- The above results were reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on 30th May 2026.
- A fire broke out on 11th April, 2025 in the open space of the Plant at Pithampur where HDPE Pipes & Sprinkler Pipes were stored, that caused losses in some part of inventory. There was no human casualties. The total financial losses were estimated as Rs. 499.37 Lacs & necessary adjustment have been made in Books of Accounts.
- The Government of India has consolidated twenty nine existing labour legislations into a united framework comprising four Labour Code viz Code on Wages 2019, Code on Social Security 2020, Industrial Relation Code 2020, and Occupational Safety, Health and Working Condition Code 2020 (Collectively referred to as the 'New Labour Codes'). These Codes have been made effective from November 21, 2025. The corresponding supporting rules under these codes are yet to be notified. The management has assessed the full impact of these new labour code and impact of RS.16.98 lakhs has been provided in the Statement of Profit & Loss.
- The audited financial results for quarter ended March 31, 2026 are the balancing figures between the audited figures for the full financial year than ended and the published year to date reviewed figures upto the third quarter of the respective financial
- Figures of Previous period have been regrouped/reclassified wherever necessary, to make them comparable with current figures of current period.

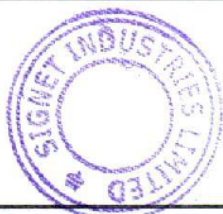

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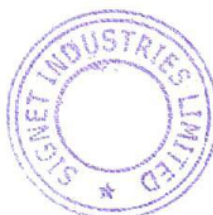

Report on the audit of the Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying quarterly and year to date financial results of Signet Industries Limited (the Company) for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2026 attached herewith being submitted by the company pursuant to the Regulations 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended (Listing Regulations).

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us these financial results :

(i) are presented in accordance with the requirements of the Listing Regulations 33 of The SEBI (Listing Obligation and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended in this regards and

(ii) gives a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principle laid down in the applicable Indian accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the net profit, other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2026.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 (as amended). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results section of our report. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial results, the Board of directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

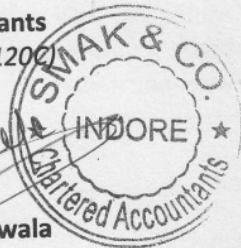
Other Matter
