Consumer courts facing shortage of staff, leaders

THE COUNTRY'S CONSUMER dispute redressal system is operating with serious gaps in leadership, staffing, and data transparency despite rising caseloads, according to a new nationwide assessment by the India Justice Report (IJR). "More than half of the president and member positions in India's State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commissions (SCDRCs) remained vacant in 2025, contributing to a 21% rise in overall case pendency over five years," the report said, adding that amongst the large and mid-sized states, only Bihar and Haryana filled both member and president posts. In 2025, 17 of the 35 state commissions were without a president, and 40% of the sanctioned member positions remained vacant. Furthermore, while regulations stipulate that every district must have a commission, one in ten districts is currently without one, indicating a concerning gap in governance. "These presidents play a vital role in forming benches, supervising district operations, and managing finances. Compounding the issue,

nearly 40% of authorised member positions at both state and district levels remain unfilled, while state commissions report an average staff vacancy rate of around 20%," the report said.

The report covered budgets, infrastructure, human resources, workload and gender diversity at state and district levels, and draws on case data for 2.857 million matters filed between 2010 and 2024 on the government's e-Jagriti dashboard.

The report, utilising data from Right to Information (RTI) requests and parliamentary responses, has positioned

Andhra Pradesh at the forefront among 19 large and mid-sized states in terms of institutional capacity. Meanwhile, in the category of small states, Meghalaya and Sikkim ranked highest.

As of 2025, a significant portion of State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commissions (SCDRCs) and district consumer commissions are facing critical leadership shortages. Currently, half of all SCDRCs lack a sitting president, with one-third of district commissions in a similar situation.

The report also mentioned that approximately 35% of pending cases at state commissions have remained unre-

solved for over three years, which far exceeds the expected resolution timeframe of three to five months. Over the past five years, overall case pendency has surged by about 20%, raising alarms about the efficiency and effectiveness of consumer redressal mechanisms in the state.

Justice (Retd.) Sanjay Kishan Kaul, former Judge of the Supreme Court of India, noted that these gaps render legislation non-functional.

"Significant gaps affect the consumer protection institutional structure and the access to speedy and effective redressal," Kaul stated during the report's release. He warned that such deficits "erode the confidence of consumers".

Similarly, Justice (Retd.) Madan B Lokur described the situation as "terribly grim," stating the system is working at a "subsistence level".

He questioned whether these bodies can still be considered effective grievance redressal mechanisms when consumption and economic growth are "severely affected by the lack of faith" in the system. The report concludes that durable economic growth requires redressal mechanisms to keep pace with market prosperity.

Social feeds power micro-drama boom: Report

MICRO DRAMAS ARE rapidly emerging as a new content category in India, with social media feeds driving discovery for a vast majority of viewers, according to a joint report by Meta and Omax Media.

The report, titled "Micro Dramas: The India Story", found that nearly 89% of viewers discover micro dramas through social feeds, underlining the role of algorithm-led

recommendations in the growth of the format.

The study, conducted between November 2025 and January 2026, covered 2,000 respondents aged 18-44 across 14 states, along with 50 in-depth interviews.

It noted that 65% of viewers discovered micro dramas within the last year, highlighting the rapid rise of the format among digital audiences.

According to the findings, viewers spend a median of 3.5 hours per week watching micro dramas, typically in seven to eight short sessions daily, indicating a preference for quick, repeat viewing rather than long-form content.

Consumption peaks between 8 pm and midnight, with additional spikes during commutes and work breaks, suggesting that micro dramas complement

rather than compete with traditional OTT platforms.

The report said around 90% of micro-drama viewing happens solo, making it a highly personal, mobile-first experience.

It further noted a rise in regional language consumption, with Tamil, Telugu and Kannada emerging as key languages after Hindi and English.

From banks to the backbone

NITIN CHUGH SHIFTS FROM FRONTLINE BANKING TO BUILDING THE TECH RAILS OF GLOBAL FINANCE AT PERFIOS

WHEN NITIN CHUGH walks into PerfiOS as managing director and group CEO, he brings more than a résumé. He brings a playbook—honed over nearly three decades of reshaping how India banks, borrows and pays. Few executives have straddled legacy banking and digital disruption as seamlessly or as consistently as he has.

His career has been less a linear climb and more a series of deliberate rewrites of the financial services script—across HDFC Bank, Ujjivan Small Finance Bank and the State Bank of India (SBI). The common thread: using technology not as an add-on, but as the core engine of growth.

Chugh's defining act came at HDFC Bank, where he rose to become group head of digital banking. Between 2013 and 2019, when much of Indian banking was still cautiously testing digital channels, he pushed decisively ahead. Mobile-first was not a buzzword under his watch—it was doctrine. Payments, online banking and customer engagement were rebuilt around the smartphone, fundamentally altering how millions interacted with their bank. By the time he left, HDFC Bank had become a benchmark for digital adoption.

In 2019, he moved to Ujjivan Small Finance Bank as MD and CEO—a shift that tested a different muscle. If HDFC was about scale and sophistication, Ujjivan was about reach. The challenge was not just to digitise, but to democratise. Chugh focused on building systems

that could scale into underserved segments, using technology to lower barriers rather than raise them. It reinforced his reputation as a leader who could balance operational discipline with inclusion.

His next move, in 2022, brought him into the heart of India's largest lender. Then chairman Dinesh Khara brought Chugh into SBI as deputy managing director and head of digital banking and transformation, signalling a renewed push for modernisation. At SBI, scale took on a different dimension. With hundreds of millions of customers, even incremental improvements had outsized impact.

Chugh played a key role in advancing YONO, the bank's flagship digital platform, and its upgraded version, YONO 2.0, rolled out under current chairman CS Setty. Artificial intelligence and analytics were embedded more deeply into customer acquisition and risk management, strengthening decision-making as the bank adapted to a rapidly digitising economy. His influ-

ence extended beyond SBI's core operations, with board roles at SBI Card, SBI Payment Services and ONDC, placing him at the intersection of banking, payments and digital commerce.

At PerfiOS, Chugh steps into a different kind of institution—one that operates less like a bank and more like the infrastructure behind many of them. The company, a B2B SaaS TechFin player, supports decision-making for more than 1,000 financial institutions across 20 countries, processing billions of data points each year. Its ecosystem—from fraud detection (ClariS) to collections (CreditNirvana) and health claims automation (IHX)—positions it as a core enabler of financial services.

For Chugh, the mandate is both evolutionary and expansive. PerfiOS is already embedded in the plumbing of finance; the next step is to make that plumbing smarter, faster and more global. Artificial intelligence sits at the centre of that ambition—across credit decisions, fraud prevention, risk management and collections—offering not just

efficiency gains but new ways of assessing and extending credit.

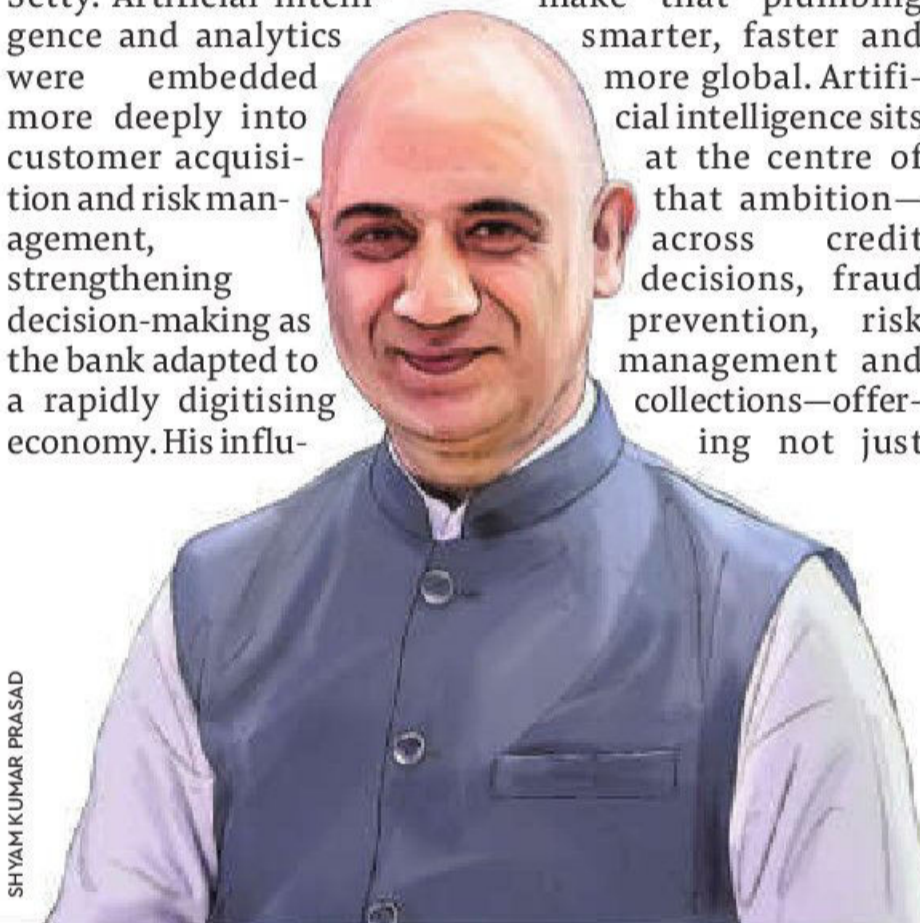
He has described this phase as one of accelerating possibilities, where data and intelligence can expand access to formal finance while improving the speed and quality of decisions. That dual objective—scale with inclusion—echoes his earlier roles, but now with a broader, global canvas.

The challenges are significant. Competition from specialised fintechs is intensifying, regulatory scrutiny in digital lending is tightening, and global markets bring their own compliance complexities. For PerfiOS, ambition will need to be matched by execution discipline.

This is where Chugh's hybrid experience could prove decisive. He understands both the agility of fintech and the rigour of banking—an increasingly valuable combination as the two worlds converge. His task will be to deepen institutional partnerships, align innovation with regulatory expectations, and build trust at scale.

If his past is any guide, Chugh is unlikely to chase disruption for its own sake. His approach has been to embed change steadily until it becomes the norm. At PerfiOS, that instinct may determine whether the company remains a fast-growing enabler or evolves into a defining force in global financial infrastructure.

In the end, Chugh's career has been anchored in a simple idea: the future of finance is not built only at the front end, but in the systems that power it. At PerfiOS, he now has the opportunity to shape those systems on a much larger stage.
