India set to fill global seafarer gap amid rising demand for officers

FRESH OPPORTUNITIES. Shipping industry is set to face a shortage of over 1.13 lakh certified officers by 2030

India has an opportunity to significantly expand its share of the global maritime workforce as the shipping industry faces a growing shortage of qualified officers, according to the Seafarer Workforce Report 2026, released by BIMCO and the International Chamber of Shipping (ICS).

The report forecasts that the global merchant fleet will require an additional 1,13,735 STCW-certified officers by 2030, reflecting rising demand driven by fleet expansion, technological advancements and stricter regulatory requirements.

The report estimates that 2.57 million seafarers currently serve aboard 85,148 merchant ships worldwide. However, the industry already faces a shortage of 39,100 certified officers in 2026, even as there is a surplus of 56,890 ratings.

To meet projected demand, the global shipping industry will need to recruit an additional 22,747 officers and 8,475 ratings every year

until 2030, representing annual growth of 2 per cent and 0.5 per cent respectively.

KEY SUPPLIER

India, currently the world's third-largest supplier of seafarers after the Philippines and China, accounts for nearly 16 per cent of the global maritime workforce. Industry experts believe the country is well placed to capitalise on the emerging demand.

"India has the potential to significantly expand its presence in the global maritime workforce — not just in

numbers, but in quality, reliability and global trust," Director General of Shipping Shyam Jagannathan said.

He said India's strategy extends beyond increasing training capacity and focuses on improving competency, strengthening training quality, modernising governance, promoting inclusion and adopting digital certification and sustainable practices.

India currently has 176 maritime training institutes, comprising 81 pre-sea institutes for new entrants and 95 post-sea institutes that provide advanced, simu-

lator-based and competency training for serving seafarers, he said.

Malini V Shankar, Vice-Chancellor of the Indian Maritime University, said Indian seafaring officers are highly respected. The number of institutions offering courses has increased.

However, the critical bottleneck is the lack of adequate training berths. Without the requisite 'sea time', they cannot find regular jobs, she added.

The BIMCO-ICS report noted that demand for STCW-certified seafarers had increased 35 per cent since the previous survey in 2021.

Demand for officers has risen 23.1 per cent, while demand for ratings has increased 46.3 per cent, reflecting the recovery of global shipping after the pandemic and continued fleet growth.

TALENT PIPELINE

"The recruitment, training and retention of the seafarer workforce will be crucial to ensuring that our industry is prepared for the future," said David Loosley, Secretary

General and CEO of BIMCO. ICS Secretary General Thomas A Kazakos said attracting young people into maritime careers will be critical to building a sustainable talent pipeline for the industry's long-term needs.

Industry executives said India's competitiveness had also been strengthened by stable wage levels, favourable exchange rates and growing international acceptance of its seafarers.

According to Capt Sanjay Prashar of VR Maritime Services Pvt Ltd, Indian seafarer employment reached 3,13,429 in 2025 and is expected to exceed 3,50,000 this year.

He attributed the rising demand for Indian crew to the growing number of certified officers, government support, and supply constraints in several competing labour markets, including China, Turkey, Ukraine and Russia.

He added that Indian officers increasingly occupy positions in global ship management companies, further boosting employment opportunities for the country's seafarers worldwide.

Uber India & South Asia President quits

Prabhjeet Singh has stepped down as President of Uber India and South Asia after a 11-year stint to pursue another leadership opportunity, sources told *businessline*.

They said Uber's India leadership team will continue to manage day-to-day operations, closely supported by the Asia Pacific leadership, until a transition is finalised.

Singh's exit follows a week-long visit to India last month by Uber Chief Executive Officer Dara Khosrowshahi, who met with senior Cabinet Ministers in New Delhi and visited Mumbai, alongside the company's tech centres in Bengaluru and Hyderabad.

Confirming Singh's resignation, an Uber spokeswoman stated that India remains a crucial driver of innovation and long-term growth.

TN eyes ₹3 lakh cr defence manufacturing opportunity

The Tamil Nadu government has stepped up efforts to position the State as a key aerospace and defence (A&D) manufacturing hub, taking its outreach campaign to industries across various cities to showcase business opportunities emerging from India's rapidly expanding defence sector.

At an industry interaction organised by the Tamil Nadu Defence Industrial Corridor (TNDIC) in Madurai, officials from Tamil Nadu Industrial Development Corporation (Tidco) said India's defence production had crossed ₹1.54 lakh crore last year, while exports exceeded ₹38,000 crore.

WOOLING INVESTMENT

With the Centre targeting ₹3 lakh crore in defence production and ₹50,000 crore in exports by 2029, Tamil Nadu is seeking to attract a significant share of investments and manufacturing activity.

The officials highlighted multi-billion-dollar opportunities across major defence and aerospace programmes, including future ready combat vehicles, future infantry combat vehicles, the advanced medium combat aircraft, medium role fighter aircraft, submarines, maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO), propellants and the space sector.

MAJOR OUTREACH

The outreach programme in Madurai is part of a series of consultations being organised in Coimbatore, Hosur, Tiruchi, Chennai and Madurai ahead of the National Departmental Summit on 'Atmanirbhara in Defence Manufacturing - Promoting State Ecosystems', scheduled to be held in New Delhi on August 20 and 21.

India among Utah's top priorities, says Governor Cox

India is a major priority market for the State of Utah and a trade mission to India is being planned for next year, Utah Governor Spencer J Cox said here on Thursday.

"India is a fascinating region of the world right now. It's one of our top priorities. We are already planning a trade mission that I will be attending next year," Cox told *businessline* while speaking to a group of international journalists in Salt Lake City, Utah.

He said he was earlier also trying to be a part of the recent delegation led by US Trade Representative Jameson Greer to New Delhi to seal the trade deal but could not do so.

The Governor's meeting with a select group of journalists was facilitated by the US State Department, as part of an international reporting tour, titled "Bringing Foreign Investment to the United States".

KEY DESTINATION

State economic and investment promotion bodies such as World Trade Center Utah note that the State had

emerged as a key destination for Asian FDI in recent years, particularly from Japan and South Korea. Switzerland, the UK and Germany are the top European contributors.

Governor Cox also spoke about the State's close ties with the Indian community, and said there was a shared entrepreneurial culture with the State.

In addition to a large student population in University of Utah, healthcare, life sciences, manufacturing and software are sectors where Indian small and medium-sized businesses can be counted.

Tata Chemicals North America and nutraceutical company Sami-Sabinsa Group are among large Indian companies located in the Western US mountain State.

Given the recent geopolitical tensions, Governor Cox

believes that sub-national relationships [between countries and individual US States] become more significant than ever, and a State like Utah can provide international investors with the personalised attention and incentives that large States often cannot.

"If you [an investor] comes to a State like Utah, you get incredibly personalised attention. You get to meet with the Governor, and you get help with every stage of your investment," he said. The State Governors and economic development agencies often play a bigger role in investment decisions than national governments, he added.

On the subject of tariffs, the Governor stressed that he believed in free trade but notes that the US has been taken advantage of, in the past, because of its open trading policies.

"If it was up to me, we would get rid of trade barriers everywhere," he said.

He called for predictability and clarity around tariffs to spur business investments.

"Capital is a coward. And if it's unsure about where to invest, it's not going to invest. If we really want people

to invest, we just need to set the rules of the game and leave them," he said.

AI-RELATED BUSINESS

Discussing the State's stance on artificial intelligence (AI) and related business investments, Governor Cox said he

was "a pragmatist" and wanted a middle path between AI development and regulation.

Noting his support for building data centres, he added that this should not be happening everywhere. The State is encouraging com-

panies to build data centres away from population centres, he said.

He also highlighted other measures taken to not strain their natural resources pool.
