**Subject: SSWL Achieves Stellar 36.84% YoY Growth in Net Turnover for June 2026**

Dear Sir/Ma'am,

Steel Strips Wheels Limited (SSWL) is pleased to report its performance for June 2026 given as below:-

### **1. Financial & Operational Highlights – June 2026**

SSWL has recorded an exceptional growth trajectory in June 2026, significantly outpacing the figures from the previous fiscal year, led by broad-based strength across Truck, Tractor, and EV-linked segments, alongside a long-awaited return to value growth in Exports.

- **Net Turnover:** Achieved Rs. 479.87 Cr in June 2026 compared to Rs. 350.67 Cr in June 2025, marking a robust YoY growth of 36.84%.
- **Gross Turnover:** Stood at Rs. 554.10 Cr in June 2026 against Rs. 426.31 Cr in June 2025, delivering a steady YoY expansion of 29.98%.
- **Alloy Products Performance:** Sustained strong traction with Monthly Alloy Products Sales growing by 23% YoY by volume.

### **2. Strategic Segment-Wise Analysis & Growth Drivers**

The remarkable performance this month reflects a highly efficient mix of rapid macro-segment adoption, rural demand resilience, product premiumization, and a notable turnaround in export economics.

#### **a) Truck Segment – Standout Volume & Value Momentum**

The Truck vertical was a key highlight of the month, posting a strong 54% growth by Value and 39% growth by Volume YoY. This sustained double-digit volume expansion reflects robust freight demand and a firming commercial vehicle replacement cycle, reinforcing SSWL's positioning in the medium and heavy commercial vehicle wheel segment.

#### **b) Tractor Segment – Resilient Rural-Led Growth**

The Tractor segment continued its strong run, delivering 34% growth by Value and 27% growth by Volume YoY. Healthy rural cash flows, sustained farm mechanization demand, and favorable agri-sentiment continue to underpin this performance, further consolidating SSWL's market share in the agricultural vehicle space.

#### **c) Exponential Push in 2 & 3 Wheelers (EV Component Adoption)**

The 2 & 3 Wheelers segment emerged as the fastest-growing engine for the month, recording a phenomenal 74% growth by Value and 40% growth by Volume. This disproportionately high value growth indicates a sharp pivot toward higher-margin product delivery, aggressively supported by accelerated market adoption of Electric Vehicles (EVs).

#### **d) Alloy Segment and Passenger Cars – Steady Premiumization**

- **Alloy Wheels Segment:** Showcased a clear up-ticking trend of premiumization, driving 35% Value growth and 21% Volume growth YoY.
- **Passenger Cars:** Maintained a stable trajectory with 9% growth in Value and 11% growth in Volume.

#### **e) Export Value Turns Positive After a Long Time**

Exports delivered a notable inflection this month — after a prolonged period of subdued value performance, exports registered a 7% positive growth by Value YoY, even as volumes declined 39% YoY amid ongoing international logistics constraints. This marks the first meaningful value-side recovery in exports in a long time, driven by strategic pricing and a shift toward premium configurations, and signals improving realizations in SSWL's international book.
