked it on February 28 in a major escalation after years of regional tumult.

The agreement is intended to strengthen collective deterrence against any act of aggression and stipulates that an armed attack against any of the three would be regarded as an attack on all, they said in a joint statement.

While the statement did not give specifics on the commitments or obligations each had accepted under the “Mecca Joint Defence Agreement”, it said the pact was aimed at strengthening their collective security and promoting peace, security and stability in the region and beyond. “The pact includes a collective defence clause. It is purely defensive in nature, pledging mutual support only for defence,” a Turkish official said.

The agreement was not directed against any specific actor, was open to other regional countries, and did not abrogate or replace any existing bilateral or multilateral arrangements, he added.

However, the three nations are particularly concerned by the increasingly aggressive military stances of both Israel and revolutionary Shi’ite Iran, as their long-time US ally struggles to contain regional upheaval.

Turkey has NATO’s second-largest military. Saudi Arabia, the strongest Gulf state, is home to Islam’s holiest sites and one of the world’s top oil exporters, while Pakistan is the only nuclear-armed Muslim country.

IRAN CRITICISES DEAL

A prominent Iranian lawmaker on Friday criticised the agreement. Ebrahim Rezaei, a member of the Iranian Parliament’s National Security and Foreign Policy Commission, threatened Saudi Arabia in a post on X.

“The Saudis should know that a paper agreement with Turkey and Pakistan will not bring them security, just as years of one-sided milking’ by the Americans did not bring them security. Change your policies so that you do not have to #BegForSecurity from others,” he wrote. Agencies
