i.	<p>Brief details of litigation viz.</p> <p>a. name(s) of the opposing party;</p> <p>b. court/ tribunal/agency where litigation is filed;</p> <p>c. brief details of dispute/litigation and change in the status and / or any development in relation to such proceedings</p>	<p>Prysmian Cables and Systems USA, LLC (“Plaintiff”) filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court, District of South Carolina, Columbia Division, against Mr. Stephen Szymanski (“Szymanski”), an employee of Sterlite Technologies Inc. (“STI”), the U.S. subsidiary of Sterlite Technologies Limited, and against STI. The Plaintiff alleged that Szymanski violated certain non-compete and confidentiality agreements and disclosed confidential information to STI, thereby providing STI with an alleged unjust competitive advantage. Szymanski and STI denied these allegations and asserted affirmative defenses. Sterlite Technologies Limited (“STL”) is not a party to this dispute and no claims have been made against STL.</p> <p>On August 9, 2024, following a three week trial, a Jury returned a verdict of USD 200,000 against Szymanski and USD 96.5 million against STI. On August 29, 2025, the Court affirmed the verdict but denied Plaintiff’s post-trial motion for pre-judgment interest.</p> <p>STI believes the judgment is unsupported by the testimony and evidence presented at trial, as well as applicable law, and intends to vigorously pursue all available post-trial remedies, including an appeal.</p>
