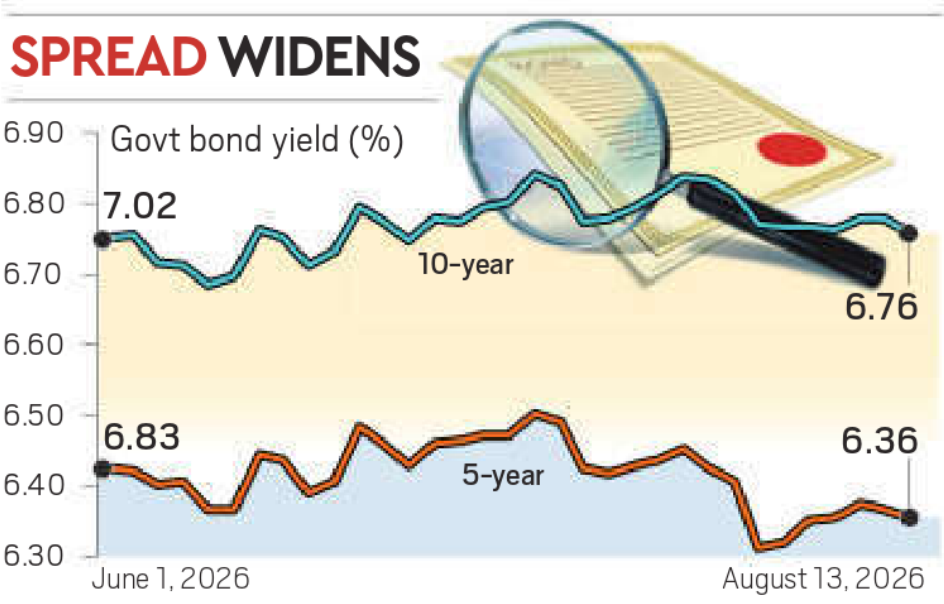

FCNR inflows supporting short end of G-Sec curve

THE G-SEC YIELD curve is likely to steepen further as foreign currency non-resident bank (FCNR-B) deposit inflows boost demand for shorter-dated government securities. Inflows are adding to rupee liquidity and supporting demand at the short end of the curve.

Driven by FCNR-B inflows, the five-year G-Sec yield has fallen 44 basis points since the June policy, compared with a smaller decline in the 10-year benchmark yield. The spread between the five-year and 10-year bonds has widened to 41 basis points from over 15 bps in May. On Thursday, the five-year and 10-year yields closed at



6.35% and 6.76%, respectively. The benchmark 10-year paper has largely traded in the 6.73-6.84% range over the past month.

The Reserve Bank of India's latest policy was seen as dovish,

with the central bank cutting its inflation projections. This has prompted banks to scale back expectations of future rate hikes, while longer-tenure government securities are expected to remain range-bound in the

near term.

"When liquidity is abundant and an immediate rate hike is off the table, short-term rates tend to fall immediately. This typically leads to a steeper yield curve, as the absence of near-term tightening expectations, combined with excess liquidity, gets priced into the front end of the curve," said Gopal Tripathi, treasury head at Jana Small Finance Bank.

As long as foreign exchange inflows continue, overnight liquidity is likely to remain elevated, keeping the short end of the yield curve benign and supporting further steepening, he added. According to RBI data, banks have mobilised \$36.73 billion through the special FCNR-B deposit scheme.

Emails show carmakers' fuel blending worries

HOURS AFTER INDIA made public assurances last week that its ethanol-blended petrol was safe, the country's main auto lobby withdrew a complaint about fuel contamination it had sent to the government a week earlier. The group said some figures needed more checks.

But separate communications between industry executives, reviewed by Reuters, showed that in the preceding days, top automakers Maruti Suzuki, Tata Motors and Mahindra discussed their concerns about contamination of petrol blended with 20% ethanol, called E20. Their data compiled the most comprehensive fuel testing done by the industry since the government started rolling out E20 nationwide from last year to curb pollution and cut oil imports. With no other petrol available since April 1, consumer concerns have grown about the impact on vehicle performance. The carmakers' emails show for the first time how they are privately worried about contaminants in E20, like chloride and moisture, which they say are hurting vehicles, even as they publicly back the government's rollout of the fuel.

India's growth now hinges on demand-side energy efficiency

INDIA'S PROJECTED ADDITION of 570 terawatt (TW)-hours of annual electricity consumption over the next five years is routinely framed by planners as a triumph of industrial expansion. It is more accurately viewed as a structural pivot point.

As the nation simultaneously builds an advanced manufacturing core, a high-density artificial intelligence (AI) infrastructure and a clean-energy grid, the primary constraint on growth is shifting away from generation capacity. The next frontier of economic competitiveness lies on the demand side. India's long-term energy resilience, energy intelligence, and sustainability will depend entirely on how intelligently the country manages the power it integrates into its systems.

For decades, Indian energy policy and industrial strategy operated under a singular directive: add megawatts (MW), expand transmission infrastructure and secure primary fuel sources. These supply-side priorities cleared the initial hurdles of industrialisation and successfully built a generation capacity that now crosses 520 GW. However, the economic architecture currently under construction



facturing expansion, the aggregate strain on the power system changes qualitatively, making demand-side efficiency and sustainable energy management critical to future readiness.

This creates a distinct operational challenge. As variable wind and solar power form a larger share of the energy mix, supply predictability naturally fluctuates. For a modern semiconductor plant or a Tier-4 data centre, power quality and absolute reliability are non-negotiable. A microsecond voltage drop or a transient frequency variation can disrupt an entire production batch or corrupt critical digital workflows. The historical milestone was overcoming absolute power shortages; the modern milestone is maintaining precise power stability across a decentralised, multi-source grid.

Every modern industrial facility, automated logistics hub, and commercial development generates massive volumes of operational data.

Historically, this data remained siloed within separate plant systems. Translating this information into actionable efficiency via real-time energy management systems, industrial software, and predictive analytics is now a core requirement for sustainable corporate growth.

In practice, this involves deploying digital twins to simulate operational and thermodynamic outcomes before capital expenditure is locked in. It requires integrating intelligent building management systems that automatically adjust cooling and power allocation based on real-time occupancy and server loads. On the factory floor, industrial software platforms can synchronize heavy production schedules with real-time grid availability and cost signals. The most reliable unit of energy is the one that operational intelligence prevents

from being drawn from the grid in the first place.

This reinforces the importance of demand-side efficiency as a strategic lever. This structural shift opens up clear avenues for collaborative policy evolution. To fully unlock demand-side efficiency, state electricity regulatory commissions (SERCs) and power distribution companies (discoms) have the opportunity to look beyond standard time-of-day tariffs toward modern frameworks like demand-side response (DSR). Introducing flexible pricing structures and clear regulatory incentives can encourage large industrial and digital consumers to automatically curtail or shift their loads during peak grid stress, providing vital balancing power to the utility network.

The capital expenditure decisions made during this current investment cycle will lock in India's industrial energy intensity for the next thirty years. Developing infrastructure that is intelligent by design provides a definitive mechanism to decouple robust economic growth from carbon-intensive grid expansion. True competitiveness will belong to the enterprises and nations that treat operational data as a core energy asset. Building this intelligence into the foundation of our infrastructure ensures a resilient, high-efficiency power sector.

The next phase of leadership will be defined by how intelligently we power growth.

By placing energy resilience at the core of its growth model and accelerating the convergence of energy and industrial intelligence, India can not only sustain its momentum but set a global benchmark for responsible, future-ready development.

The path forward is clear. Growth and efficiency are no longer trade-offs. They are the same objective.

MSCI Aug rejig to see 4 Indian stocks added, three removed

GLOBAL INDEX PROVIDER MSCI said on Thursday said four Indian companies — Adani Energy Solutions, Billionbrains Garage Ventures (Groww), Laurus Labs and Lenskart Solutions — will be added to its global standard index as part of its August review, underscoring the continuing churn in India's representation within global passive portfolios.

Three companies — Astral, Balkrishna Industries and SBI Cards and Payment Services — would move out of the index.

The changes will be implemented after the close of trading on August 31, 2026, and take effect on September 1, MSCI said.

Laurus Labs, an active pharmaceutical ingredients manufacturer; Lenskart, an omnichannel eyewear retailer; Adani Energy Solutions, the Adani Group's power transmission and distribution arm, and Groww, a digital investment and broking platform, will enter the index. They will replace tyre maker Balkrishna Industries, credit-card issuer SBI Cards, and building-materials company Astral. Following the reshuffle, the number of Indian constituents in the key MSCI index will rise to 166 from 165.

“आसियान चषकातून भारतीय संघाचे नाव मागे घेण्यात आले आहे. ब्राझीलविरुद्धचा सामना आणि आसियान चषक या दोन्हीत खेळणे शक्य नाही. त्यामुळे ब्राझीलविरुद्धच्या सामन्याला पसंती देण्यात आली आहे,” असे सत्यनारायण यांनी वृत्तसंस्थेला सांगितले.

या निर्णयामुळे दक्षिण-पूर्व आशियातील काही अव्वल संघांविरुद्ध ‘फिफा’च्या मान्यतेखालील स्पर्धेत खेळण्याची संधीही भारताला गमवावी लागणार आहे. आसियानचा सदस्य नसतानाही भारताला या स्पर्धेत सहभागी होण्यासाठी आमंत्रित करण्यात आले होते. भारताने सुरुवातीला ‘फिफा’चे हे आमंत्रण स्वीकारले होते आणि सहभागाचा करारही केला होता. त्यानंतर

भारत आगामी काळात २०२६ ‘फिफा’ विश्वचषकात सहभागी झालेल्या संघांविरुद्ध मैत्रीपूर्ण सामने खेळण्याच्या प्रयत्नात असल्याचे वृत्त गुरुवारी समोर आले. केप व्हर्डे आणि इराण या संघांविरुद्ध सामने आयोजित करण्याबाबत चर्चा सुरु असल्याचे सांगितले जात आहे. मात्र, याला ‘एआयएफएफ’ने अद्याप अधिकृत दुजोरा मिळलेला नाही.

इंडोनेशिया, मलेशिया आणि सिंगापर या संघांसह भारताचा विभाग-१, गट-‘अ’मध्ये समावेश करण्यात आला होता.

ही स्पर्धा २१ सप्टेंबर ते ६ ऑक्टोबर या कालावधीत खेळवली जाणार आहे. मात्र, भारताचा ब्राझीलविरुद्धचा सामना ३ ऑक्टोबर रोजी कोलकात्यातील सॉल्ट लेक स्टेडियमवर निश्चित झाल्यामुळे वेळापत्रकाचा संघर्ष निर्माण झाला. ब्राझीलविरुद्धचा हा सामना गेल्या महिन्यात अधिकृतपणे जाहीर करण्यात आला होता. त्यामुळे भारतासमोर आसियान चषकात

सहभागी होणे किंवा ब्राझीलसारख्या जागतिक दर्जाच्या संघांविरुद्ध खेळण्याची संधी स्वीकारणे, असा पेच निर्माण झाला होता. अखेर ‘एआयएफएफ’ने ब्राझीलविरुद्धच्या सामन्याला अधिक महत्त्व देण्याचा निर्णय घेतला.

आसियान चषकात राखीव फळीतील खेळाडूंना संधी देऊन ब्राझीलविरुद्धच्या सामन्यासाठी प्रमुख संघ उतरवण्याची शक्यताही ‘एआयएफएफ’ने यापूर्वी तपासली होती. मात्र, अखेरीस महासंघाने स्पर्धेतून पूर्णपणे माघार घेण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आहे.

पॅरिस सेंट-जर्मेनचे वर्चस्व कायम

सलग दुसऱ्यांदा सुपर चषकाचे जेतेपद



साल्झबर्ग : पॅरिस सेंट-जर्मेन संघाने युरोपीय क्लब फुटबॉलमधील आपले वर्चस्व कायम राखले. सलग दोन वेळा चॅम्पियन्स लीग जिंकणाऱ्या सेंट-जर्मेनने ‘सुपर चषक’ आपल्याकडेच राखण्याची किमया साधली आहे. बुधवारी रात्री झालेल्या लढतीत फ्रेंच क्लब सेंट-जर्मेनने ‘युरोपा लीग’ विजेत्या अंश्टन व्हिला संघाचा २-१ असा पराभव केला.

साल्झबर्ग येथील रेड बुल मैदानावर झालेल्या सामन्यात पॅरिस संघाने २०व्या मिनिटाला आघाडी घेतली.

त्यांच्यासाठी खविचा क्वारत्सखेलियाने हा गोल केला. मात्र, अंश्टन व्हिलाने प्रयत्न कायम राखताना पहिल्या सत्राच्या अखेरीस बरोबरी साधली. ४५व्या मिनिटाला कर्णधार जॉन मॅकगिनचा अप्रतिम पासवर १७ वर्षीय ब्रायन माडजोने गोल केला. या गोलसह माडजो युरोपीय सुपर चषकाच्या इतिहासातील सर्वात कमी वयाचा गोल करणारा खेळाडू ठरला.

उत्तरार्धात सेंट-जर्मेनच्या आक्रमणाला अधिक धार आली.

त्यांनी सातत्याने गोलसाठी प्रयत्न केले. डिझिरे दुप्रेने ६२व्या मिनिटाला गोल करत सेंट-जर्मेनला २-१ अशी आघाडी मिळवून दिली. गोल करण्यापूर्वी दुप्रे ‘ऑफ-साइड’ होता का, याची व्हिडीओ तंत्रज्ञानाच्या (व्हीएआर) मदतीने तपासणी करण्यात आली. मात्र, दुप्रेने योग्य वेळी अंश्टन व्हिलाच्या बचावपट्ट्याच्या पुढे धाव घेतल्याचे स्पष्ट झाल्याने हा गोल ग्राह्य धरण्यात आला. अखेर हाच गोल निर्णायक ठरला.

अंश्टन व्हिलाने सेंट-जर्मेन संघाला चांगली झुंज दिली. सेंट-जर्मेनचा गोलरक्षक मॅटवे सफोनोव्हला अनेक प्रसंगी महत्त्वाचे बचाव करावे लागले. मात्र, अंश्टन व्हिलाच्या प्रयत्नांना यश आले नाही. त्यामुळे अंश्टन व्हिलाचे प्रशिक्षक उनाय एमरी यांची सुपर चषकातील सलग चार पराभवांची मालिका कायम राहिली. यापूर्वी दोन वेळा सेव्हिया आणि एकदा व्हिलारेयल संघाला मार्गदर्शन करताना एमरी यांना अपयश आले होते.
