Thailand Parliament elects Thaksin's daughter Paetongtarn Shinawatra as PM

BANGKOK, AUG 16 /--/ Thailand's Parliament elected Paetongtarn Shinawatra, the youngest daughter of the divisive former leader Thaksin Shinawatra, as the country's new Prime Minister Friday.

Paetongtarn becomes Thailand's third leader from the Shinawatra family, after her father, who was ousted by coup before returning from exile last year, and her aunt Yingluck Shinawatra, who lives in exile. Paetongtarn also became Thailand's second female Prime Minister after her aunt and the country's youngest leader at 37. She is the leader of the ruling Pheu Thai party but was not an elected lawmaker, which was not required for her to be a candidate for Prime Minister.

Paetongtarn was the sole nominee and got a majority of the votes in Parliament with the voting ongoing. The last Prime Minister had been removed by the Constitutional Court two days ago over an ethics violation. Thaksin is one of Thailand's most popular but divisive political figures and was ousted

by a military coup in 2006. He is widely seen as a de facto leader of Pheu Thai, the latest in a string of parties linked to him. His residual popularity and influence is a factor behind the political support for Paetongtarn.

Her public entry into politics came in 2021 when the Pheu Thai party announced she would lead an inclusion advisory committee. She was appointed as leader of Pheu Thai last year, after she was named one of its three Prime Ministerial candidates ahead of the polls. When Paetongtarn was on the campaign trail for Pheu Thai, she acknowledged her family ties but insisted she was not just her father's proxy.

"It's not the shadow of my dad. I am my dad's daughter, always and forever, but I have my own decisions," she told a reporter. However, her father's shadow is too big to be dismissed and her work will not be easy with him continuing to call political shots for Pheu Thai, said Petra Alderman, a political research fellow at England's University of Birmingham. "Thaksin was a political

force to reckon with, but he was also a liability," she said. "He has a tendency to overplay his political hand, so serving in his shadow has never been easy." Paetongtarn's nomination followed the removal of Prime Minister Srettha Thavisin on Wednesday after less than a year in office. The Constitutional Court found him guilty of a serious ethical breach regarding his appointment of a Cabinet member who was jailed in connection with an alleged bribery attempt. It was the second major ruling in a week to shake Thai politics. The same court last week dissolved the progressive Move Forward party, which won last year's general election but was blocked from taking power. The party has already regrouped as the People's Party. Pheu Thai and its predecessors had won all national elections since 2001, with core populist policies pledging to solve economic problems and bridge income equality, until it lost to the reformist Move Forward in 2023. It, however, was given a chance to form a Government after Move Forward was

blocked from taking power by the previous Senate, a military-appointed body.

Move Forward was excluded from the coalition by Pheu Thai, which went on to join hands with parties affiliated with the military Government that ousted it in a coup. The move drew criticism from some of its supporters but party officials say it was necessary to break the deadlock and start reconciliation after decades of deep political divisions. Thaksin returned to Thailand last year after years in exile in what was interpreted as part of a political bargain between Pheu Thai and their longstanding rivals in the conservative establishment to stop Move Forward Party from forming a Government. The former senators were given special power to veto a Prime Ministerial candidate by the constitution adopted in 2017 under a military Government. However, that power expired when their term ended in May. New members of the Senate, selected in a convoluted process last month, do not retain the veto. (PTI)

Another murder case filed against ousted B'desh PM Hasina

DHAKA, AUG 16 /--/ A murder case was filed against Bangladesh's former Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on Friday over the death of a teacher, the latest in the string of cases filed against her after her ouster.

The case was filed against Hasina and Awami League General Secretary Obaidul Quader in Bogura. Hasina, 76, fled to India on August 5 after she was forced to resign following a massive protest by students against a quota system in Government jobs.

Ninety-nine other local leaders and activists of her party were also sued in the case filed with Bogura Sadar Police Station over the murder of 35-year-old Selim Hossain, a resident of Palikanda village of Shibganj upazila, on August 4. On August 4, the day before Hasina resigned and fled the country in the face of a student-led mass uprising, Hossain joined students' protest in Bogura's Satmatha area. According to the complaint, Awami League (AL) leaders and activists attacked

the protesters and hacked Hossain to death with sharp weapons. Hossain's brother alleged that AL men killed his brother after getting orders from Hasina and Quader. This is the latest in a string of cases filed against Hasina following her ouster on August 5.

A case of enforced disappearance was filed on August 14 against Hasina and several others, including former ministers of her cabinet, on the charge of kidnapping a lawyer in 2015. On August 13, a murder case was lodged against Hasina and six others over the death of a grocery shop owner during last month's violent clashes that led to the fall of her Government.

Over 230 people were killed in Bangladesh in the incidents of violence that erupted across the country following the fall of the Hasina Government, taking the death toll to 560 since the anti-quota protests first started in mid-July.

Bangladesh's International Crimes Tribunal on Wednesday started an inves-

tigation against the former premier and nine others on charges of genocide and crimes against humanity that took place from July 15 to August 5 during students' mass movement against her Government. A complaint was filed on Wednesday with the investigation agency of Bangladesh's International Crimes Tribunal against Hasina, Awami League general secretary and former Road Transport and Bridges Minister Quader, former Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal, and several other prominent figures within the party.

A team of UN experts will visit Bangladesh next week to investigate the killings of the protesters ahead of and in the aftermath of Sheikh Hasina's resignation as the Prime Minister last week, it was announced on Thursday.

An interim Government was formed after the fall of the Hasina-led regime, and 84-year-old Nobel laureate Muhammad Yunus has been appointed as its Chief Adviser. (PTI)

Pak Health Ministry confirms case of new variant of mpox, 1st in Asia

PESHAWAR, AUG 16 /--/ Pakistan's health ministry said Friday it has identified the first case of a new mpox variant that might be more easily transmitted, days after the World Health Organization declared the spread of mpox a global health emergency.

The case, in a man who had recently returned from a Middle Eastern country, is only the second confirmed case of the new variant outside of Africa.

The first case was reported on Thursday by authorities in Sweden. The ministry in a statement said the man who tested positive for mpox was from Mardan, a district in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province bordering Afghanistan.

It said the ministry has directed officials at border crossing points and airports to ensure strict surveillance and collect samples for medical tests if they see symptoms of the disease in any passenger returning from abroad. It was unclear which Middle Eastern country the man had visited, and no cases of the new variant have yet been reported in that region. The United Arab Emirates, however, has had 16 confirmed cases of mpox since 2022, according to the WHO.

The UAE is particularly affected by transnational outbreaks given its role as a hub connecting East and West with its long-haul carriers Emirates and Etihad.

On Wednesday, the WHO said there have been more than 14,000 cases and 524 deaths in Africa this year, which already exceed last year's figures.

More than 96% of all cases and deaths have been in Congo. The director of public health for Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Dr. Irshad Roghani, said the person infected with mpox in Pakistan has mild symptoms.

"Contact tracing of the affected person has been started and samples of more people are being obtained," he told The Associated Press. Roghani said that since 2022, 300 people have been tested in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, of whom two tested positive last year.

This is the first case detected this year. (PTI)

South African minister says cooperation with India pivotal in amplifying voice of Global South

JOHANNESBURG, AUG 16 /--/ Cooperation between South Africa and India at multilateral fora has played a pivotal role in amplifying the voice of the Global South, South African Minister for Basic Education Siviwe Gwarube has said.

Speaking as the Chief guest at India's 78th Independence Day celebration hosted by the Indian High Commission in Pretoria on Thursday, Gwarube said: "We have found in India a partner like South Africa that aspires to enhance the visibility and the interests of the Global South. We must work together more to find ourselves in an equitable global order." The minister said the bilateral relationship between India and South Africa has matured into a strategic partnership in the 30 years that the two countries have resumed diplomatic ties after a break of almost four decades as India led the international fight against apartheid at the UN. "This reflects our shared values and mutual objectives, which underpin our bonds between the two countries. It is an honour for us as South Africans to celebrate this significant milestone with the people of India," she said.

"Today we can look back on the accomplishments of the past thirty years and reflect on the successes that have been brought on by the collaboration of the two countries. These include growth in trade and investment and tourism, successful joint initiatives such as the establishment of the Gandhi-Mandela Skills Centre in Pretoria, and reintroducing Cheetah in India," the minister said. Gwarube, commenting on the recent elections in both countries, said: "These elections have been profound for both nations, reflecting the electorate's engagement in shaping the nation's future." These elections were not only pivotal for good Governance, but they also

have implications for regional stability, economic policies and global partnerships. They highlight the evolving political landscape in both countries and serve as a reminder of the enduring importance of democratic values shaping society and global stability, Gwarube said.

"For three decades, our countries have worked together closely fostering economic growth, cultural exchanges and people-to-people ties. We have collaborated in various fields from trade and investments to higher education,

development and even healthcare," she added. Gwarube said South Africa was looking forward to getting India's assistance in her country's plans to renew early childhood development, with a special focus on foundation phase learning literacy, which are "great priorities for South Africa".

"I am deeply pleased that the discussions in this regard are ongoing and I look forward to agreeing to strengthen and shape our objectives," she said. Gwarube said the lessons learnt during the past 30 years would be assessed during the 11th Joint

Ministerial Commission (JMC) that South Africa will host towards the end of this year. Prabhat Kumar, the High Commissioner of India to South Africa, sharing his Government's plans to make India a developed country by 2047, said: "India will be a USD 32 trillion economy, with an average annual GDP growth rate of 7.6 per cent over the next 25 years."

Detailing some of the highlights of the India-Africa relationship in the past year, Kumar said: "With bilateral trade crossing USD 19 billion last year, we are beginning to witness diversification of our trade basket. (PTI)

Wickremesinghe backed by grand alliance of over 30 parties in Lanka's Prez poll

COLOMBO, AUG 16 /--/ Sri Lankan President Ranil Wickremesinghe, the front runner in the Presidential poll scheduled for next month, was on Friday endorsed by a grand coalition of over 30 political parties and groups.

This comes after Wickremesinghe, 75, announced himself as the independent candidate on Thursday by handing over nominations to contest the September 21 Presidential election. Wickremesinghe, the leader of the now decimated grand old party, the United National Party (UNP), is backed by the Rajapaksa family breakaways from the Sri Lanka Podujana Peramuna (SLPP).

Wickremesinghe was elected as the stop-gap President after then-president Gotabaya Rajapaksa was ousted in a popular uprising following his inability to handle the country's unprecedented economic crisis that led to a shortage of essential commodities. The SLPP of the Rajapaksa provided Wickremesinghe with parliamentary support to become the President but did not approve of the incumbent president's hard reforms to revive the bankrupt economy. The SLPP has fielded the heir apparent of the dynasty Namal Rajapaksa,

38, against him. Wickremesinghe, who initiated a hard reform programme led by the International Monetary Fund, took upon reviving the economy with the support from his SLPP-dominated cabinet. "I'm thankful to those who supported me to handle this difficult task. They did not run away when challenged to perform the responsibilities of the country," Wickremesinghe, also the Finance Minister, said.

Wickremesinghe, since being elected, implemented hard economic reforms as necessitated by the IMF to secure a bail-out of nearly USD 3 billion over four years. His hard reforms brought in stability although the Opposition said the economic hardships caused by the IMF deal had left the public in the lurch. The Opposition has vowed to renegotiate the IMF programme to provide relief to the public.

Wickremesinghe's main rivals are once his deputy Sajith Premadasa and the leader of the Marxist Janatha Vimukthi Peramuna (JVP) Anura Kumara Dissanayake. There have been several individuals who changed loyalties to Wickremesinghe and Premadasa and vice versa since the election was announced by the island nation's independent election commission. Flights and trains cancelled in Tokyo area as strong typhoon swerves nearby

TOKYO, AUG 16 /--/ Flights and trains in the Tokyo area were cancelled Friday, and people were warned of strong winds, heavy rains and potential flooding and mudslides as a typhoon swerved near Japan on its way further north in the Pacific Ocean. Typhoon Ampil was forecast to reach the waters near Tokyo in the evening then continue north, bringing stormy conditions to the northern Kanto and Tohoku regions early Saturday. It had sustained winds of 162 kph (101 mph) with higher gusts Friday morning

and was moving north at 20 kph (12 mph), the Japan Meteorological Agency said. Ampil was not expected to make landfall and would weaken to a tropical storm by

Sunday. The Shinkansen bullet trains running between Tokyo and Nagoya were halted for the entire day, according to Central Japan Railway, a common response to typhoons here. (PTI)
