DMK alliance holds protest in Erode condemning voter list revision

Erode, Nov. 12: A massive protest was organized in Erode by the DMK-led alliance parties condemning the Election Commission of India's intensive voter list revision process. The protest was held near Chimney Hotel, Erode, jointly organized by the Secular Progressive Alliance (SPA) to denounce both the Election Commission of India, which introduced the Special Summary Revision scheme in Tamil Nadu despite opposition from all alliance parties, and the Central BJP government, for failing to address their concerns. The demonstration was led by Erode North District DMK Secretary Nallasivam, who also delivered an address. Several prominent leaders

Thousands of DMK alliance functionaries and cadres from Erode North, South, and Central districts — including state, district, city, town, union, area, village, ward, and branch-level office bearers, BLA2, PTA, and PLC members, as well as local body representatives — participated enthusiastically in the protest, raising slogans against the Election Commission and the Central government.
