REVENUE DECLINES 1.3% TO ₹21,256 CRORE

ITC Q2 profit rises 3% to ₹5,126 crore

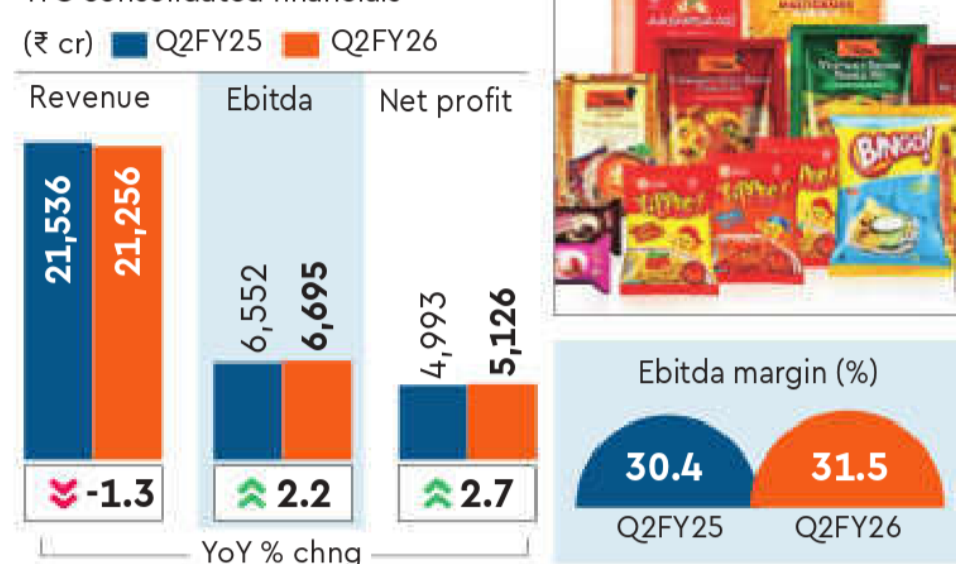

CIGARETTE-TO-FMCG major ITC on Thursday reported a year-on-year growth of nearly 3% in its consolidated profit for the September quarter at ₹5,187 crore, but revenue declined 1.3% y-o-y to ₹21,256 crore amid GST transition issues. The mixed show notwithstanding, the company beat Street estimates on both profit and revenue, which were forecast at ₹5,080 crore and ₹19,774 crore, respectively, for Q2.

Consolidated earnings before interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation (Ebitda) for the second quarter grew 2.2% y-o-y to ₹6,695 crore against Bloomberg consensus estimates of ₹6,446 crore for the period. Ebitda margins expanded 110 basis points in Q2 to 31.5% versus 30.4% reported in the same period last year. One basis point is one-hundredth of a percentage point. The 'FMCG Others' segment saw an 8% y-o-y growth excluding notebooks. But there were short-term disruptions in FMCG due to excessive rains across several regions and the transition to the new GST regime, the company said. Growth was led by staples, dairy,

premium personal wash, and agarbattis, while the premium portfolio and new-age channels continued to perform strongly, it said. ITC derives over 45% and 31% of its total revenue from cigarettes and FMCG segments, respectively.

In the cigarettes segment, net revenue rose 7% y-o-y, driven by strong performance in the differentiated and premium offerings. Strategic portfolio initiatives and market interventions, particularly in competitive markets and to counter illicit trade, helped reinforce the company's leadership position. Leaf tobacco consumption costs remained elevated,

although procurement prices moderated in the current crop cycle, it said.

The notebooks business remained under pressure owing to low-priced paper imports and increased competition from local and regional players. Meanwhile, GST rates were reduced in over half of the FMCG portfolio, and the company passed on the benefits to consumers. The segment's Ebitda margin improved by 50 basis points q-o-q, supported by smart revenue management, price-volume-value rebalancing, and focused cost optimisation amid input cost volatility.

Dabur profit rises 6.5% to ₹453 cr in Sept quarter

CONSUMER GOODS MAJOR Dabur on Thursday posted a 6.5% year-on-year increase in its consolidated net profit of ₹453 crore for the September quarter. The figure fell short of Bloomberg consensus estimates of ₹457 crore amid GST trade disruptions during the quarter. Consolidated revenue was up 5.4% y-o-y to ₹3,191 crore, also below Street estimates of ₹3,217 crore.

The board approved the launch of Dabur Ventures, an investment platform with capital allocation of up to ₹500 crore, which will be invested in acquiring stakes in high-potential, new-age digital-first businesses, the company said. "Continuing with our payout policy, the board has declared an interim dividend of ₹2.75 per share, aggregating to a total payout of ₹487.76 crore," Dabur India Chairman Mohit Burman said.

Earnings before interest tax depreciation and amortisation was up 6.4% y-o-y to ₹588 crore, in line with Bloomberg estimates of ₹587 crore. Ebitda margins were steady in Q2 at 18.4%, higher than 18.2% a year ago, but in line with Street expectations of 18.2% for the quarter.

Adani Power Q2 profit falls 12% to ₹2,906 cr

ADANI POWER ON Thursday posted a 12% decline in consolidated net profit to ₹2,906 crore in the September quarter, driven by a rise in expenses. It had clocked a net profit of

₹3,297.52 crore in the July-September period of the preceding 2024-25 financial year, the Adani Group entity said in an exchange filing. Total income, however, increased to ₹14,307.79 crore in the September quarter from ₹14,062.84 crore in the year-

ago period. The revenues were higher despite lower merchant tariffs and import coal prices, supported by higher power sales, the company said. Total expenses stood at ₹10,341.59 crore, higher from ₹9,928.76 crore in Q2 FY25.

The company has again demonstrated stable financial performance this quarter, in the face of weather-driven fluctuations in demand, highlighting our operational efficiency and competitive advantages, SB Khyalia, CEO of Adani Power Limited, said.

Infra, energy and realty to drive domestic order growth for L&T

OPPORTUNITIES IN ENERGY, infrastructure, real estate and others are expected to boost the domestic orders of Larsen & Toubro (L&T) in the coming quarters, say brokerages. In Q2FY26, the company got orders worth ₹115,784 crore at the group level, and 45% of order inflows were domestic orders and about 50% of the domestic orders were infrastructure orders. International orders mostly came from hydrocarbon renewables and power trans-

mission and distribution, the company said.

L&T is witnessing improvement in order inflow prospects from domestic markets, Motilal Oswal Financial Services said in a note. Over the next two to three years, the company is eyeing around 10-15GW of thermal power projects, along with opportunities from nuclear and hydro power, strong inflows from buildings and factories, particularly from real estate, and opportunities from transportation infrastructure, metals and mining, as well as defence, it said. "We expect these opportu-

nities to bring improvement in domestic order inflows for the company over time," Motilal Oswal said. L&T is going slow on water projects on account of payment delays. Water segment currently forms 7% of the total order book, it said.

Elara Securities said L&T delivered a strong Q2, with E&C (engineering and construction) order inflows up 54% y-o-y, led by large wins in hydrocarbon and infrastructure segments, both domestically and in West Asia, reinforcing robust visibility. "A sharp uptick in the order prospect pipeline (₹10.4 lakh crore), led by energy transition

and infrastructure opportunities, underpins strong inflow momentum to continue in H2," it said.

Antique Stock Broking said since L&T is the largest infrastructure company in the country, it believes the company would be a key beneficiary of various infrastructure development projects and the central government's Gati Shakti, which is a pivotal theme to revive the Indian economy.

Motil Oswal noted L&T is steadily diversifying into new-age sectors aligned with global sustainability and technological trends.

DLF Q2 profit down 15% to ₹1,180 crore

REALTY MAJOR DLF on Thursday reported 15% decline in consolidated net profit at ₹1,180.09 crore for the second quarter of this fiscal year, while sales bookings jumped over six-times to ₹4,332 crore on strong demand for its newly launched project in Mumbai. Its net profit stood at ₹1,381.22 crore in the year-ago period.

Revenue from operations fell to ₹1,643.04 crore during the July-September period of this fiscal year from

₹1,975.02 crore a year ago. Total income, however, rose to ₹2,261.80 crore from ₹2,180.83 crore in the year-ago period on the back of increase in the other income.

DLF is the country's largest real estate firm in terms of market capitalisation. "New sales bookings for the second quarter stood at ₹4,332 crore, driven by the successful maiden launch in Mumbai — The Westpark and continued healthy momentum in the super-luxury segment," DLF said in a statement.

Its sales bookings stood at ₹692 crore in the year-ago period.

एक बाहुबली नेता के शामिल होने के आरोप लगाए हैं। प्रत्यक्षदर्शियों का कहना है कि घटना के वकत दुलारचंद के समर्थकों के साथ दूसरे गुट की झड़प के बाद दुलारचंद पर गोली चलाई गई, जिससे वह जखमी हो गए। मोकामा में पहले चरण के लिए छह नवंबर को मतदान होना है। मोकामा टाल के एक गांव में चुनाव प्रचार के दौरान हुई इस घटना के बाद पूरे इलाके में अफरा तफरी का माहौल बन गया।

आगामी चुनाव में मोकामा विधानसभा सीट इसलिए बेहद अहम है कि इस सीट पर दो बाहुबली नेताओं के बीच टक्कर है। सुरजभान की पत्नी वीणा देवी राजद की उम्मीदवार हैं, जिनका मुकाबला जद(एकी) के उम्मीदवार अनंत सिंह से है। जन सुराज के उम्मीदवार पीयूष प्रियदर्शी ने कहा कि गरीब दबने वाला नहीं है, दुलारचंद के साथ जो कुछ हुआ, बहुत जल्दी उसका जवाब देंगे।

सरकार बजट सत्र में सख्त बीज कानून पेश करेगी : चौहान

नई दिल्ली, 30 अक्टूबर।

कृषि मंत्री शिवराज सिंह चौहान ने गुरुवार को कहा, सरकार अगले साल की शुरुआत में संसद के बजट सत्र के दौरान बीज की गुणवत्ता को विनियमित करने के लिए सख्त प्रावधानों वाला कानून पेश करने की योजना बना रही है। किसान उत्पादक संगठनों (एफपीओ) पर एक कार्यक्रम को संबोधित करते हुए चौहान ने कहा कि इन संशोधनों का उद्देश्य कृषक समुदाय को गुणवत्तापूर्ण उत्पादों की आपूर्ति सुनिश्चित करना है।
