


Marudamalai Temple imposes vehicle restrictions

Coimbatore, Jan. 29: In view of the expected heavy influx of devotees during the Thaipusam festival, the Marudamalai Murugan Temple, located in the Perur Taluk of Coimbatore district, has announced restrictions on vehicle movement to the hill temple.

Accordingly, devotees will not be permitted to travel to the hill temple using two-wheelers or four-wheelers for a period of five days, from January 30

to February 3.

During these days, devotees can reach the temple by climbing the hill steps or by using the buses operated by the temple administration, as well as special buses arranged by the temple. The Marudamalai temple administration has requested devotees to cooperate with these arrangements to ensure smooth crowd management and safety during the festival period.

Weekly turmeric auction to begin at Chithode from Feb

Erode, Jan 29: In Erode district, turmeric auctions are presently being conducted continuously from Monday to Friday between 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. at four locations — the Perundurai and Erode Regulated Market Committees, and the Erode and Gobichettipalayam Agricultural Producers' Cooperative Marketing Societies.

Recently, a dedicated turmeric auction facility with all infrastructure

amenities has been established at the Chithode Regulated Market Committee. Since April 14 last year, turmeric auctions have been conducted there through the Electronic National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) online platform.

As a continuation of this initiative, it has been announced that turmeric auctions will be held at the Chithode Regulated Market Committee every Saturday, starting from

February 14, at around 11 a.m.

Farmers have been requested to segregate their turmeric bags according to quality and variety, and to remove stones, soil, dust, and other foreign materials mixed with the produce before bringing them for auction.

They have also been advised to store their turmeric stock in the 1,000-metric-ton capacity warehouse available at the Chithode Regulated

Market Committee and to avail themselves of pledge loans by submitting necessary documents, including Aadhaar card and a copy of the front page of their bank passbook.

The Erode District Collector has further urged farmers in the district to benefit by selling their turmeric produce at the Chithode Regulated Market Committee functioning at Kannimarkadu, Nallakoundanpalayam.

No unsegregated waste dumped at Vellore, CCMC tells NGT

Coimbatore, Jan 29:

The Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) has informed the Southern Bench of the National Green Tribunal (NGT) that no unsegregated municipal solid waste has been dumped at the Vellore dumpyard since December 22, 2025. The statement was made in a compliance report filed before the Tribunal in connection with cases relating to environmental pollution and waste management at the site.

According to the report, the corporation has stopped open dumping of waste at the Vellore dumpyard and is ensuring that only segregated waste is handled in accordance with the Solid Waste Management Rules. The civic body stated that measures have been taken to prevent violations and to strictly enforce segregation of waste at source across the city.

The corporation further informed the Tribunal that Phase II bio-mining of legacy waste at the

dumpyard is in progress. Officials said large quantities of accumulated waste from previous years are being processed systematically as part of the clean-up operation, with the objective of reducing environmental hazards and reclaiming land at the site. The CCMC reiterated its commitment to complete the bio-mining process within the stipulated timeline submitted earlier to the Tribunal.

In its submission, the corporation also said enforcement action has been intensified against bulk waste generators who fail to comply with segregation norms. Penalties and monitoring mechanisms have been strengthened to ensure adherence to waste management rules and to prevent the dumping of mixed waste.

However, environmental activists have disputed the claims made by the corporation. Representatives of local pollution prevention groups contended that the city

lacks adequate infrastructure to process the entire quantity of waste generated daily. They alleged that the claim of zero dumping of unsegregated waste was not in line with ground realities and urged the Tribunal to conduct an independent verification.

Taking note of the submissions and objections, the National Green Tribunal directed the Central Pollution Control Board and the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board to inspect the Vellore dumpyard and submit a factual report on waste segregation, dumping practices, and compliance with environmental norms. The matter has been posted for further hearing after the inspection reports are filed.

The Vellore dumpyard has been under scrutiny for several years due to issues such as accumulation of legacy waste, leachate seepage, foul odour, and incidents of fire, raising concerns among residents about air and groundwater pollution.
