Three MP Kumbh returnees killed after bus collides with parked truck in Rajasthan

At least three people were killed and two others seriously injured when the bus they were travelling in crashed into a parked truck on the Delhi-Mumbai eight-lane expressway in Rajasthan. The bus was carrying devotees from Maha Kumbh in Uttar Pradesh's Prayagraj. The injured have been admitted to Kota's MBS Hospital for treatment. The devotees were returning to Mandasaur in Madhya Pradesh after visiting Maha Kumbh for a holy dip. The accident occurred near Karodra in Simliya (Kota) in the morning. According to Simliya police station ASI Hariraj Singh, the accident took place around 6.30 a.m. The bus was carrying approximately 56 passengers, all residents of Mandasaur. While travelling on the expressway, the bus collided with a stationary truck. Five passengers sustained severe injuries and were immediately referred to Kota for medical care, while the remaining passengers

escaped unhurt. ASI Singh confirmed that three passengers lost their lives, and two others were critically injured. The bodies have been sent to the mortuary. Upon receiving information about the accident, Simliya police rushed to the scene, initiated rescue operations, and transported the injured to the nearest hospital with the help of ambulances. ASI Hariraj Singh said, "The accident was reported at around 6:30 in the morning. There were about 56 passengers on the bus. All the passengers are residents of Mandasaur in MP. They were returning to Mandasaur after taking a holy dip in Prayagraj. A truck was parked on the highway in the morning. The bus rammmed into the parked truck from behind." The deceased were identified as Kailash Bai (54), Kishori Lal (60) and Ashok (35). Kailash and Kishori Lal were husband and wife. "Chaman Lal and Parvati are injured. These people were sitting in the cabin of the bus."



MP GOVT SIGNS AGREEMENT WITH FINLAND-BASED ORGANISATION TO PROMOTE TOURISM

The Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board on Thursday signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Finland-based organisation 'V Real' at Samatva Bhawan in Bhopal Niwas. The agreement was signed in the presence of Chief Minister Mohan Yadav and Finland's Ambassador for India, Kimmo Lahdevirta in Bhopal. On this occasion, Chief Minister Yadav said that the MP Tourism Board and Finnish organisation 'V Real' discussed the application of modern technology at tourist sites, historical heritage locations, and museums in the state. He said the virtual tour initiative will allow people interested in tourism, history, and culture to explore the rich heritage and glorious history of Madhya Pradesh from the comfort of their own countries. "The initiative is expected to pro-



motate the state's tourism sites and historical landmarks on a global scale, increasing international tourist visits," the Chief Minister said in a statement. Principal Secretary of Tourism and Culture, Sheshshakar Shukla, informed Finland-based organisation 'V Real' has been preserving history, culture, and heritage through advanced technology by producing high-quality videos.

The Ambassador also highlighted his keen interest in exploring Madhya Pradesh's UNESCO World Heritage Sites during his visit, he added. Currently, Madhya Pradesh has three UNESCO sites - the Khajuraho temple complex, Sanchi Stupa and Bhimbetka. The Central government has accepted the dossier prepared by the Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board, nominating Orchha's group of monuments for the Unesco World Heritage List. The recommendation for Orchha's inclusion has been made for 2027-28. Vishal V. Sharma, Indian ambassador to UNESCO, formally submitted the dossier to Lazaro Eouandou Assomo, director of UNESCO World Heritage Centre during an event in New Delhi.

BIKE-BORNE MEN KIDNAP 6-YEAR-OLD BOY AFTER THROWING CHILLI POWDER AT MOTHER IN GWALIOR

The kidnapping of a 7-year-old boy in Gwalior on Thursday morning sparked a political controversy as the Opposition Congress raised questions about Madhya Pradesh's law and order situation. Termining the abduction of the child as a "shocking" and "dangerous" example of crime, Congress veteran and former Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Kamal Nath said the incident has once again exposed the state's deteriorating law and order situation. "The courage of criminals in the state is increasing so much that they no longer have fear of the law. I hope that swift action will be taken and the child would be handed over to his parents safely," Kamal Nath said in a statement.

Meanwhile, minister incharge for Gwalior, Tulsi Ram Silawat informed that he has spoken to Director General of Police (DGP) Kailash Makwana on phone and was monitoring the developments in the case with senior police officials. Silawat said he also spoke to the parents of the abducted boy and has assured them that the boy would be rescued safely as soon as possible. The child, who is 6 to 7 years old is a resident of Gwalior. The incident occurred in the Muzan area of Gwalior on Thursday morn-

ing when his mother was going to drop the child off to school. Suddenly, two miscreants arrived on bikes and threw chilli powder in her eyes, they picked up the child and sped away. This entire incident has been captured on a CCTV camera installed there. The footage shows a youth walking on his red bike while his side comes running with the child in his arms. He sits on the bike with the boy, and the duo flee from there. The video also shows the child's mother trying to chase them. Gwalior Division IG

Arvind Saxena told media persons that a police team has spoken to the parents, however, they were not in a position to face more questions. "The matter is very serious, and we are investigating the case from several aspects. We will try to get some more concrete information from the parents, which can give a clue about the criminals as soon as possible. Several teams are working on this matter," Saxena said. Saxena said that the police have announced a reward of Rs 30,000 on the person who gives information about the child kidnappers from Murar CP Colony or the kidnappers. He has issued the number +91 81310 46472 for giving information on the whereabouts of the kidnappers or the boy.



Not in the race to become Madhya Pradesh unit BJP chief : Narottam Mishra

With the central BJP leadership all set to appoint new president for the Madhya Pradesh unit, senior leader of the ruling party, Narottam Mishra, denied of being in the race for the post. Mishra made this statement after Union Minister Jyotiraditya Scindia reached his residence and the two held a closed-door meeting in Bhopal on Wednesday. After reaching Bhopal, Scindia visited Raj Bhawan to meet Governor Mangubhai Patel, and then he arrived at Mishra's residence. This closed-door meeting led to a lot of speculation in the state's political circles. However, responding to media queries, former Madhya Pradesh Home Minister Narottam Mishra said that Scindia had

visited him for a courtesy meeting. "Let me make it clear that I am not in the race for the BJP state president," he added. Scindia's sudden visit to Mishra's residence also created a buzz as several other senior BJP leaders from the state have also visited him in the past few days. Before that, senior BJP leader and Madhya Pradesh Urban Development Minister, Kailash Vijayvargiya had met Mishra last Thursday. Political circles have been speculating that the ruling BJP is likely to appoint a new state BJP chief for Madhya Pradesh, and five-time former minister Narottam Mishra, who lost the Assembly election in 2023, is considered one of the potential candidates in the race.



Prez Murmu, PM Modi and HM Shah set to visit MP between February 23 to 26

President Droupadi Murmu, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah will visit Madhya Pradesh between February 23 to 26. Prime Minister Modi will arrive at Baghelwar Dham in Chhatrapur district, where he will lay the foundation stone for a cancer hospital on February 23. Baghelwar Dham's head priest Dharendra Shastri is building a cancer hospital. Later in the day, PM Modi will arrive in Bhopal and stay overnight at Raj Bhawan. Next morning, he will inaugurate the Global Investment Summit (GIS) in Bhopal on February 24, in which around 4,000 industrialists, and business representatives from several overseas countries, including the US, UK, Japan and Germany will participate. Chief Minister Mohan Yadav has confirmed that the state government has requested

PM Modi to inaugurate GIS-2025, and got approval from PMO. Union Home Minister Shah is also scheduled to attend GIS on the concluding day on February 25. He is supposed to address the gathering of industrialists during the closing ceremony of GIS. On February 26, President Murmu is scheduled to arrive in Chhatrapur to attend a mass marriage ceremony at Baghelwar Dham. The marriage of 251 girls will be solemnized between February 22 and 26. Out of them, 186 girls belong to the tribal community. For the GIS, the MP government organised a curtain-raiser event at the Taj Hotel in Delhi on Wednesday, wherein, the state's new investment policy was highlighted. During the event, Chief Minister Mohan Yadav held one-on-one and round table discussions with industrialists and invited them to GIS Bhopal on February 24 and 25.



MADRASAS IN BENGAL PROPAGATING ANTI-NATIONAL IDEOLOGY : VIJAYVARGIYA

Madhya Pradesh Cabinet Minister Kailash Vijayvargiya has alleged that some madrasas in West Bengal are imparting anti-national ideology. He stated that intelligence agencies are actively investigating the matter. Speaking to media persons here on Thursday, Vijayvargiya asserted, "Anti-national education is being imparted in Bengal's madrasas. Intelligence agencies are investigating the matter. Evidence has been found at some places, though some madrasas are also functioning properly." The BJP leader, who was previously the state incharge of West Bengal, added, "I have been in Bengal, and I am aware that several madrasas have been involved in

propagating anti-national ideology." The issue of alleged anti-national activities in educational institutions was further amplified by Maharashtra Minister and BJP leader Nitesh Rane, who on



Wednesday alleged that a minority institute in Nandurbar district had provided shelter to a Yemeni national. He wrote to Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis to set up a Special Investigation Team to probe the matter.

Reacting to Rane's statement, Vijayvargiya said, "I do not fully endorse Nitesh Rane's statement. While some madrasas may be engaging in such activities, others are functioning well. However, a thorough investigation is needed to ascertain the truth." Vijayvargiya also criticised senior Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, accusing him of making baseless allegations against constitutional institutions whenever his party loses elections. "In a democracy, winning and losing are part of the game. But when the Congress loses, they blame voters lists, EVM manipulation, and the Election Commission. However, if they win, everything is deemed fair."

CONTROVERSIAL POSTERS PUT UP IN BHOPAL, CITIZENS PROTEST

Taking his point further, he said that this is such an area where tableaus are put up. Muharram processions are welcomed, RSS's pathshala is also welcomed. In view of this, I appeal to such people not to spread communal mentality in Bhopal, Bhopal is an island of peace. Strict action should be taken against such mischievous elements. Another person Mujahid Siddiqui says that I condemn those who have put up this poster. This country belongs to Hindus, Muslims, Sikhs, Christians. An example of this is Maha Kumbh, where crores of Hindu devotees reached, there also Muslims helped them. There the Maulvi opened madrasas.
