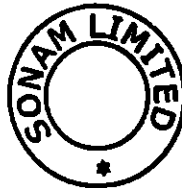

Table Space Leases 1L sq ft at CCD B'uru

BENGALURU Flexible office space provider Table Space Technologies has leased over one lakh square feet in the Cafe Coffee Day Square Property in Bengaluru, which had served as the erstwhile corporate headquarter of the company and its flagship store. The lease term is 60 months with a lock-in period and commands a rental of ₹175 per square foot with a 10% escalation every two years, as per the lease registry document shared by Prostack, a data analytics firm. The Cafe Coffee Day Square at Bengaluru's premium Vittal Malya Road has a total built-up area of over 100,000 sq ft, and each floor measures approximately 9,000 sq ft, said the document. Table Space currently has over 3.5 million square feet, including this new lease transaction, under its portfolio, totalling over 75,000 seats across seven key cities in India. The Bengaluru-based firm continues to grow its portfolio across the country, with plans to reach 21 million square feet by 2026. Ad Industry to Grow 12% to Over ₹1.1L cr This Yr: Madison

NEW DELHI: Madison Media predicted a 12% growth of the advertising industry this year in the 'Pitch Madison Advertising Report 2024', released on Thursday. It is estimated to cross ₹1.1 lakh crore. Global ad expenditure growth is projected to grow by 8%.

The industry grew by 10% in 2023, against Madison's expectations of 16% growth. This is the lowest percentage growth of AdEx in the past 6 years, excluding the pandemic year. According to the World Advertising Research Centre (WARC), the Global AdEx grew by just 5% in 2023.

Sam Balsara, chairman of Madison World, said, "While the outlook for AdEx in India is extremely strong in the medium and long-term, in the short term we are witnessing a slowdown in momentum because of India Re's focus on quarterly profits. This does not augur well for sustained growth in profits for advertisers who should be focusing on volume growth."

Luggage Brands on High-growth Path as Travel Industry Booms

Sector, labelled as 'low-involvement category', sees doubling of sales, rising investor interest

New Delhi: A surge in domestic and international travel is leading to doubling of sales of luggage brands, global names entering India and investor interest in a category that was earlier perceived as a 'low-involvement category', industry executives said.

"We are seeing 100% year-on-year growth in the premium range, with global brands like Tommy Hilf and Delsey Paris. The affordable range is seeing 40%+ year-on-year growth on brands like Safari, Kamiliat, and Aristocrat, also from tier-three and four cities," said Sourabh Srivastava, vice president, Amazon Fashion India.

Reliance Brands has partnered with German luggage brand Rimowa to set up luxury stores in India, the first of which has been opened in Jio World Plaza. Licensing company Dream Theatre, which recently acquired rights to the Deigo Maradona Consumer Products programme in India from Podium Icons, a division of Podium Brands Group in the UK, will soon launch a range of premium luggage under the footballer's iconic franchise, said Jigy George, chief executive at Dream Theatre.

The category is also seeing a spurt in direct-to-consumer brands like Mokobara, Nasher Miles and Uppercase.

15% increase in revenues in FY24. "Organised luggage makers are set to double capacity and ramp up retail presence by 35-40%, drawing up total capital expenditure of ₹100 crore this fiscal," Crisil said in the report. It added while the capex would increase debt levels, overall capital structure and coverage ratios were unlikely to be materially impacted because of improved cash accruals.

Visa-free Locales Top Indians List for Foreign Holiday

ON CLOUD NINE Bookings for Sri Lanka, Thailand surge as relaxations in visa rules boost sentiment

Mumbai: Indians are flocking to destinations, such as Sri Lanka and Thailand, which have been of free visas since last year.

"With the announcement of the free visa policy to Sri Lanka and Thailand, bookings to these countries have seen 15-20% growth," Ayappa R, chief executive of travel portal Cleartrip, told ET.

"The Sri Lankan government in November granted a visa exemption for tourists from India from March 31, 2024, offers free visa for the first 30 days of stay upon arrival, travellers will be granted dual entry status and the visa validity will be limited to a 30-day stay in Sri Lanka.

Also, in November, the Thai government granted a visa exemption for tourists from India from November 10, 2023, to May 10, 2024, for a stay period not exceeding 30 days.

"There is a 33% spike to these places in February, compared to November, before the announcement of free visas," said Ayappa R.

"During the holiday season in December, Indians increasingly favoured visa-free nations, with a significant 49% increase in bookings for destinations like Indonesia, Malaysia, Maldives, Sri Lanka, and Thailand, compared to last year," he added.

Demand for international air travel has increased overall, with Indians travelling in herds to new destinations such as Baku, Almaty, Thiruvananthapuram, and Tashkent. But, much of the incremental demand is for visa-free destinations.

"Visas form a first moment of truth and a significant hurdle to borderless travel — more so for Indian consumers. Not surprising then that the announcement of visa-free entry has been a game-changer catalysing growth by approximately 35% for such destinations. Sopping up the list is Sri Lanka with a top-up of 49%, followed by Malaysia at 35% and Thailand at

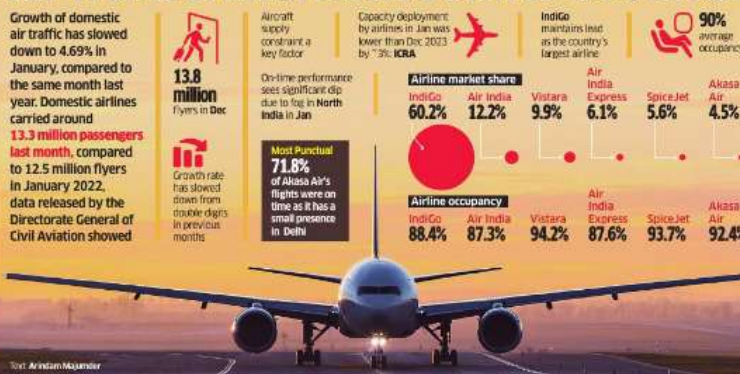

Sun Pharma Scouts for Novel Products to Boost India Biz

Co launched Sovatelite at ₹1,300 per vial, which is much cheaper than others for ischemic stroke

Mumbai: Sun Pharma in September last year launched Tysabri (Sovatelite), a novel therapy for treating ischemic stroke in India, under an exclusive licensing agreement from Illinois-based Pharmaz.

Approved by Indian drug regulatory in May 2023, Sovatelite can be administered within 24 hours for the treatment of ischemic stroke, almost five times more than the narrow time window of 4-5 hours offered by current treatment options called tissue plasminogen activator (tPA) called as thrombolytic drugs that dissolves the clots that causes strokes. An ischemic stroke is a medical emergency that occurs when blood supply to part of a brain is blocked or reduced.

Sun Pharma priced Sovatelite at ₹1,300 per vial. Considering average body weight in India, a total of 9 injections are to be administered in 6 days' time. The total cost of therapy is at ₹1,700. That's much cheaper than two common thrombolytic drugs, alteplase 20 mg - ₹24,000 and tenecteplase - ₹34,500.

These are still early days for sovatelite, which is not yet approved in the US.

Karti Gankar, CEO of India Business at Sun Pharma in an interview to ET said the response from the doctors who use it on their patients has been good. He believes sovatelite has the potential to shake up the ₹15 cr Indian ischemic stroke market.

"We have a business development and portfolio team, which is continuously scanning opportunities across therapies," Gankar said.
