ANOTHER E-WAY | MSRDC's MD says the project needs 1000ha

Virar-Alibaug corridor gets 360 hectare land

The Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation (MSRDC) has acquired 360 hectare (ha) of land for the proposed Virar-Alibaug Multimodal Corridor (VAMMC). The expressway will comprise 8-14 lanes and connect three districts of Raigad, Thane and Palghar. Joint MD of MSRDC, Kailas Jadhav said the project needs 1,000ha.

Jadhav also said that the land pooling method adopted for Samruddhi Mahamarg will not be used for the Virar-Alibaug corridor. He said that land would be bought and the compensation will be paid as per the provisions of the Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement (LARR) Act of 2015. The senior official said they have submitted a



proposal regarding floating of the bonds with the state government, and will commence the further process once it's approved.

The greenfield expressway was originally planned in 2011 by Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA). However, in September 2020,

a deal was signed to hand over the construction to MSRDC, which received environmental clearance for the 18km stretch between Chirner and Balvali in June 2021. Nearly 5,000 trees are likely to be cut for the project and 221ha of forest land is to be diverted.

With an estimated cost of

Rs55,000 crore, the project is likely to be completed by 2030. The access-controlled road will have 8-14 lanes with a lane width of 3.75mt. Fourteen civil engineering firms submitted 33 bids to construct 96.47km Phase 1 of the 126km expressway after technical bids were opened in May 2024.

1.75L noise barriers along Bullet viaduct

More than 1.75 lakh noise barrier units are being installed along the viaduct of Mumbai-Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail (MAHSR) corridor, or the Bullet train. These barriers are meant to mitigate the noise generated by the train and civil operations. Work on a stretch of 87.5 km is over, an official said.

The barriers are concrete panels 2mt in height and 1mt wide, with each panel weighing nearly 830-840 kg. Each kilometre gets nearly 2,000 such units. The barriers will not only reflect and distribute the aerodynamic noise but also suppress noise from the wheels running on the tracks. In residential areas, the barriers will rise to 3mt, with the upper 1mt made out of translucent polycarbonate to allow for the scenic view.

"Six precast factories have been set up in Ahmedabad, Surat, Vadodara, and Anand," the official added.

Delay in fitness certs, truck firms in losses

Maharashtra's transport sector is facing a severe crisis as hundreds of vehicles (mainly trucks) are stranded due to an 18-day delay in the issuance of fitness certificates by the state's Regional Transport Offices (RTOs). The disruption has led to significant financial losses and caused widespread delays in the movement of essential and non-essential goods, bringing a large portion of the transport industry to a standstill.

Bal Malkit Singh, the chairman of the core committee and former president of the All India Motor Transport Congress (AIMTC), said that the suspension of fitness certification by RTOs has caused widespread operational challenges for transporters and businesses relying on timely deliveries.



The issue primarily stems from new requirements imposed on vehicles previously fitted with speed limiting devices (SLDs), which now need to undergo new installations. "The earlier process allowed for quick renewals upon presentation of renewal letters," Singh said. Additionally, vehicles equipped with company-fitted electronic control units (ECUs) are also being denied fitness certificates due to technical discrepancies in the system. The disruption has significantly affected supply

chains across Maharashtra, especially in the logistics of critical commodities.

Singh has written to Vivek Bhimanwar, IAS, Transport Commissioner of Maharashtra, urging immediate intervention. Bhimanwar told the FPJ that they are working on the issue and hope to resolve it soon.

"Immediate action is necessary to prevent further disruption to the supply chain and mitigate the financial impact on transporters across the state," said a truck owner.

Leyland's 'Lalpari' diesel buses for MSRTC from Oct

Beginning October, the Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC) will receive the first batch of 2,500 diesel buses from Ashok Leyland. The production of the prototype is complete and it's currently undergoing various tests, expecting to receive the certification shortly.

An official said that the final inspection of the prototype was conducted on September 10 at Ashok Leyland's factory in

Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu. The company is preparing to begin deliveries next month, with 50 to 100 buses, known as 'Lalpari', joining the MSRTC fleet in October. By November, an additional 150 to 300 buses will be delivered. The entire batch of 2,500 buses is expected to be fully delivered within the next eight to nine months.

MSRTC, which recently witnessed a three-day strike, operates 14,000 buses daily, serving around 5.5 million passengers. Officials said that large-scale addition to its fleet is expected to significantly

enhance the network across rural Maharashtra.

Jagdeep Desai, a transport expert, expressed his support for the purchase of diesel buses for rural areas. "Developing the necessary infrastructure to support electric buses in rural areas would require significant funding and time, so it's not a bad decision," Desai said. An MSRTC official confirmed that the transitioning from traditional diesel buses to electric and CNG has begun, but said it will take time to develop sufficient supporting infrastructure in rural areas.

NMC nod for PG med institute in Navi Mum

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) has received a go-ahead from the National Medical Commission to commence with the post-graduate institute of medical science in the city. With the green signal, the medical department of NMMC is all set to commence with four courses at the Vashi and Nerul municipal hospitals from the next academic year.

The courses to be commissioned are medicine (three seats), orthopaedics (two seats), gynaecology (eight

seats) and paediatrics (four seats). Later, the administration plans to start a course in surgery as well.

An official said, "Both the required infrastructure and teaching faculty, comprising the dean, professors and the administrative staff, are already in place. We are driven to start with the course at the earliest."

Acute shortage of staff during the Covid-19 pandemic paved the way for the NMMC to have its own institute. The doctors expected to take admission for higher studies will assist the medical department of the corporation.
